

Our Heavenly Father—our Creator—has a Personal Name. In Aramaic Square Script Hebrew it is: יהוה. In Paleo Hebrew Script it is יהאָה. One transliterated version into English to help with sound pronunciation is “Yahuah,” additionally “Yah” for short—יה or יה. Other English transliterations do exist.

Our Messiah—our Savior—has a Personal Name as well. Similarly in Aramaic it is written יהושע or OWYAH in Paleo—transliterated to English by some as Yahusha. Other English transliterations do exist.

(Cepher) I am the א (Aleph) and the ת (Tav), the beginning and the ending, says **Yahuah Elohiym**, which is, and which was, and which is to come, **Yahuah Tseva'oth**.

(TS2009) “I am the ‘Aleph’ and the ‘Taw’, Beginning and End,” says יהוה “who is and who was and who is to come, the Almighty.”

(YS) “I am the ‘Aleph’ and the ‘Tau’, Beginning and End,” says יהאָה “who is and who was and who is to come, El Shaddai.”
