

How would this evidence be collected?

Knife- In order to collect a knife that has blood present, the blade and point would be wrapped in stiff unmovable cardboard and then placed in a paper bag or envelope. (Individual Evidence)

Blood Spatter- Blood spatter would be collected by scraping, if the deposit is crusty or flaky, and stored in a paper fold. Dried blood smears can be collected on moist pieces of cotton, cloth, or cotton swabs. (Class Evidence) Footprints- Patent prints would photographed, casted, and lifted by using powders and chemicals. (Individua Evidence).


Shirt Fiber- Fiber can be collected by using tweezers, vacuuming, and tape lifting. (Class Evidence, can lead to Individual Evidence).
