**URGENT: Uganda's Military Intervention in South Sudan Must End Immediately**

**Bombing of Civilians with Attack Helicopters & Incendiary Bombs is a War Crime**

**Mass Atrocities Underway: Uganda's War Crimes Against South Sudanese Civilians**

Over the past four days, Uganda has escalated its direct military intervention in South Sudan by launching indiscriminate airstrikes on civilian villages using MI-28 attack helicopters and Antonov bombers.

These illegal aerial attacks have specifically targeted Nuer and Equatorian communities, dropping incendiary bombs and chemical agents—causing mass deaths, civilian burn injuries, and the destruction of entire villages.

This **unprecedented war crime** is happening in real time, and unless the international community acts **immediately**, thousands more South Sudanese civilians will be killed in the coming days.

**Key Facts About Uganda's Military Attacks on South Sudanese Civilians**

1. Ugandan MI-28 attack helicopters have bombed Nuer civilian villages in Nasir, Ulang, Longuchuk, and Mabaan counties.

2. Antonov aircraft, coordinated from Juba, have dropped incendiary weapons on densely populated areas, burning civilians alive.
3. Chemical agents have been deployed—early reports suggest ethyl acetate bombs have been used, violating the **Chemical Weapons Convention and international humanitarian law**.
4. The airstrikes have not targeted military forces, but civilian populations, an act that constitutes a **war crime under the Geneva Conventions**.
5. The attack is part of a coordinated operation by President Salva Kiir's regime to delegitimize opposition groups and terrorize ethnic communities into submission.

## **URGENT CALL TO ACTION: WHAT THE WORLD MUST DO NOW**

### **1. Immediate UN Security Council Emergency Session**

The **UN must urgently convene an emergency session** to address **Uganda's illegal war crimes in South Sudan**.

- Sanctions must be imposed on Ugandan military leaders responsible for airstrikes.
- An immediate ceasefire must be enforced, with threats of further diplomatic action against Uganda if it continues its military aggression.

### **2. AU & IGAD Must Intervene to Halt Uganda's Role in South Sudan**

The **African Union and IGAD must take an immediate stand** against Uganda's violations of **South Sudan's sovereignty and human rights**.

- African nations cannot stay silent while Uganda bombs South Sudanese civilians in cold blood.
- An AU Peacekeeping Force should be deployed to investigate and stop further military aggression.

### **3. U.S., UK, and EU Must Issue Sanctions Against Ugandan Military Leaders**

The international community must not fund Uganda's war crimes.

- The U.S., UK, EU, and Troika nations must freeze military aid and cooperation with Uganda until it withdraws all forces from South Sudan.
- Sanctions must be expanded to target Ugandan generals, financial institutions, and government officials involved in South Sudan's war.

#### **4. ICC Investigation into Uganda & South Sudan's War Crimes**

The **International Criminal Court (ICC) must investigate Uganda's direct involvement in war crimes in South Sudan.**

- Eyewitness reports and forensic evidence must be compiled to hold Uganda's military accountable.
- Arrest warrants should be issued for Ugandan commanders authorizing airstrikes on civilians.

Uganda's direct military aggression is no longer just an intervention—it is an occupation.

- This is not peacekeeping; this is a foreign government actively killing South Sudanese citizens.

If Uganda is not stopped now, its military occupation of South Sudan will escalate into a regional war involving Sudan, Ethiopia, and other neighboring states.

The world must **act today**—not after another genocide unfolds.
