POORS organized three workshops on human rights awareness training for youths, community people, women, and children at Raikia, Tumudibandh, Baliguda, Daringbadi Tikabali Jignagam, and Chakapada where **442** participants attended and understood their rights and duties for their lives when it comes to respecting and promoting human rights, governments bear the primary responsibility. However, every individual owes it to themselves and their communities to promote human rights. That can seem like a challenging task, but there are many ways you can undertake this mission in both your daily life and as a lifelong goal. Here are the examples to the discussion points for the participants in the workshop meeting:

1. Research human rights issues

To promote human rights, you first need to understand the issues. Many people have good intentions, but if they lack accurate information, their efforts can make things worse. Commit to thorough research from credible sources, such as the

- United Nations,
- The World Health Organization, and
- News organizations with good track records.

Bear in mind that no source is perfect and even reliable organizations can miss the mark. It's your responsibility to read widely, listen to people's stories, and recognize that learning is a continuous process.

2. Donate to good organizations

- Donating money is one of the best ways to promote human rights.
- Money allows organizations to continue their work whether it's providing aid to people in crisis, pressuring governments to take action on human rights, or creating programs that empower the disenfranchised.

3. Change your shopping habits

- You can promote human rights by considering the human rights impact of your shopping habits.

4. Connect to human rights movements

- It's much easier to promote human rights within a group.
- Look for groups doing human rights work in your area or join online communities that connect you to global movements.
- When people work together, they can raise more awareness and funds for the causes they promote. Good groups will have strong leadership, good accountability systems, and a commitment to listening to the communities they serve.

SHG Development Program on Skill & Tailoring

The project organized the skill development training in this quarter where **35 women and grown-up girls** learned to make phenol and sell it in the market as well as do the pushing sell door to door and get money for their survival. Most of the women are benefited as it is a kind of profit business. They gain more profit with less effort when the people use this phenol gets more satisfaction and assured the quality. The buyers compare with the present market value and its quality. The project also provided Tailoring training with machines to the **15 SHGs members & different abled persons** and a handwashing program for the children and taught them to wash their hands before every meal. Project is also sending students to different events and seminars are a way in which youth can be made aware of the issues pertaining to their skills and ability to survive in society. In this training all women learn how to generate their income source, in order to eradicate the problem of trafficking, it is important to layout on how to work towards achieving the goal and how can the youth participate in the same. When the project realized the ways in which the participants can be sought, POORS introduced a Youth Club, to fight human trafficking-related issues. From time to time projects need to have awareness sessions and outreach activities to make people aware. Project organized meetings to engage the Panchayati raj society as well as constantly planning on how our students can be involved in such activities when it comes to making people aware about the same.

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
