Dear Friends:

Thank you for supporting the *Friends of Pine Grove Furnace State Park*. We hope you will renew your membership, or join for the first time. Members receive a discount card for our merchandise in the State Park Office. Memberships run March to March; if you join now, we'll extend your membership through March 2024.

We are a chapter of the *Pennsylvania Parks & Forests Foundation* (PPFF) which has four dozen similar groups across PA. Friends volunteers and supporters provide some "value added" to State Parks and State Forests which serve the public using limited resources and personnel.

Our Friends group fosters volunteerism and supports education, recreation and conservation at Pine Grove Furnace State Park. Since 2010 we have improved the park for hundreds of thousands of visitors annually, with a notable spike in visitation during the pandemic (in 2020 more than 379,000, and in 2021 more than 350,000 — that's a lot of people for a park of less than 700 acres). We expect the visitor total for 2022, when available, will be similar. Pine Grove Furnace is a busy park, all year round!

Despite restrictions due to the pandemic, over the past few years we have been able to host a variety of outdoor events including history tours and a concert by musician-storyteller Van Wagner. We assisted the park with special volunteer efforts such as Earth Day, and except for 2020 have been able to continue the very popular Fall Furnace Fest – this year it will be October 21-22, always during the third full weekend of that month.

In 2022 we focused on history, hiking and conservation. We continue to work with DCNR to repair existing "wayside" displays and create new ones to better interpret the 250-year story of Pine Grove Furnace as first an industrial center then as a tourist destination since the early 20th century. We also help maintain our park's hiking trails (excluding the Appalachian Trail), and purchase and help plant native vegetation. For example, last year we paid for new hemlock trees for the Group Campground after a 9-decade-old white pine plantation was removed for camper safety. The Friends financially supported native habitat restoration along Mountain Creek near Fuller Lake, led by the Michaux Forest Association. We also supported an Eagle Scout project to restore the old log building on Fuller Field, formerly a concession stand and lifeguard shack (now used only for storage).

We continue to cut, split and stack wood – selling firewood in the Family Campground is not simply a fundraiser for our group and a service to campers; locally sourced wood avoids long-distance movement of forest pests and pathogens. The Friends group supports special efforts such as Earth Day, National Public Lands Day, and Woodsy Owl. We are grateful for the volunteers who help maintain trails, remove invasive plants, and hold major events.

Our regular fundraisers include Fall Furnace Fest including the pumpkin float and Hairy Hand story at Fuller Lake; the Iron Run half-marathon and 5k; campground firewood sales; and merchandise sales. Earth Day – Saturday, April 22 Volunteers needed for trail maintenance and other tasks to prepare the park for the busy Summer season.
