- Serve home-cooked meals every Friday to 60+ people

- Host All Recovery Meetings Monday—Friday at noon & 6 PM
- Stay open Saturdays for drop-in hours and Sundays for church service led by Chaplain Heidi Woldhuis
- Create **safe spaces** for connection and creativity—we honor *all* recovery pathways
- Partner with agencies, sober homes, courts, and care providers to offer a true continuum of support
