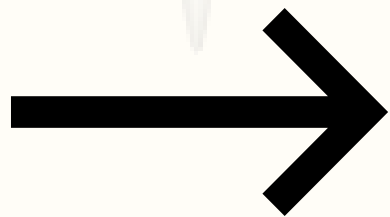

REVELATION GIFTS (SEE)

WORD OF KNOWLEDGE - WORD OF WISDOM - DISCERNING OF SPIRITS

Purpose: Seeing, knowing, discerning

- Word of Wisdom

Supernatural insight into God’s strategy, timing, or outcome
- Word of Knowledge

Supernatural knowledge of facts, conditions, or truths not learned naturally
- Discerning of Spirits

Ability to distinguish between the Holy Spirit, human spirit, and demonic spirits

UTTERANCE GIFTS (SAY)

PROPHECY - DIFFERENT KINDS OF TONGUES - INTERPRETATION OF TONGUES

Purpose: Speaking what God gives

- Prophecy

Inspired speech in a known language for edification, exhortation, and comfort
- Different Kinds of Tongues

Speaking in unknown languages given by the Spirit for prayer, worship, or as a sign
- Interpretation of Tongues

Supernatural understanding of the meaning of tongues so the message can be understood

POWER GIFTS (DO)

- GIFT OF FAITH - GIFTS OF HEALINGS - WORKING OF MIRACLES

Purpose: Demonstrating God’s power

- Gift of Faith

Supernatural confidence and assurance to believe God for impossible outcomes
- Gifts of Healings

Supernatural healing of physical, emotional, or mental conditions
- Working of Miracles

Divine intervention that supersedes natural laws



MOTIVATIONAL GIFTS



ROMANS 12:6–8

These describe how a believer is wired to serve
They are consistent, observable, and character based
They are listed in Romans 12

- Prophecy

Grace to speak truth plainly and call alignment

Romans 12:6

Note this is not the prophetic office and not the same as
1 Corinthians 12 prophecy

- Service (Helps)

Grace to meet practical needs and support others

Romans 12:7

- Teaching

Grace to explain, clarify, and ground people in truth

Romans 12:7

- Exhortation (Encouragement)

Grace to strengthen, urge, and motivate others

Romans 12:8

- Giving

Grace to supply resources joyfully and generously

Romans 12:8

- Leadership (Administration)

Grace to organize, direct, and govern people well

Romans 12:8

- Mercy

Grace to show compassion and care for the suffering

MINISTRY OFFICES (CALLINGS)

EPHESIANS 4:11–12

These are roles Christ appoints, not gifts people choose
They come with responsibility, authority, and accountability
They are listed in Ephesians 4

- Apostle
Sent one who establishes, governs, and builds foundations
Ephesians 4:11
- Prophet
Provides direction, correction, and alignment
Ephesians 4:11
- Evangelist
Proclaims the gospel and advances the Kingdom
Ephesians 4:11
- Pastor (Shepherd)
Cares for, protects, and nurtures people
Ephesians 4:11
- Teacher
Grounds believers in sound doctrine and understanding
Ephesians 4:11



FRUIT OF THE SPIRIT

Purpose: Character and maturity.

Love – Choosing others over self; acting for someone's good even when it costs you

Joy – Deep inner stability not dependent on circumstances or mood

Peace – Inner calm and trust in God that is not shaken by chaos or pressure

Patience – Endurance under delay or irritation without reacting in anger

Kindness – Treating people with care, dignity, and consideration in everyday moments

Goodness – Moral integrity; choosing what is right even when no one is watching

Faithfulness – Reliability and loyalty; doing what you said you would do consistently

Gentleness – Strength under control; responding without harshness or dominance

Self control – Governing impulses, emotions, and desires instead of being ruled by them

† FRUIT OF THE FLESH

Sexual immorality – Using sex outside God's design; hookups, porn, adultery, lust driven behavior

Impurity – A polluted inner life; consuming what defiles the mind and heart

Sensuality – Being ruled by appetite and impulse; no restraint, no boundaries

Idolatry – Placing anything above God; money, self, success, relationships, image

Sorcery – Seeking power or guidance apart from God; manipulation, witchcraft, occult practices, control

Enmity – Deep rooted hostility; us versus them mindset

Strife – Constant conflict; always needing to argue or prove superiority

Jealousy – Resentment toward what others have; comparison fueled discontent

Fits of anger – Explosive reactions; emotional volatility, lack of self control

Rivalries – Competition driven by ego; needing to win or outshine others

Dissensions – Creating division through offense, gossip, or stubborn opinions

Divisions – Loyalty to camps and sides over truth and unity

Envy – Wanting what someone else has and resenting them for it

Drunkenness – Escaping reality through substances; numbing instead of facing life

Orgies – Excess and debauchery; pleasure without limits or accountability
