Friends of Pine Grove Furnace State Park

Our group is a non-profit chapter of the Pennsylvania Parks & Forests Foundation (PPFF) which supports four dozen similar groups in PA State Parks (and some PA State Forests, including our neighbors the *Friends of* Michaux). Friends volunteers and supporters provide a little "value added" to State Parks and State Forests which serve the public using limited resources and personnel. At Pine Grove Furnace, we work closely with park staff to maintain quality public programs at our busy little park. We raise money for special projects while promoting education, conservation and recreation.

Our regular fundraisers include the Fall Furnace Fest (with the famous pumpkin float and Hairy Hand story at Fuller Lake); the Iron Run half-marathon & Charcoal Challenge 5k run/walk; campground firewood sales; and merchandise sales.

We continue to cut, split and stack wood for campground firewood sales — a special thank you to the dedicated volunteers who help with that ongoing and time-consuming task. The Friends also support special volunteer mornings such as Earth Day and National Public Lands Day. We are grateful for the many volunteers who help to maintain trails, plant trees, remove invasive plant species, and assist at special events.

Since 2010 we've done our best to improve the park for hundreds of thousands of visitors annually. In 2022 we focused on history, hiking and conservation. We are working with DCNR to repair existing "wayside" displays and create new ones. We also help to maintain hiking trails, and we purchased and helped plant native vegetation at the Group Campground after the 9-decade-old white pine plantation was removed for camper safety. The Friends financially supported native habitat restoration along Mountain Creek near Fuller Lake, led by the Michaux Forest Association. We also supported an Eagle Scout project to restore the log building on Fuller Field, known to many as a former concession stand and lifeguard shack (now used for storage).
