

PHOTOGRAPHY, VIDEO & WEBSITE CODE OF PRACTICE

Football is a high profile sport and as a result attracts media interest.

Burbage FA is understandably keen to maximise publicity opportunities for the players and the club by publicising the achievements of teams and individuals.

Burbage FA has agreed the following guidance:

Parents will be asked at the start of each season to inform the coach in writing if they object to the use of their child's photograph being used on websites or in other published materials.

Pictures will not be reproduced with the player's name or any other information that could lead to the player being identified without specific permission from the parent.

Individual player's pictures will only be published with permission from the parent. Permission is 'taken as read' if the BFA does not receive in writing objections from the parent.

If one player in the photograph does not have parental consent, the picture will not be published.

Video films and photographs of events/matches/training sessions can only be made / taken with parental consent.

Images of players will not be used on a website without parental consent.

Code of Practice

We will:

- Not use images of players without the consent of parents/guardians
- Primarily use photographs/videos of players in teams/groups
- Not use photographs of players to which we receive written objections
- Not reveal details of players without parental consent
- Not use images of players labelled with their names without parental consent
- Not use close up images on the website without parental consent
- Not use any players individual pictures in any publication without parental consent
