SCHOLARSHIPS

Forty \$1,000 scholarships will be awarded this year. Twenty of the scholarships are awarded based on scholastics, and twenty by random drawing.

The Central Midwest Regional Council scholastic scholarships are awarded based on 60% high school grade point average and 40% on SAT or ACT scores. Twenty scholarships will be selected by random drawing.

The scholarship is to be used solely for the purpose of education in the form of tuition, room and board and or books.

Sons, daughters, and dependent children of members of the Central Midwest Regional Council of Carpenters and Millwrights are eligible for scholarships provided that they meet the following criteria:

***The parent or guardian is now and has been a member in good standing of the Central Midwest Regional Council of Carpenters for at least one year.**

*The son, daughter, or dependent child is a high school graduating senior in high school. This is not available for students already attending college or trade school.

*The son, daughter, or dependent child who will be attending a college, university, or trade school as a full-time student in fall of 2026.

*Application is received at the Council office prior to Friday, March 20, 2026.
