## 7 Reasons to Come to the Craft Fair

For the 7th year, our church will host a craft fair on the first Saturday in October. Before we held this annual affair, I hadn't shopped such events, but I am a convert! Here are seven reasons why it's fun to come to the Ascension Craft Fair –

- 1. Stating the obvious come for the crafts! The people selling the crafts are usually the same people who make the crafts. They create items because they love doing it; this isn't a job, often it's a hobby, a labor of love. They look forward to meeting and talking with you about why they do what they do. Make a connection!
- 2. Come shop! Crafters rent table space from us and fill it with items for sale; usually handcrafted. It's almost certain you can find something you can use or give as a gift. - 5. Come to serve empty trash and keep the restrooms tidy, sell raffle tickets or cans of soda. There are dozens of things you can do to help, even for a half hour. As it's said, many hands make light work. Be welcoming and helpful!
- 6. Come bolster congregational outreach. The crafters paid to rent the tables and they expect to sell a good portion of the items they bring. If they see lots of foot traffic and sell their products, they'll be more likely to promote our craft fair and our church as a friendly place to spend the day. They'll come back, bringing their friends, encouraging their fellow crafters to rent space it's a virtuous cycle. Be neighborly!
- **7.** Come in support of our church's youth ministry. The Craft Fair serves as the primary fundraiser to fund youth and chaperones attending the Youth Gathering. The Gathering makes a lifelong Christian impact counter-acting the world's "post Christian" message. Spread Christ's love to the next generation!


**Eric and Sarah Eckhoff** – this married couple both teach at Martin Luther Academy, a K-8 school providing Lutheran education to families living north of the river.
