


Yah's Calendar Pattern Throughout Time

Our Heavenly Father—our Creator—has a Personal Name. In Aramaic Square Script Hebrew it is: **יהוה**. In Paleo Hebrew Script it is **אֵלֶּה**. One transliterated version into English to help with sound pronunciation is “Yahuah,” additionally “Yah” for short—**יה** or **אֵל**. Other English transliterations do exist.

Our Messiah—our Savior—has a Personal Name as well. Similarly in Aramaic it is written **יהושע** or **ܝܫܘܥ** in Paleo—transliterated to English by some as Yahusha. Other English transliterations do exist.

Scripture clearly speaks of different “types” of days. Technically, there are four:

1. **New Moon Day Celebration** (which is different from the physical “New Moon”  known as one type of lunar “conjunction.”)
2. **Work Day**—6 consecutive work days follow every New Moon Day, and follow the weekly Sabbath Rest Days.
3. **Rest Day Weekly**—1 rest day followed after 6 work days. These weekly rest times are “appointed times” aka seasons.
4. **Rest Day Annual**—totally explained in **Leviticus 23**. These annual rest times are also “appointed times” aka seasons.

Below is the ongoing pattern of how the first three types of “a day” work together in **any given month**. The first New Moon (and first phase ever) was when Yah created the heavens and the earth. Consider letting go of all human calendars and surrender to Yah to teach you His Calendar. Yah does not change as per **Malachi 3:6**, so Yah's Calendar doesn't change either.

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When Noah's Flood began on the **17th Day of the 2nd Month** of whatever the year, the same pattern existed.

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When Noah's Flood ended more than a year later on the **17th Day of the 7th Month**, the same pattern existed.

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In **Exodus 12** Yah teaches Israel about how Yah will be passing over them “Passover” in the 1st month on the 14th day of the year of the Exodus. The pattern remains the same. On the 10th day, they were to take an unblemished lamb, keep it until the 14th. We are told in **Exodus 12:14** that this day (the 14th of the 1st month of every year) is a feast to Yah throughout our generations. We are to keep this day as a feast via ordinance forever. Passover is the 14th of the 1st Month every year. Our Messiah was crucified on this date.

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Continuing along in Exodus 12, Yah teaches about His 7-day **Feast of Unleavened Bread**, which begins on the 15th of the 1st Month. The **15th and the 21st are annual rest days—annual Sabbaths**. Also reference **Leviticus 23:6-8**. The Red Sea was crossed on the 21st.

The pattern is the same. The 16th-20th are work days during FUB. The 16th is also the wave sheath offering day as per **Leviticus 23:11**.

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Yah brought the Israelites out of Egypt on the 15th day of the 1st month—yes, on a weekly and annual Sabbath evening. See **Numbers 33:3**.

Below is a timeline of events beginning with the 14th Day of the Exodus 1st Month. It makes sense to me that the Israelites crossed the Red Sea on the 21st day of that **1st Month**—the last day (and an annual Sabbath) of the 7-day **FUB**. **Isaiah 51:10** speaks of this as well. Does Scripture specifically state that they crossed on the 21st? No, we have to use the brain with which Yah blessed us.

The 2nd Month of the Exodus follows the same pattern. As per **Exodus 16:1** the Israelites came into the wilderness of Sin which is between Elim and Sinai on the **15th day of the 2nd Month**—a weekly Sabbath.

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Quail was sent the evening of the 15th of that 2nd Month. Manna began the morning of the 16th day of the 2nd Month. Double portion of manna on day 6, and no manna on the weekly Sabbaths. This went on for 40 years. As per **Joshua 5:12**, the manna was no longer sent after the Israelites ate from the produce of the Promised Land (Canaan) on the 15th following the Passover.

The 3rd Month of the Exodus follows again the same pattern. **Exodus 19:1** tells us that the Israelites arrived to Sinai on the 15th day of the 3rd month, a weekly Sabbath.

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For three consecutive months in a row in the same year, the 15th of each month was a weekly and/or annual Sabbath—clearly Yah’s calendar. This not possible on any human calendar including the Julian or Gregorian.

40 Years Later, we again have the same pattern.
