## **Travelling to Bath**

#### By Train:

<u>Bath Spa</u> is the main station that serves the city of Bath and is a short walk from the city's major attractions. It has regular trains to and from London Paddington, Bristol Temple Meads, and Cardiff.

### By Plane:

<u>Bristol International Airport</u> is the closest airport to Bath (18.7 miles), and is connected by the <u>A4 Air Decker</u> bus service, which takes you directly from the airport to Bath.

You can also get the <u>Bristol Airport Express</u> from the airport to <u>Bristol Temple Meads</u> station to travel to Bath by train.

If you are travelling from <u>London Heathrow</u>, you can travel to London Paddington via the <u>Elizabeth Line</u> or the <u>Heathrow Express</u>. From Paddington, the <u>GWR Service</u> is directly connected to Bath.

You can also get the <u>National Express</u> coach service directly from Heathrow to Bath Spa Bus Station.
