

## Shem & Sedeqetelebab

Our Heavenly Father—our Creator—has a Personal Name. In Aramaic Square Script Hebrew it is: יהוה. In Paleo Hebrew Script it is איהא. One transliterated version into English to help with sound pronunciation is “Yahuah,” additionally “Yah” for short—יה or איה. Other English transliterations do exist.

Our Messiah—our Savior—has a Personal Name as well. Similarly in Aramaic it is written יהושע or איהא in Paleo—transliterated to English by some as Yahusha. Other English transliterations do exist.

There is one race, and one race only—the human race. Reference **Genesis 1:27, Deuteronomy 10:17, Acts 17:26, Galatians 3:28, Colossians 3:11.**

Following the Flood, eight people survived—**Noah** and his wife **Emzârâ** (referenced in The Book of Jubilees 4:33), and their three sons (**Japheth, Shem, and Ham**) and their wives (referenced in the Book of Jubilees Chapter 7).

Shem’s genealogy is found in **Genesis 10:21-31, Genesis 11:10-32** and in **1 Chronicles 1:17-27.**

**Shem & Sedeqetelebab**—“Semitic Lineage”—Genetics, not any religion. We are told of 5 sons as per **Genesis 10:22.**

- (1 of 5) **Elam**—modern-day Iran—Elamites—settled east of the Tigris River and south of Assyria.
- (2 of 5) **Asshur**—Assyria—located in ancient Mesopotamia around the Tigris River. Nineveh (the Jonah story), Rehoboth, and Calah were located here as per **Genesis 10:11.**
- (4 of 5) **Lud**—Lydia in Anatolia (modern-day Turkey).
- (5 of 5) **Aram**—a region in ancient Syria between the Tigris and Euphrates rivers.
  - **Uz**—**Genesis 10:23** and **1 Chronicles 1:17.** Job was from Uz as per **Job 1:1.**
  - **Hul**—linked to Arameans in modern-day Syria.
  - **Gether**—possibly Mesopotamia, Scripture does not specifically state.
  - **Mash**—probably modern-day Syria.

→ (3 of 5) **Arphaxad**—Messopotamia near Ur (which is linked to the Chaldeans).

**Salah**

→ **Eber**—2 sons as per **Genesis 10:25** Peleg and Joktan.

→ **Peleg** (1<sup>st</sup> son of Eber).

**Rue** (Genesis 11:18)

**Serug** (Genesis 11:20)

**Nahor** (Genesis 11:22)

**Terah** (Genesis 22:24) had 3 sons Abram, Nahor, and Haran.

**Abram** (**Genesis 11:26**) Name changed to Abraham in **Genesis 17:5**.

**Isaac**

**Jacob** Name changed to Israel in **Genesis 32:28**.

**ISRAELITES—12 Tribes from 14 men.**

→ **Joktan** (2<sup>nd</sup> son of Eber) had 13 sons as per **Genesis 10:26-29**.
