## HT 101 Train the Trainer



## **Overview:**

In Spring 2025 DCBS continued the work originally funded through the OVC Improving Outcomes for Child and Youth Victims of Human Trafficking grant project, which ended in Sept. 2024, through implementation of the HT101 Train the Trainer Series, which was offered through four regional trainings for professionals throughout Kentucky positioned to provide future HT101 training to individuals in their field and awareness presentations to community members.

The HT101 training content for the Train the Trainer included an overview of human trafficking definitions and laws, impacted populations, familial trafficking, intersections with substance misuse, screening for trafficking, national and local human trafficking data, Kentucky state human trafficking laws, prevention, and intervention. Attendees were provided guidance as trainers which included additional resources, information on training v/s awareness, fielding questions, updating data, adverse childhood experiences, and multi-disciplinary collaboration. Training exercises were included to build the skills of attendees as trainers on human trafficking and a Trainer Manual was provided to each attendee with printed materials and e-versions of resources for use in future trainings.
