

Trumpet One of Seven—≈400-410AD—Goths

Scriptures are KJV; any Brackets [] were added by the translators.

Yellow Highlighting my emphasis; ≈ means approximately.

Revelation 8:7 *“The first angel sounded, and there followed hail and fire mingled with blood, and they were cast upon the earth: and the third part of trees was burnt up, and all green grass was burnt up.”*

The Goths (Alaric 1—King of the Visigoths from 395-410) were known to burn as they went and conquered.

Roman Emperors in the West recap—approximate dates:

- 284-305AD Diocletian and Maximian
- 305-311AD Galerius Valerius Maximianus, Maximinus Daza, Severus II, and Maxentius.
- 311-324AD Constantine I (aka Constantine the Great 306-337AD), and Licinius.
- 324-337AD Constantine I.
- 337-340AD Constantine II, Constantius II (337-361AD), and Constans (337-350).
- 340-350AD Constantius II (337-361AD), and Constans (337-350).
- 350-361AD Constantius II.
- 361-363AD Julian—last Pagan Roman Emperor. He was the Caesar of the West from 355-360AD, and the Roman Emperor from 361-363AD.
- 363-364 Jovian.
- 364-375 Valentinian I, Valens (364-378AD), and Gratian (367-383).
- 375-378AD Valens, Gratian, and Valentinian II (375-392AD).
- 379-395AD Theodosius I (aka Theodosius the Great)—established the Nicene Creed.
- 395 Empire splits into East and West.

The first four trumpets of Revelation 8 occur in a 76-year period—≈400-476AD.
