Bluebird Monitoring Walk: Friday, August 22nd at 10:00 AM

Have you noticed the new wooden bird boxes around the park, and want to learn more? Join the park educator on a walk around the new cavity-nesting trail to look for signs of activity, and learn about how you could get involved! **Meet behind the Park Office.**

Trail Bridges of PIGR Hike: Saturday, August 23rd at 10:00 AM

Bring the little ones out to do a fun craft and learn about our favorite amphibian, the frog! Fun for the whole family! Look for the pop-up canopy behind the park office. **Meet at the Park Office.**
