Effective Routines: Set a Time & Place for Homework

- ✓ Choose a **consistent homework time** that works for your child.

 - ✓ Use a **first-then approach** (e.g., *"First finish math, then play outside"*).
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Organization & Time Management: Use Checklists & Timers

- ✓ Break **large tasks** into **smaller, manageable steps**.
 - ✓ Use **visual schedules** or **written checklists** to track progress.
 - ✓ Set a **timer** (e.g., *20-minute focus, 5-minute break*) to maintain attention.
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Parent-Teacher Communication: Monthly Check-ins

- ✓ Send a **quick email** to check on progress and ask for feedback.
 - ✓ **Celebrate your child's wins** with the teacher.
 - ✓ Ask for **suggestions on reinforcing classroom strategies** at home.
