	Teaching 'no biting' clothes/feet, leash, gentle restraint	Paw Targeting - Platform (HO)	*train recall games with puppy's name, and with 'recall word' separately!	
	Teaching 'All Done' (end training; take focus off treats)	Release Cue: Release cue from Crate		
OTHER:	'Being Still' (training calm waiting)	'Sit, 'Down', 'Stand' Hold, Release' (3D's) (HO)	NOTE: lure or 'shape' your puppy into sit, down, and stand positions in the beginning, and DO NOT USE VERBAL CUES. Just get them familiar with positions and position changes.

For a truly reliable behavior, train each skill with:

- ~ Duration
 - ~ Distance
 - ~ Distractions
 - ~ in new Environments
- Change only one criteria at a time:**
If moving away, don't want too long!
If waiting longer, don't add distractions yet!
- Build criteria by asking for more reps between treats, too!
When you change the environment, reduce other criteria & increase reinforcement when you first begin!
'Ping-Pong' criteria - harder, then really easy!
Begin to fade treats!
Start training without treats in your hand or on your person. Have them in a bowl on a table or shelf!
Begin to use OTHER reinforcers: like access to go outdoors, to play, smells, parks, people, other dogs, etc.
