Job Details:

Intern Position Summary:

The campus ministry student intern would assist the UM Campus Minister in developing an overall vision for creating and maintaining a progressive, open and affirming campus ministry student organization. The intern's work focuses on connecting students with campus ministry activities, forming and mentoring student leaders, integrating spirituality and social justice concepts. In collaboration with a core team, the intern would assist in planning weekly student organization meetings and monthly community nights for UWSP students and community. The intern assists in organizing, and would attend, Student Engagement Fairs and an Alternative Spring Break Service Trip.

Essential Functions:

- Vision and assist in creating and maintaining a progressive, open and affirming, campus ministry student organization at UWSP.
- Weekly communication of campus ministry opportunities using a variety of social media platforms, including Instagram, Facebook, SPIN, and other UWSP campus life apps/email services.
- Assist in creating and posting posters, fliers, and brochures for campus ministry activities, events, and opportunities in the DUC, academic buildings, residents halls and others.
- Attend weekly meetings with UM Campus Minister and campus ministry student organization.
- Work through job assignments with guidance/supervision from UM Campus Minister and UWSP Faculty Advisor.

Qualifications:

- Enrolled as a full-time UWSP student.
- Ability to work independently and collaboratively.
- Proven relational skills.

- Good communication, organizational, and time management skills.
