Daily Devotional for September 2025

Theme: In this harvest season I give thanks to God for all he has gifted me.

Week 1

Monday, September 1

- **Bible Passage:** Deuteronomy 8:7-10 (KJV) "For the LORD thy God bringeth thee into a good land, a land of brooks of water, of fountains and depths that spring out of valleys and hills; A land of wheat, and barley, and vines, and fig trees, and pomegranates; a land of oil olive, and honey; A land wherein thou shalt eat bread without scarceness, thou shalt not lack any thing in it; a land whose stones are iron, and out of whose hills thou mayest dig brass. When thou hast eaten and art full, then thou shalt bless the LORD thy God for the good land which he hath given thee."
- **Psalm:** Psalm 100:4-5 (KJV) "Enter into his gates with thanksgiving, and into his courts with praise: be thankful unto him, and bless his name. For the LORD is good; his mercy is everlasting; and his truth endureth to all generations."
- **Prayer:** Heavenly Father, as we begin this month, we thank You for bringing us into a good land, full of Your provision. Remind us to enter Your presence with a grateful heart, knowing that Your goodness, mercy, and truth endure forever. Amen.

Tuesday, September 2

- **Bible Passage:** Galatians 5:22-23 (KJV) "But the fruit of the Spirit is love, joy, peace, longsuffering, gentleness, goodness, faith, Meekness, temperance: against such there is no law."
- Psalm: Psalm 103:2 (KJV) "Bless the LORD, O my soul, and forget not all his benefits:"
- **Prayer:** Lord, we thank You for the spiritual harvest in our lives. Cultivate within us the beautiful fruit of Your Holy Spirit. Help us to never forget the benefits You have given us, and to live lives that reflect Your goodness. Amen.

Wednesday, September 3

- **Bible Passage:** Philippians 4:19 (KJV) "But my God shall supply all your need according to his riches in glory by Christ Jesus."
- **Psalm:** Psalm 104:24 (KJV) "O LORD, how manifold are thy works! in wisdom hast thou made them all: the earth is full of thy riches."
- **Prayer:** Gracious God, we thank You for supplying all our needs. As we look at the bounty of the earth and the richness of Your creation, we are filled with awe. Help us to trust in Your abundance. Amen.

Thursday, September 4

- **Bible Passage:** Ephesians 2:8-9 (KJV) "For by grace are ye saved through faith; and that not of yourselves: it is the gift of God: Not of works, lest any man should boast."
- **Psalm:** Psalm 107:1 (KJV) "O give thanks unto the LORD, for he is good: for his mercy endureth for ever."
- **Prayer:** Lord Jesus, we give You profound thanks for the gift of salvation, a gift of pure grace. We rejoice that our eternal hope is not based on our works, but on Your enduring goodness and mercy. Amen.

Friday, September 5

- **Bible Passage:** Romans 12:4-5 (KJV) "For as we have many members in one body, and all members have not the same office: So we, being many, are one body in Christ, and every one members one of another."
- **Psalm:** Psalm 133:1 (KJV) "Behold, how good and how pleasant it is for brethren to dwell together in unity!"
- **Prayer:** Lord, thank You for the gift of community, the blessing of being one body in Christ. Help us to value and support one another, dwelling together in pleasant unity. Amen.

Saturday, September 6

- **Bible Passage:** Lamentations 3:22-23 (KJV) "It is of the LORD's mercies that we are not consumed, because his compassions fail not. They are new every morning: great is thy faithfulness."
- **Psalm:** Psalm 136:1 (KJV) "O give thanks unto the LORD; for he is good: for his mercy endureth for ever."
- **Prayer:** O Lord, thank You for Your endless mercies and great faithfulness. We rejoice that Your compassion is new every morning, sustaining us with a love that endures forever. Amen.

Sunday, September 7

- **Bible Passage:** Psalm 119:105 (KJV) "Thy word is a lamp unto my feet, and a light unto my path."
- **Psalm:** Psalm 19:7-11 (KJV) "The law of the LORD is perfect, converting the soul: the testimony of the LORD is sure, making wise the simple. The statutes of the LORD are right, rejoicing the heart: the commandment of the LORD is pure, enlightening the eyes. The fear of the LORD is clean, enduring for ever: the judgments of the LORD are true and righteous altogether. More to be desired are they than gold, yea, than much fine gold: sweeter also than honey and the honeycomb. Moreover by them is thy servant warned: and in keeping of them there is great reward."
- **Prayer:** Lord, we thank You for the gift of Your perfect Word. It is a lamp for our feet and a light for our path. Make Your Word sweeter to us than honey, and guide us by its truth. Amen.



Monday, September 8

- **Bible Passage:** 1 Thessalonians 5:18 (KJV) "In every thing give thanks: for this is the will of God in Christ Jesus concerning you."
- **Psalm:** Psalm 34:1-3 (KJV) "I will bless the LORD at all times: his praise shall continually be in my mouth. My soul shall make her boast in the LORD: the humble shall hear thereof, and be glad. O magnify the LORD with me, and let us exalt his name together."
- **Prayer:** Lord, help us to give thanks in every circumstance, knowing that this is Your will for us. May our praise continually be on our lips, magnifying Your name in all we do. Amen.

Tuesday, September 9

- **Bible Passage:** Colossians 1:13-14 (KJV) "Who hath delivered us from the power of darkness, and hath translated us into the kingdom of his dear Son: In whom we have redemption through his blood, even the forgiveness of sins:"
- **Psalm:** Psalm 32:1-2 (KJV) "Blessed is he whose transgression is forgiven, whose sin is covered. Blessed is the man unto whom the LORD imputeth not iniquity, and in whose spirit there is no guile."
- Prayer: Lord, we are blessed to have been delivered from darkness and given the gift of forgiveness through the blood of Your Son. We thank You for covering our sins and not imputing iniquity to us. Amen.

Wednesday, September 10

- **Bible Passage:** Proverbs 3:5-6 (KJV) "Trust in the LORD with all thine heart; and lean not unto thine own understanding. In all thy ways acknowledge him, and he shall direct thy paths."
- **Psalm:** Psalm 111:10 (KJV) "The fear of the LORD is the beginning of wisdom: a good understanding have all they that do his commandments: his praise endureth for ever."
- **Prayer:** Lord, we thank You for the gift of wisdom that comes from trusting in You. Help us to acknowledge You in all our ways, that You may direct our paths and guide us to live in Your praise. Amen.

Thursday, September 11

- **Bible Passage:** John 3:16 (KJV) "For God so loved the world, that he gave his only begotten Son, that whosoever believeth in him should not perish, but have everlasting life."
- **Psalm:** Psalm 23:6 (KJV) "Surely goodness and mercy shall follow me all the days of my life: and I will dwell in the house of the LORD for ever."
- **Prayer:** Gracious God, we thank You for the incredible gift of Your Son, Jesus Christ, and for the promise of everlasting life. May Your goodness and mercy follow us every day, and may we rejoice in the hope of dwelling with You forever. Amen.

Friday, September 12

- **Bible Passage:** Isaiah 40:31 (KJV) "But they that wait upon the LORD shall renew their strength; they shall mount up with wings as eagles; they shall run, and not be weary; and they shall walk, and not faint."
- **Psalm:** Psalm 28:7 (KJV) "The LORD is my strength and my shield; my heart trusted in him, and I am helped: therefore my heart greatly rejoiceth; and with my song will I praise him."

• **Prayer:** Lord, we thank You for renewing our strength when we wait upon You. Be our shield and our help, and fill our hearts with great joy so that we may praise You with our songs. Amen.

Saturday, September 13

- **Bible Passage:** Ephesians 6:2-3 (KJV) "Honour thy father and mother; which is the first commandment with promise; That it may be well with thee, and thou mayest live long on the earth."
- **Psalm:** Psalm 127:3 (KJV) "Lo, children are an heritage of the LORD: and the fruit of the womb is his reward."
- **Prayer:** Lord, we thank You for the gift of family, a precious heritage from You. Help us to honor and love our parents, and to treasure the children and family members You have given to us. Amen.

Sunday, September 14

- **Bible Passage:** Psalm 95:6-7 (KJV) "O come, let us worship and bow down: let us kneel before the LORD our maker. For he is our God; and we are the people of his pasture, and the sheep of his hand."
- **Psalm:** Psalm 95:1-6 (KJV) "O come, let us sing unto the LORD: let us make a joyful noise to the rock of our salvation. Let us come before his presence with thanksgiving, and make a joyful noise unto him with psalms. For the LORD is a great God, and a great King above all gods. In his hand are the deep places of the earth: the strength of the hills is his also. The sea is his, and he made it: and his hands formed the dry land. O come, let us worship and bow down: let us kneel before the LORD our maker."
- **Prayer:** Lord God, thank You for the gift of worship. We come before You with thanksgiving and praise. Help us to remember that You are our Maker and our God, and we are the sheep of Your pasture. Amen.

Monday, September 15

- **Bible Passage:** Matthew 11:28 (KJV) "Come unto me, all ye that labour and are heavy laden, and I will give you rest."
- **Psalm:** Psalm 4:8 (KJV) "I will both lay me down in peace, and sleep: for thou, LORD, only makest me dwell in safety."
- Prayer: Lord Jesus, thank You for the gift of rest. When we are weary and heavy laden, help
 us to come to You. Remind us that in You alone, we can find peace and rest in Your safety.
 Amen.

Tuesday, September 16

- **Bible Passage:** John 14:26 (KJV) "But the Comforter, which is the Holy Ghost, whom the Father will send in my name, he shall teach you all things, and bring all things to your remembrance, whatsoever I have said unto you."
- **Psalm:** Psalm 143:10 (KJV) "Teach me to do thy will; for thou art my God: thy spirit is good; lead me into the land of uprightness."
- **Prayer:** Lord, we thank You for the gift of the Holy Spirit, our Comforter and our Teacher. Lead us by Your good Spirit, so we may learn to do Your will and walk in uprightness. Amen.

Wednesday, September 17

- **Bible Passage:** Colossians 3:23-24 (KJV) "And whatsoever ye do, do it heartily, as to the Lord, and not unto men; Knowing that of the Lord ye shall receive the reward of the inheritance: for ye serve the Lord Christ."
- **Psalm:** Psalm 90:17 (KJV) "And let the beauty of the LORD our God be upon us: and establish thou the work of our hands upon us; yea, the work of our hands establish thou it."
- **Prayer:** Lord, thank You for the gift of meaningful work. Help us to do all things heartily for You, knowing that You establish the work of our hands. May the beauty of Your presence be upon us. Amen.

Thursday, September 18

- **Bible Passage:** Jeremiah 29:12-13 (KJV) "Then shall ye call upon me, and ye shall go and pray unto me, and I will hearken unto you. And ye shall seek me, and find me, when ye shall search for me with all your heart."
- **Psalm:** Psalm 116:1-2 (KJV) "I love the LORD, because he hath heard my voice and my supplications. Because he hath inclined his ear unto me, therefore will I call upon him as long as I live."
- **Prayer:** Lord, we thank You for the gift of prayer and the assurance that You hear us. We are grateful that when we call upon You, You incline Your ear and answer. We will call upon You as long as we live. Amen.

Friday, September 19

- Bible Passage: Nehemiah 8:10 (KJV) "for the joy of the LORD is your strength."
- **Psalm:** Psalm 16:11 (KJV) "Thou wilt shew me the path of life: in thy presence is fulness of joy; at thy right hand there are pleasures for evermore."
- **Prayer:** Lord, we thank You for the gift of joy. We find our strength in You. Show us the path of life, and fill us with the fullness of joy that comes from being in Your presence. Amen.

Saturday, September 20

- **Bible Passage:** 3 John 1:2 (KJV) "Beloved, I wish above all things that thou mayest prosper and be in health, even as thy soul prospereth."
- Psalm: Psalm 30:2 (KJV) "O LORD my God, I cried unto thee, and thou hast healed me."
- **Prayer:** Lord, we thank You for the gift of health and the blessing of physical well-being. We give You thanks for healing and restoration. May our souls prosper in You, and may our bodies be strong to serve You. Amen.

Sunday, September 21

- **Bible Passage:** 1 John 1:9 (KJV) "If we confess our sins, he is faithful and just to forgive us our sins, and to cleanse us from all unrighteousness."
- **Psalm:** Psalm 51:10 (KJV) "Create in me a clean heart, O God; and renew a right spirit within me."
- **Prayer:** Lord, we thank You for the precious gift of forgiveness. We are so grateful that You are faithful and just to cleanse us from all unrighteousness. Create in us a clean heart and a right spirit. Amen.



Monday, September 22

- **Bible Passage:** Psalm 91:4 (KJV) "He shall cover thee with his feathers, and under his wings shalt thou trust: his truth shall be thy shield and buckler."
- **Psalm:** Psalm 91:1-4 (KJV) "He that dwelleth in the secret place of the most High shall abide under the shadow of the Almighty. I will say of the LORD, He is my refuge and my fortress: my God; in him will I trust. Surely he shall deliver thee from the snare of the fowler, and from the noisome pestilence. He shall cover thee with his feathers, and under his wings shalt thou trust: his truth shall be thy shield and buckler."
- **Prayer:** Lord, we thank You for the gift of Your protection. You are our refuge and our fortress, our shield and our buckler. We trust in You and rest securely under the shadow of Your wings. Amen.

Tuesday, September 23

- **Bible Passage:** Psalm 127:3-5 (KJV) "Lo, children are an heritage of the LORD: and the fruit of the womb is his reward. As arrows are in the hand of a mighty man; so are children of the youth. Happy is the man that hath his quiver full of them: they shall not be ashamed, but they shall speak with the enemies in the gate."
- **Psalm:** Psalm 128:3 (KJV) "Thy wife shall be as a fruitful vine by the sides of thine house: thy children like olive plants round about thy table."
- **Prayer:** Lord, we thank You for the children and family members You have gifted to us. We rejoice in this precious heritage from You. Help us to raise them in Your truth, and may our homes be a reflection of Your love and faithfulness. Amen.

Wednesday, September 24

- **Bible Passage:** Psalm 104:27-28 (KJV) "These wait all upon thee; that thou mayest give them their meat in due season. That thou givest them they gather: thou openest thine hand, they are filled with good."
- **Psalm:** Psalm 145:15-16 (KJV) "The eyes of all wait upon thee; and thou givest them their meat in due season. Thou openest thine hand, and satisfiest the desire of every living thing."
- **Prayer:** Lord, we give thanks for our daily bread and for Your constant provision. We know that the eyes of all creatures wait upon You. You open Your hand and fill us with good things. Amen.

Thursday, September 25

- **Bible Passage:** Mark 2:27 (KJV) "And he said unto them, The sabbath was made for man, and not man for the sabbath:"
- **Psalm:** Psalm 116:7 (KJV) "Return unto thy rest, O my soul; for the LORD hath dealt bountifully with thee."
- **Prayer:** Lord, thank You for the gift of rest and the Sabbath. Help us to find true rest in You, remembering that You have dealt bountifully with us. We return to You, our source of peace. Amen.

Friday, September 26

• **Bible Passage:** Proverbs 17:17 (KJV) - "A friend loveth at all times, and a brother is born for adversity."

- **Psalm:** Psalm 16:3 (KJV) "But to the saints that are in the earth, and to the excellent, in whom is all my delight."
- **Prayer:** Lord, we give thanks for the gift of friends and brothers in Christ. We are grateful for those who love us in all times. Help us to be a delight to the saints and a true friend to others. Amen.

Saturday, September 27

- **Bible Passage:** Psalm 98:4 (KJV) "Make a joyful noise unto the LORD, all the earth: make a loud noise, and rejoice, and sing praise."
- **Psalm:** Psalm 96:1-3 (KJV) "O sing unto the LORD a new song: sing unto the LORD, all the earth. Sing unto the LORD, bless his name; shew forth his salvation from day to day. Declare his glory among the heathen, his wonders among all people."
- **Prayer:** Lord, we thank You for the gift of music and the ability to praise You. Fill our hearts and voices with a new song and help us to declare Your glory and wonders to the world. Amen.

Sunday, September 28

- **Bible Passage:** 1 Corinthians 12:4-6 (KJV) "Now there are diversities of gifts, but the same Spirit. And there are differences of administrations, but the same Lord. And there are diversities of operations, but it is the same God which worketh all in all."
- **Psalm:** Psalm 145:4 (KJV) "One generation shall praise thy works to another, and shall declare thy mighty acts."
- **Prayer:** Lord, we thank You for the diverse spiritual gifts You have given to Your Church. Help us to use our unique gifts to serve one another and to declare Your mighty acts from one generation to the next. Amen.



Monday, September 29

- **Bible Passage:** Psalm 103:11-12 (KJV) "For as the heaven is high above the earth, so great is his mercy toward them that fear him. As far as the east is from the west, so far hath he removed our transgressions from us."
- **Psalm:** Psalm 103:1-5 (KJV) "Bless the LORD, O my soul: and all that is within me, bless his holy name. Bless the LORD, O my soul, and forget not all his benefits: Who forgiveth all thine iniquities; who healeth all thy diseases; Who redeemeth thy life from destruction; who crowneth thee with lovingkindness and tender mercies; Who satisfieth thy mouth with good things; so that thy youth is renewed like the eagle's."
- **Prayer:** Lord, we are overwhelmed by the greatness of Your mercy and lovingkindness. Thank You for removing our transgressions so far from us. We bless Your holy name and will not forget all Your benefits. Amen.

Tuesday, September 30

- **Bible Passage:** Colossians 3:15 (KJV) "And let the peace of God rule in your hearts, to the which also ye are called in one body; and be ye thankful."
- **Psalm:** Psalm 100:1-5 (KJV) "Make a joyful noise unto the LORD, all ye lands. Serve the LORD with gladness: come before his presence with singing. Know ye that the LORD he is God: it is he that hath made us, and not we ourselves; we are his people, and the sheep of his pasture. Enter into his gates with thanksgiving, and into his courts with praise: be thankful unto him, and bless his name. For the LORD is good; his mercy is everlasting; and his truth endureth to all generations."
- **Prayer:** Lord God, as we conclude this month, let Your peace rule in our hearts. We are thankful for the harvest of Your blessings, both physical and spiritual. Help us to serve You with gladness and enter Your gates with a thankful heart, forever praising Your good and merciful name. Amen.
