

Our Heavenly Father—our Creator—has a Personal Name. In Aramaic Square Script Hebrew it is: יהוה. In Paleo Hebrew Script it is יהוה. One transliterated version into English to help with sound pronunciation is “Yahuah,” additionally “Yah” for short—יה or יה. Other English transliterations do exist.

Our Messiah—our Savior—has a Personal Name as well. Similarly in Aramaic it is written יהושע or יהושע in Paleo—transliterated to English by some as Yahusha. Other English transliterations do exist.

(Cepher) Before the mountains were brought forth, or ever you had formed the earth and the world, even from everlasting to everlasting, you *are* El.

(TS2009) Before the mountains were born, Or You had brought forth the earth and the world, Even from everlasting to everlasting You are El.

(YS) Before the mountains were born, Or You had brought forth the earth and the world, Even from everlasting to everlasting You are El.

(Brenton) Before the mountains existed, and before the earth and the world were formed, even from age to age, Thou art.
