Mon Apr 6	Luke 24:13–35	Psalm 105	Lord, stay with us and open our eyes to recognize You in the breaking of bread.
Tue Apr 7	Acts 10:34–43	Psalm 148	We thank Thee, Lord, that the Gospel is for all people through Your Name.

Wed Apr 8	1 Corinthians 15:1–11	Psalm 98	Lord, keep us steadfast in the Gospel which we have received.
Thu Apr 9	1 Corinthians 15:12–20	Psalm 30	Thank You, Christ, for being the firstfruits of them that slept.
Fri Apr 10	1 Corinthians 15:21–28	Psalm 8	We rejoice that You have put all enemies under Your feet, even death.
Sat Apr 11	1 Corinthians 15:50–58	Psalm 149	Lord, give us the victory through our Lord Jesus Christ.
Sun Apr 12	John 20:19–31	Psalm 148	<i>Easter II:</i> Grant us the peace that passes understanding and strengthens our faith.
Mon Apr 13	Acts 5:29–42	Psalm 34	Lord, grant us boldness to obey God rather than men.
Tue Apr 14	1 Peter 1:3–9	Psalm 147	We thank Thee for a lively hope through the resurrection of Jesus Christ.
Wed Apr 15	John 21:1–14	Psalm 96	Lord, nourish us by Your Word as You fed the disciples by the sea.
Thu Apr 16	Acts 3:11–21	Psalm 4	We thank Thee for the times of refreshing that come from Your presence.
Fri Apr 17	1 John 3:1–7	Psalm 133	Behold what manner of love! Thank You for calling us the sons of God.

Sat Apr 18	Luke 24:36–49	Psalm 111	Lord, open our understandings that we might understand the Scriptures.
Sun Apr 19	John 10:11–18	Psalm 23	<i>Easter III:</i> We thank Thee, Good Shepherd, for laying down Thy life for the sheep.
Mon Apr 20	Acts 4:1–12	Psalm 100	There is none other name under heaven given whereby we must be saved.
Tue Apr 21	1 John 3:16–24	Psalm 139	Lord, teach us to love not in word only, but in deed and in truth.
Wed Apr 22	Ezekiel 34:11–16	Psalm 80	We thank Thee for seeking us when we were lost and binding up our wounds.
Thu Apr 23	John 15:1–8	Psalm 80	Lord, help us to abide in Thee, the True Vine, that we may bear much fruit.
Fri Apr 24	1 John 4:1–11	Psalm 66	Thank You, Father, for sending Your Son to be the propitiation for our sins.
Sat Apr 25	Mark 13:5–13	Psalm 119:1–8	<i>St. Mark:</i> We thank Thee for the strength to endure and testify of Your truth.
Sun Apr 26	John 15:1–8	Psalm 150	<i>Easter IV:</i> Resurrect our joy, Lord, as we dwell in Your love and Word.

Mon Apr 27	Acts 8:26–40	Psalm 67	Lord, lead us to those seeking the truth, that we may share Christ with them.
Tue Apr 28	1 John 4:12–21	Psalm 145	We thank Thee that there is no fear in love, for Your perfect love casts out fear.
Wed Apr 29	John 14:1–14	Psalm 33	Let not our hearts be troubled; we thank Thee for the place You prepare for us.
Thu Apr 30	Acts 11:1–18	Psalm 117	We praise Thee, Lord, for granting repentance unto life to all nations.
