TO BE ELIGIBLE TO STAND FOR ELECTION

A candidate must:

- ✓ Be aged 18 years or over
- ✓ Be a registered member of Ngāti Hinemanu, Ngāi Te Ūpokoiri me ōna Piringa Hapū Authority Trust
- Have one person who is an adult registered member of the Trust sign the nomination form
- ✓ Be resident in Aotearoa

INFORMATION FOR CANDIDATES

1. Candidate Eligibility

The eligibility requirements are outlined in Schedule One of the Trust Deed.

To be eligible as a candidate, you must be a registered adult (over 20 years old) member of the Trust. A member of the Trust is defined in the Trust Deed as someone who descends from any one of the hapū of Ngāti Hinemanu, Ngai Te Ūpokoiri, Ngāti Mahuika and Honomokai and who affiliates to the Hapū; and is registered on the Trust Membership Register.

You must also meet the requirements associated with officer eligibility as outlined on the nominations form, including those in the Charities Act 2005. This includes not being an undischarged bankrupt and not having recently (within the last 7 years) been convicted of certain crimes.

Current employees may not hold the position of a trustee concurrently. Employees may be nominated and if appointed, must resign from their employed position.

2. Key Dates

- Nominations open 25 September 2025
- Nominations close 18 October 2025
- A copy of the public notice will be published online via e-pānui and on social media.
- Voting packs will be posted to all <u>registered</u> adult uri (over the age of 18 years) with a valid postal address
- Voting will close at 12.00pm on 17 November 2025
- Results will be announced at the Hui a Tau (AGM) on Saturday, 29 November 2025.

3. Submitting a Nomination

4. Ministry of Justic Criminal Record

Upon submission of this nomination, Ministry of Justice checks will be completed by the Trust. This is a requirement of many of our funding contracts. For this reason, photo identification is required.

5. Curriculum Vitae

A brief curriculum vitae (CV) no more than four A4 pages in length must be provided (as a Word.doc) containing details of the candidates experience relevant to the role of Trustee (See Terms of Reference).

It is recommended that the CV include the following information:

- Iwi and hapū affiliations
- Occupation
- Current qualifications
- Personal Interests
- Community Involvement
- · Candidate Statement

6. Photo

Must include a recent (i.e. less than one year old) photograph of the candidate only (i.e. not part of a group). Photos may be in an electronic format (scanned as an attachment on email), or hard copy. Photos will be printed in colour. (Note that photos will not be returned to candidates).

7. Candidate Biography

A statement (a maximum of 300 words) must be confined to information concerning the candidate, and the candidate's policies and intentions if elected. This will be included in the Voting Pack

The Returning Officer reserves the right to:

- Collate information to be included in voting material to be forwarded to registered members, if an election is required.
- Redact personal phone numbers and street addresses of the candidate and their nominators, for privacy.
