PLANS FOR NEW FOOT BRIDGE ACROSS MOUNTAIN CREEK

The Friends of Pine Grove Furnace State Park are applying for grants to improve the Mountain Creek Trail and construct a foot bridge. The goal is to connect the two sections of the trail to make a thru trail between the two ends of the park.

Mountain Creek Trail is a fairly level trail that follows along Mountain Creek between Laurel and Fuller Lakes. The 1.72 mile trail is divided into two unconnected sections by Mountain Creek. During the dry summer months it is possible to ford the creek to hike the entire

length of the trail, but for most of the year, it is two trail sections each ending abruptly at the creek. Even though the trail connects the two primary recreation/day use areas of the park, the trail is underutilized and is in need of improvements. There are a number of large fallen trees and boggy areas that have old crossings that need to be replaced.

Ideally, we would like to build a suspension bridge, but what we ultimately decide to do will depend on the cost and our ability to raise sufficient funds.

THIS YEAR'S UPDATES

Pine Grove Furnace State Park receives close to half a million visitors each year. That's a lot of activity for a park with less than 700 acres! The Park has increasingly turned to the *Friends of Pine Grove Furnace State Park* as a way to help maintain quality educational and recreational programs.

One of our primary goals is to raise money in support of the Park. In June we had our 5th annual Iron Race and raised \$5,000(net of expenses) and we have already begun to plan for our annual Fall Furnace Fest in October.

In 2014, the Friends used their funds to help repair the 250 year

old furnace stack in the center of the park, purchased a children's playground for the campground, bought a firewood shed for the campground and purchased a sprayer for the staff's ongoing battle against barberry and other nonnative invasive plants.

This year, the Friends purchased a playground for the Fuller Beach picnic area. Once funding is obtained for the Mountain Creek Trial, future plans include a playground in the Laurel Lake area.

In addition to fund raising, volunteers play an important role in supporting Pine Grove Furnace State Park. Last year, volunteers both individually and in groups contributed more than 3,500 hours of service to the Park. That equates to more than 93 weeks of donated work!
