General Rules	<ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1. Limit of three (3) quilts per entrant. If entering more than 1 quilt, indicate your priority for consideration: 1, 2, or 3. Priority will be considered when the total number of qualified entries for the show is excessive and must be limited. All entries accepted will be judged. 2. All entries must be quilted. A quilted entry consists of three (3) layers, primarily fabric, held together by stitching. Quilting stitches pierce all three (3) layers and are distributed throughout the entry. EXCEPT for those placed in the Potpourri category (if offered). 3. No tied quilts will be accepted. NO WEIGHTS OR FRAMING OF ANY KIND SHOULD BE ADDED TO THE QUILT. Quilts with electrical components are not accepted. 4. All entries must have been completed within the last five (5) years. Please do not submit entries completed before January 1, 2021. 5. All entries must be clean, smoke free, labeled, and ready to hang. Detailed instructions will be included in the jury acceptance letter. 6. No items entered and shown in previous Three Rivers Quilt Shows should be submitted. 7. Category (ALL Categories – Max. width 96")	Size – perimeter (add all 4 sides)	# of Makers	Description (Any number of makers <u>except</u> in Solo categories)
Theme	Any size.	1 or more	Quilt reflects show theme "Log Cabin". (All techniques, any number of makers.) Definition: Quilts made using the Log Cabin design in blocks.
Appliqué	Any size.	1 or more	Appliqué is the predominant technique (90%)
Modern	Any Size	1 or more	Functional rather than decorative design, asymmetric design, increased negative space, improvisational piecing, modern art/architectural inspired design, simplistic and/or minimalist.
Pieced Small - Solo	<300"	Only 1	Piecing is predominant technique - made for bed, lap quilt, baby quilt – only 1 maker
Pieced Small	<300"	1 or more	Piecing is predominant technique - made for bed, lap quilt, baby quilt
Pieced Large – Solo	>300"	Only 1	Piecing is predominant technique (90%). (Made for a bed) – only 1 maker
Pieced Large	>300"	1 or more	Piecing is predominant technique (90%). (Made for a bed)
Wall Hanging	Any Size	1 or more	Pieced or Applique – made to hang on the wall
Art	Any Size	1 or more	Any art form that uses traditional and non-traditional quilting techniques to create fiber art objects (such as pictures, paintings and landscapes) usually to be hung on a wall.
Kits/Block of the Month (Pieced quilts only)	Any Size	1 or more	Any <u>pieced</u> quilt made from a kit or Block of the Month pattern where the fabrics have been pre-selected by a quilt shop or designer and used in your quilt (even if some provided fabrics were substituted). Includes patterns with pre-selected/pre-fused fabrics.
Mixed Technique	Any Size	1 or more	Balanced combination of both appliqué and piecing; including embroidery & other needlework techniques in any combination.
Potpourri	Any Size	1 or more	Crazy Quilt, Yo-Yo, Wool, Cathedral Windows or Wholecloth (no tied quilts will be accepted) Use this category if your quilt does not seem to fit in any other category.

- One **completed**, signed entry form for each entry.
- (2) color 4" x 6" photos (non-returnable) for each entry (**Full** front view & **Close-up** of front stitching). Nothing larger than 4x6 please!
- **ENTRY FEE: \$15.00 for 1st entry, \$10 each additional entry (ENTRIES MUST INCLUDE PHOTOS).**
- Members of Three Rivers Quilters, Inc. get their first entry for a \$1 handling fee, \$10 for each additional entry. (\$1 for each photo that has to be printed by the guild.)
- Make checks out to "Three Rivers Quilters, Inc." (No cash, *exception for TRQ members' \$1 entry & photo charges*).
