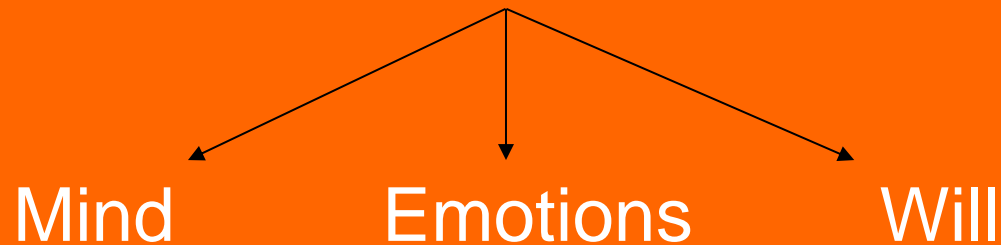

³ And he sought to see who Jesus was, but could not because of the crowd, for he was of short stature.



Luke 19:2-9 NKJV

⁴ So he ran ahead and climbed up into a sycamore tree to see Him, for He was going to pass that way.

⁵ And when Jesus came to the place, He looked up and saw him, and said to him, “Zacchaeus, make haste and come down, for today I must stay at your house.”



Zacchaeus was determined
to overcome his personal problem of being short.



Zacchaeus was intentional
to find a way to see Jesus.

Luke 19:2-9 NKJV

.....⁸ Then Zacchaeus stood and said to the Lord, “Look, Lord, I give half of my goods to the poor; and if I have taken anything from anyone by false accusation, I restore fourfold.”



Zacchaeus Repented

If a person has really wanted to accept Jesus as saviour then repentance is seen as evidence of true Salvation.

By a change of heart and direction.

..... people soon began bringing to him all who were sick.... he healed them all. Matthew 4:24 NLT

- The woman bleeding for 12 years – healed (Luke 8:43)
- Blind Bartimaeus – healed (Mark 10:46)
- Jairus – his daughter raised from the dead (Mark 5:22-23)
- The 10 lepers – healed (Luke 10:12-13)
- The disciples afraid – he calmed the storm (Mark 4:38)
- The Gadarene demoniac – cast out the demon (Luke:27)

Jesus said to him,

“I am the way, the truth, and the life. No one comes to the Father except through Me.”

John 14:6 NKJV

If we want to experience the ABUNDANT
life that God promised

We need to walk in the way of Jesus
and hear the truth of Jesus

And you shall know the truth, and the truth
shall make you free – John 8:32 NKJV

If the truth will make us free.

We need more truth of Jesus,
not more intellectual knowledge of the truth.

We need to apply the truth to our lives.

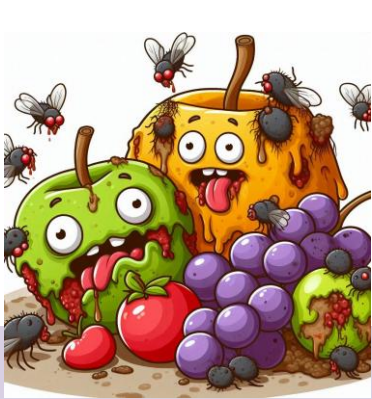

The Fruit of Sin

Fear

Guilt and shame

Loss of relationship with God

Slavery and Bondage

It hurts others

Physical sickness and even physical death

EVENTUALLY Judgement by God

How have we sinned?

By Sin, Transgression and Iniquity

¹ Blot out my transgressions (**pasha**).

²Wash me thoroughly from my iniquity (**avon**),
And cleanse me from my sin (**chattaah**).

Psalms 51:1-2 NKJV

What is Sin?

**Sin (chattah and chet)
both come from root chata**

Sin is a general term for falling short of God's standard.

Sin can be intentional or unintentional (Numbers 15:27)

Sin is not only doing something wrong,
it is also failing to do what is right (James 4:17)

Who has Sinned?

For all have sinned and fall short of the glory of God.
Romans 3:23 NKJV

All have sinned.
All fall short of the glory God intended.

What is Transgression?

Transgression (pesha)

Transgression means
to disobey knowingly and deliberately (Romans 4:15)

..... the Law [what was its purpose]?

It was added [after the promise to Abraham, to reveal to people their guilt] because of transgressions [that is, to make people conscious of the sinfulness of sin],

Galations 3:19 AMP

The law of God makes us aware of our sin,
to deliberately disobey by transgression

What is Iniquity?

Iniquity (avon)

Iniquity is a perversion of the truth
and a twisted attitude
that makes plans to commit sin.

Woe to those who plan iniquity (avon) , to those who
plot evil on their beds! Micah 2:1 NIV

What are the effects of Iniquity

And the tongue is a fire, a world of iniquity. The tongue is so set among our members that it defiles the whole body James 3:6 NKJV

The words we speak are important.

Iniquity defiles our character.

Example of Stealing.

Sin

Mistakenly taking someone's bottle of drink at work

Transgression

Seeing a colleague's bottle of drink at work.

You take it deliberately

Iniquity

Your company supplies drink for employees at work.

You justify and take several bottles home every night

God Makes a Way

For the wages of sin is death, but the gift of God is eternal life in Christ Jesus our Lord.

Romans 6:23 NKJV

Wages are what we earn and deserve

The gift from God is free and undeserved

What do we need to do?

Godly sorrow brings repentance that leads to salvation and leaves no regret, but worldly sorrow brings death.

2 Corinthians 7:10 NIV

First we need to recognise our sin and repent.

This means to grieve for our sins

Repentance is an essential pathway to salvation then

⁹ If you openly declare that Jesus is Lord and believe in your heart that God raised him from the dead, you will be saved.

¹⁰ For it is by believing in your heart that you are made right with God, and it is by openly declaring your faith that you are saved. Romans 10:9-10 NLT

Believe Jesus died and rose again
to take away your sins.

Openly declare your faith that ...

Jesus paid for our
Sin, Transgression and Iniquity

⁵But He was wounded for our transgressions (**pasha**), He was bruised for our iniquities (**avon**);

¹¹.....For He shall bear their iniquities (**avon**).

¹²..... And He was numbered with the transgressors (**pasha**),
And He bore the sin (**chet**) of many

Isaiah 53:5-12 NKJV

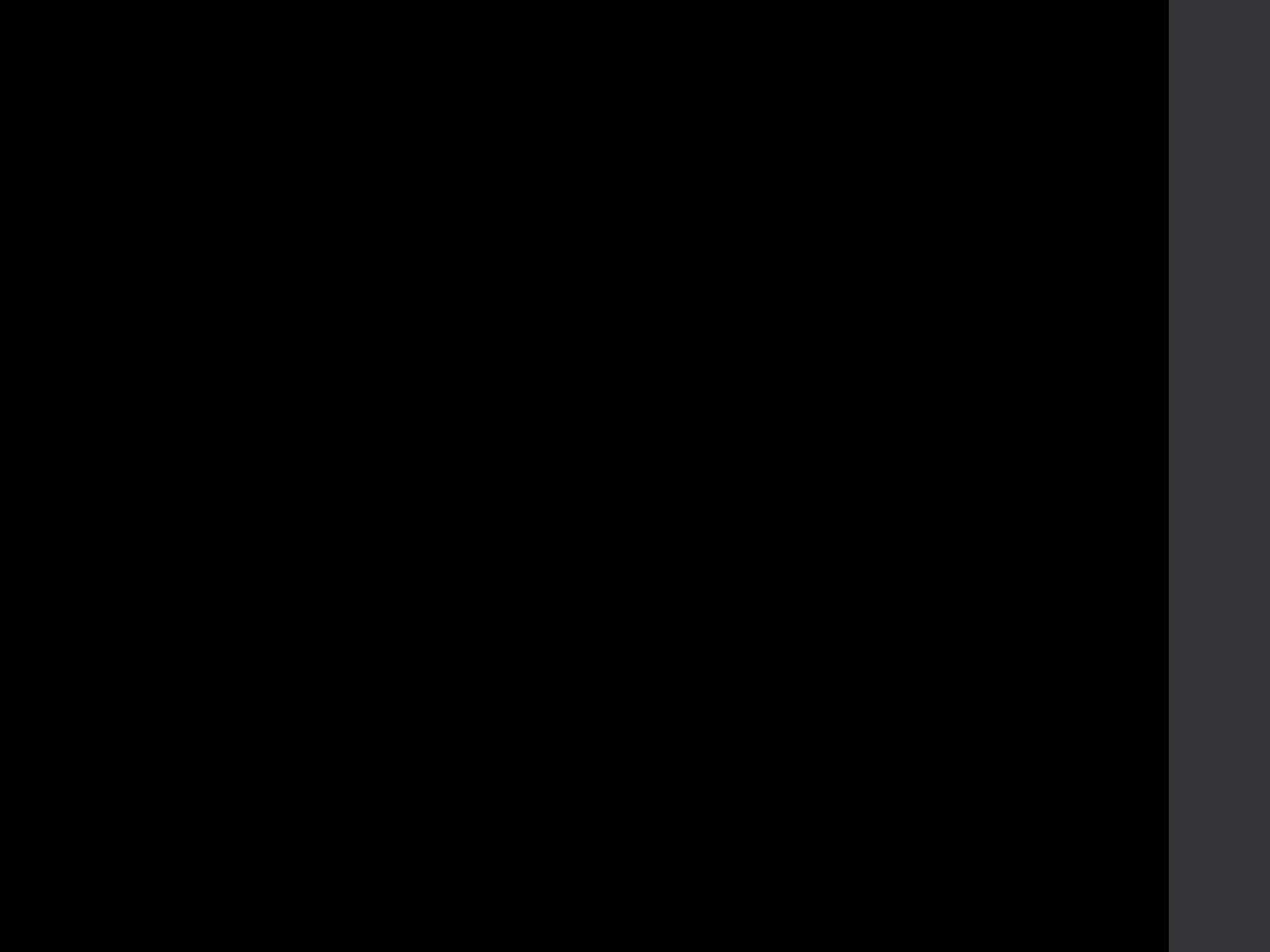

**Justification is

..... having been justified by faith, we
have peace with God through our Lord
Jesus Christ, Romans 5:1 NKJV

Justification
means

Just as if I had never sinned

Since Christ bore our penalty on
the cross we received freedom
from the penalty of ALL sins –

Past sins
Present sins
Future sins

Sanctification
means

Freedom from Sin's Power

Sanctification is
the slow moving growth
into becoming more like Christ.

Sanctification
is the process
of being
transformed

And do not be conformed to this world

but be transformed and progressively changed [as you mature spiritually] by the renewing of your mind [focusing on godly values and ethical attitudes],

Romans 12:2 AMP

Be transformed
and progressively changed

How are we transformed?



By the renewing of our minds

Transformed is “metamorphosis.”
From a caterpillar to a butterfly



Refers to the inner process
that leads to an outward,
permanent change.

Concentrating on the Godly Behaviours

Practise God's ways
(1 Timothy 4:7)

Put on the Armour of God
(Ephesians 6:11)

Think on these things
(Philippians 4:8)

An Example of Identity Theft based on:

Physical Appearance

Lie #1

Focusing on self and our outward appearance as all important (idolatry)

Lie # 2

Comparison of yourself with others (envy, greed, pride)

Lie # 3

Focused on what others think and say about us (fear of man)

From Sinful Nature

to Fruit of the Spirit

Natural Sinful Nature (Galations 5:19-21)

adultery, premarital sex, lust, pornography, idolatry, drug use, witchcraft, hatred, quarrelling, jealousies, anger, selfishness, conflict, rivalry, envy, murders, gluttony, drunkenness, wild parties and similar

Fruit of the Spirit (Galations 5:22-23)

[responsible for all this inequality]?

Satan is our enemy.

Job was
acting out
of fear



For the thing I greatly feared has
come upon me, and what I
dreaded has happened to me.
Job 3:25 NKJV

Fear can open the door
to a legal attack by Satan

¹But now, stretch out Your hand and touch all that he has, and he will surely curse You to Your face!”

¹²And the LORD said to Satan, “Behold, all that he has is in your power; only do not lay a hand on his person.” Job 1:11-12 NKJV

Satan was permitted
to attack Job

Job blames others

May the day perish on which I was
born, and the night in which it was
said, 'A male child is conceived.'
Job 3:3 NKJV

Job first blamed his parents

But You have become cruel to me;
with the strength of Your hand You
oppose me. Job 30:21 NKJV

Then Job blames God

Job repented

³ You asked, ‘Who is this that questions my wisdom with such ignorance?’ It is I—and I was talking about things I knew nothing about, things far too wonderful for me....

Job was restored after he repented.

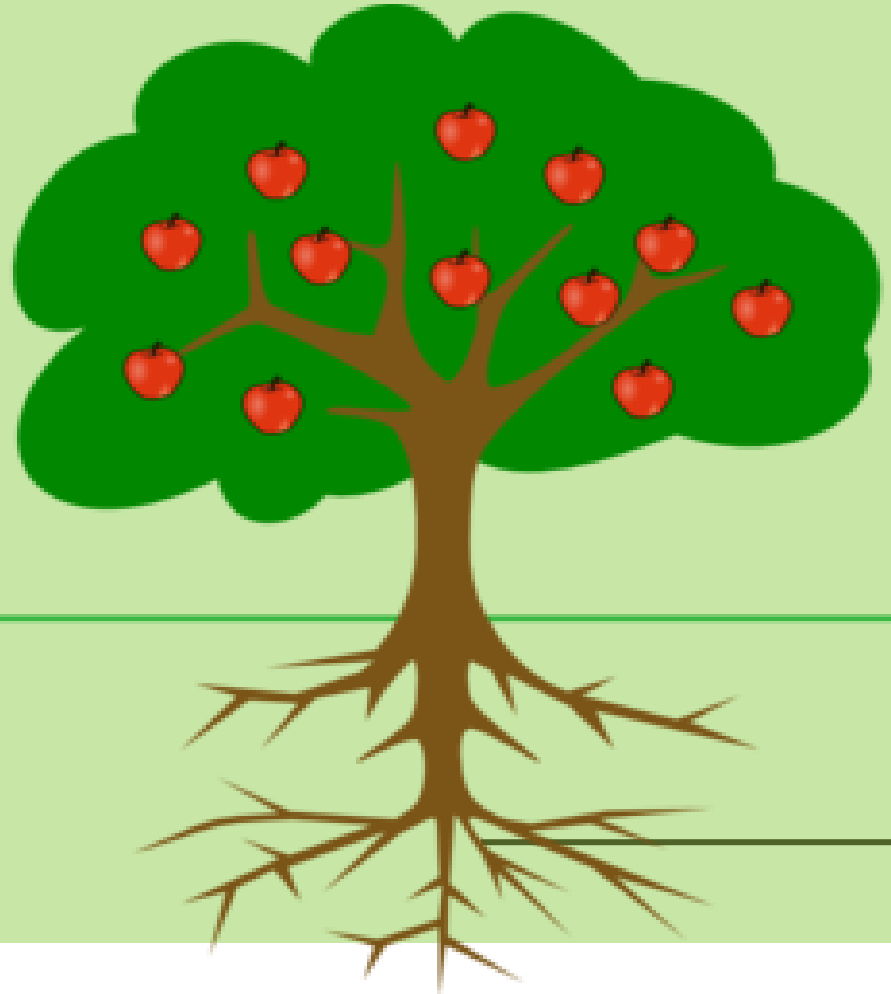

..... I give you the authority to trample on serpents and scorpions, and over all the power of the enemy, and nothing shall by any means hurt you. Luke 10:19 NKJV

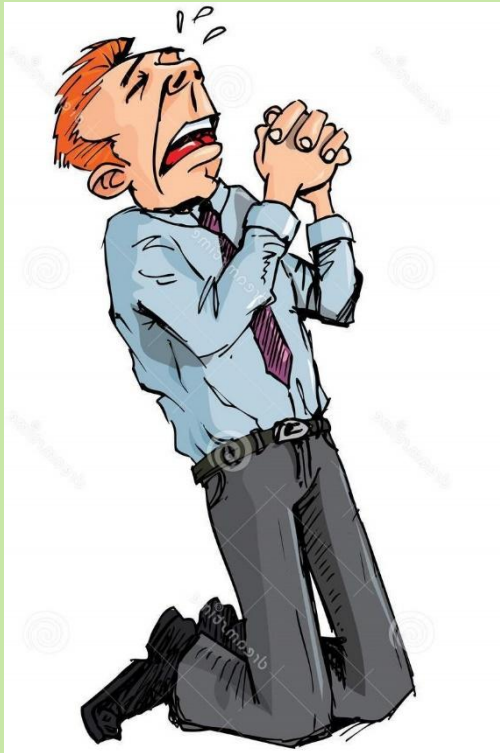

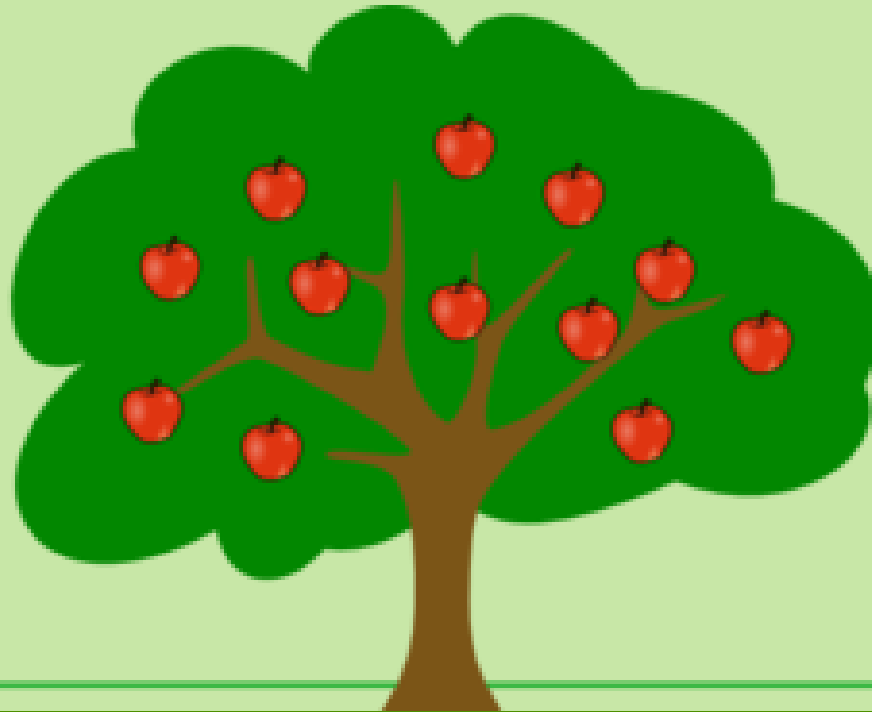
