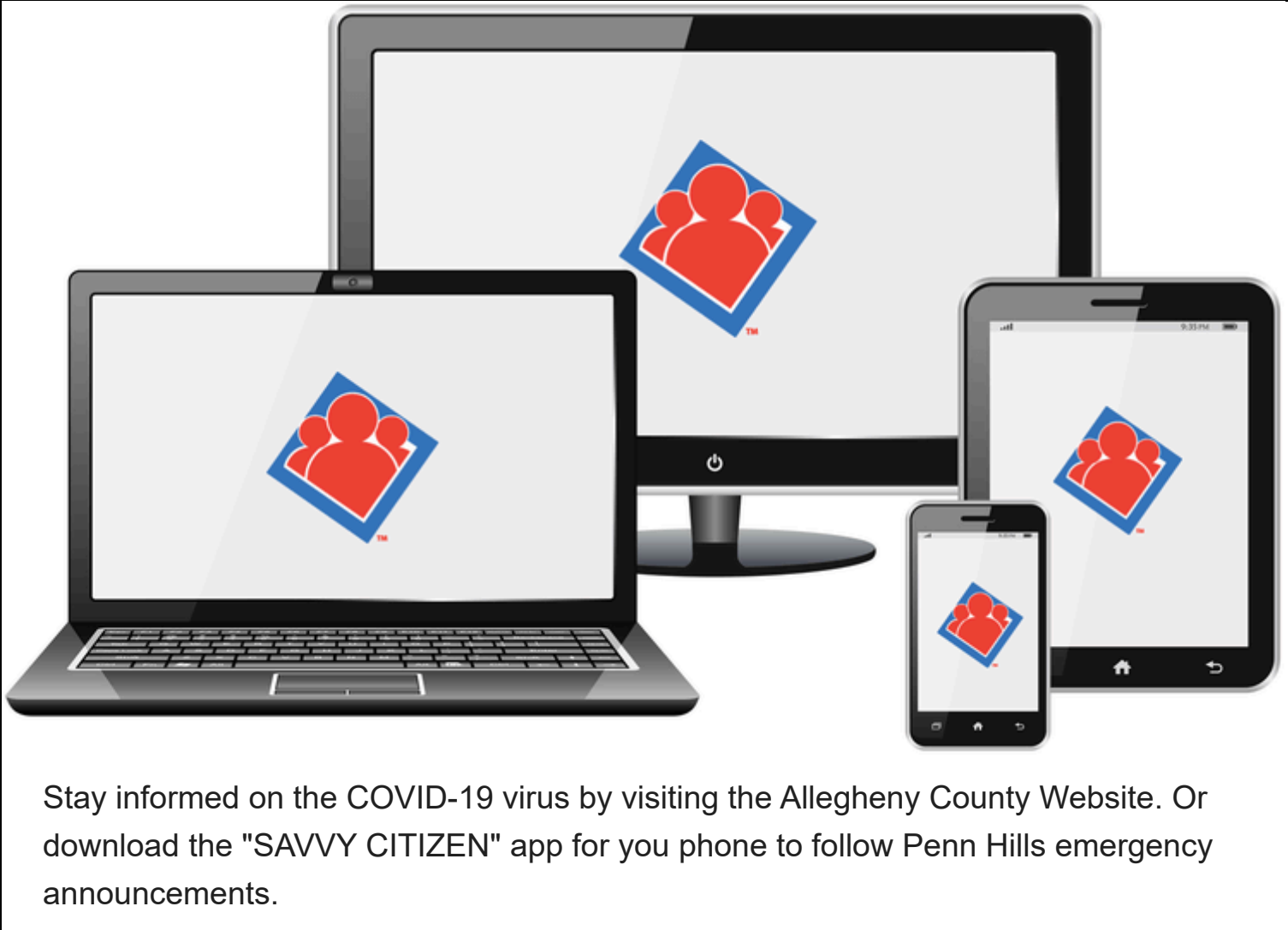

You can now have groceries delivered by setting up an account with Aldi. Go to shop.aldi.us/store you have to enter your first and last name and email and select your store.

Delivery is free for the first 3 orders \$35 or more. You must enter code SHOPALDI20 at checkout to get both free delivery or curbside pickup. After the first 3 orders, charge is less for \$35 & over and more for \$25 & under for both services.

Other grocery stores like Giant Eagle and Walmart offer curbside pick up for online orders too.
