## Yahuah's (Yah who ah) Personal Name

Our Creator, (and Father) just like you and me, has a personal Name—Yahuah, or Yah for short.

Humans are very persnickety about the spelling <u>and</u> pronunciation of their name(s). My family (to this day) hates it when our last name—our surname—is not pronounced correctly, (or as they deem to have it pronounced). My last name is spelled "ROHDE," yet, most people who don't know me choose to pronounce it like the USA state of "Rhode" Island. The pronunciation of my surname however, is like the word "ROW" followed by the letter "D" (as in David). "ROW D," not "road."

Think about all of the people in this world who are named "Peter." If any of those people named "Peter" travel to France, they are still called "Peter." They are not suddenly called "Pierre," which is a French "<u>translation</u>" for the name "Peter." Similarly, the people in the world named "Pierre" are still called "Pierre" wherever they happen to be on the planet at any given time.

Humans are created in the image of our Creator (**Genesis 1:27**); so if we humans are picky about the spelling, and very importantly the pronunciation of our name(s), don't you think our Creator just might like us to call on Him (correctly to our current ability) by His personal Name as well?

Scripture tells us to do just that as early as **Genesis 4:26**, **Genesis 12:8**, **Genesis 13:4**, and **Genesis 26:25** as examples. We are continually told throughout the Old and New Testaments to "Call upon the Name" of our Creator.

How can we call upon the Name of our Creator (pronounce it—say it), when we don't even know what His Personal Name is? How His Name is written in any world language is not as important as how we pronounce it—the sound matters. I don't turn when I hear the sound "road," but I do turn when I hear the sounds "Row D." Our Creator wants us to call on His True Name, only.

The King James Version (KJV) and all of its derivatives do not help us in any way with regard to pronouncing our Creator's Name. They hinder immensely because the translators changed His Name to words which completely go against Scripture, as Scripture flat out tells us that we must not add or subtract (and that would include changes as well). Reference **Deuteronomy 4:2** and **Revelation 22:18-19**. Some hard printed copies of the KJVs state that the Creator's Name has been changed to "G-o-d," "L-O-R-D," or "L-o-r-d" for example, while many do not. If one wants to know our Creator's Name, one has to go to different English Translations—The Scriptures, Cepher, Yah Scriptures, and the Hebrew Gospels as four good examples.

aYal is our Creator's Name in the Paleo script. In Aramaic Hebrew Square script His Name is in the Arial font), or יהוה (in the Arial font).

I stay away from Masoretic Hebrew aka "Vowelled Hebrew" used by those practicing Judaism today. I also stay away from the Aramaic "Square Hebrew" as well. I work with the Paleo-Hebrew whenever possible.

Again, our Creator's Name is **AYAL** in the Paleo script. Hebrew reads from right to left, while English reads from left to right. The letters of our Creator's Name in the correct order from right to left are:

- 1. The vowel "YOD" Y (10th letter of 22 letters). The sound is a "Y," and it means "hand."
- 2. The vowel "HAY"— **H** (5<sup>th</sup> letter of 22 letters). The sound is a "H," and it means "window."
- 3. The vowel "UAU" W (6th letter of 22 letters). The sound is "U/Uau," and it means "hook."
- 4. The vowel "HAY"— H (5<sup>th</sup> letter of 22 letters). The sound is a "H," and it means "window."

In English, to the best of my current ability, this is pronounced "Yahuah." (Yah who ah.) The first time this is used is in Genesis 2:4. When doing a word search in e-Sword, in the TS2009 translation this word is used in 6079 verses, 7147 times. In the Cepher, it is used in 6149 verses, 7216 times. In the Yah Scriptures (YS) it is used in 6904 verses, 8052 times.

Our Creator's shorter Name is **31** and pronounced "**Yah**." The actual English letters "Yah" are used in 46 verses, 50 times in the TS2009 in 101 verses, 105 times in the Cepher in 101 verses, and 42 times in 38 verses in the YS.

The Paleo Bora "font" works "within" a word processing program like Microsoft Word which is what I use working with an English keyboard. This is completely different from using a Hebrew keyboard which is about typing the Aramaic Hebrew Square script.

## Yahuah's Human Son Named Yahusha (Yah who sha)

Again, there is only one Creator—not two, and not three. Our supernatural Creator has a human Son—our Messiah. He is our Savior, Advocate, Comforter, etc. He is EVERYTHING to us. We are NOTHING, and can do NOTHING without Him. Our Messiah's Name in Paleo Hebrew is:

## OWYAL

- 1. The vowel "YOD" **1** (10<sup>th</sup> letter of 22 letters). The sound is a "Y," and it means "hand."
- 2. The vowel "HAY" ◀ (5<sup>th</sup> letter of 22 letters). The sound is a "H," and it means "window."
- 3. The vowel "UAU"— Y (6th letter of 22 letters). The sound is "U/Uau," and it means "hook."
- 4. The letter "SHIN" ₩ (21st letter of 22 letters). The sound is "SH," and it means "tooth."
- 5. The vowel "AYIN"—O (16<sup>th</sup> letter of 22 letters. The sound is "E/A" and means "eye."

I believe the English pronunciation to be "Yahusha." (Yah who sha.) Our Messiah's Name can't possibly be "J-e-s-u-s C-h-r-i-s-t" because the English language and its letter "j" did not exist in the 1<sup>st</sup> century. In the TS2009 translation the Aramaic term "vi" is used in 936 verses, 977 times. In the Cepher, the term "Yahusha" is first used in Exodus 17:9 and used in 1234 verses, 1306 times. In the YS the term "ha'Mashiah" is used in 258 verses, 270 times.

If our Creator's Name is pronounced "Yah who ah," it stands to reason His Son's Name would be "Yah who sha." Regardless of any spelling, it is about the correct "sound" that matters.

John 1:1-3 "IN the beginning was the Word, and the Word was with את Elohiym, and Elohiym was the Word." <sup>2</sup> "The same was in the beginning with את Elohiym." <sup>3</sup> "All things were made by him; and without him was not anything made that was made." [Cepher]

Our Father and His Son are ONE. They are not two different entities.
