Once the SureStart period ends, typically after 10 years, you are covered for shingles only and at a reduced rate as the roof ages.

When a CertainTeed Integrity Roof System® is installed, your ShingleMaster™ PREMIER Credentialed Contractor is exclusively authorized to offer you enhanced SureStart PLUS protection, which takes traditional SureStart protection and extends coverage for up to 50 years.

5. Ventilation

A roof that breathes is shown to perform better and last longer. Ridge Vents, in combination with Intake Vents, allow air to flow on the underside of your roof deck, keeping the attic cooler in the summer and drier in the winter.

Available in numerous profiles, these accessories are used on the roof's hip and ridge lines for a distinctive finishing touch to your new roof.
