

SAMPLE DAY THEME: BLOSSOMS & BULBS

Brain Break: Spring Yoga Cards

Whole Group I: KWL Chart – share what we know/want to know regarding flowers.



Whole Group 2: Write-the-Room blossom & bloom edition

Center I: FLOWER DISECTION- Playdough flower model

Center 2: CAPILLARY ACTION- STEM project to learn how flowers pull water up their stems to make beautiful blooms.



Center 3: MIXED MEDIA CRAFT- Build a Daffodil Model

Center 4: NOTEBOOKING- Discover wildflowers natural to our area and notebook about them (draw, label, add facts, etc.)

Center 5: SPOT IT GAME - Play a blossoms & blooms version of classic Spot It game.

Center 6: SEED JOURNEY- Learn about the journey of seeds - pick a seed type and create a short comic showing its journey.

*We follow a theme for one month, different whole group/centers each week. Final week we will put together projects/presentations about what we learned and have a party to celebrate the theme.



FREQUENTLY ASKED QUESTIONS

Q: Is this a drop off program?

Yes, this program is a drop off program. However, parents can stay as long or as little as they would like. You are always welcome!

Q: What is the class size?

Class size will max out at 15 students per day. There will be myself and a teachers assistant.

Q: What are student expectations?

The way this program is run there will be consistent structure to encourage participation. Students are expected to participate in group activities; however, there will always be the option to take breaks and advocate for themselves.

Q: What days/hours are the program?

The program is held on Thursdays from 10:00–3:00. We also meet the last Friday of every month from 10:00–2:00 for a party and presentations. When applicable there will be a field trip to accompany our learning theme.

Q: What are the payment options?

State-Funded spots are available through Colorado Homeschool Enrichment (CHE).

The self-pay cost per month is \$300. However, there are options. If this is not feasible for your family, please reach out! There are also sibling discounts, referral discounts, and discounts for paying the entire year up front. Limited full-time scholarships available.
