

Empower x Momentum Scholarship



Two \$1,000 Non-Renewable Scholarships Available Deadline for Submission: March 15, 2026

Scholarship Description

The Empower x Momentum Scholarship is a collaborative initiative between Plays 2 Empower and Momentum Health Charities, created to support African American female students in Prince William County who demonstrate academic achievement, leadership, and a commitment to their communities. Two scholarships of \$1,000 each will be awarded to students planning to attend an accredited college or university beginning in Fall 2026. The mission of this scholarship is to provide financial support that empowers deserving young women to achieve their educational goals, develop as leaders, and continue giving back to their communities.

Eligibility Requirements

Applicants must meet all of the following criteria:

- Must be a graduating senior from a Prince William County High School (Class of 2026)
- Must identify as an African American female
- Must have a minimum cumulative GPA of 3.0 or higher
- Must submit a personal essay (500 words max)
- Must submit two letters of recommendation
 - At least one must be from a current school official (teacher, counselor, or administrator)
- Must provide an activities résumé listing:
 - Community service, leadership roles, extracurricular activities, honors, and/or employment

- Must submit an official or unofficial high school transcript
- Must show **proof of college/university acceptance** (required before funds are disbursed)
- Must submit their FAFSA Student Aid Index (SAI)
- **Immediate family members** of Plays 2 Empower or Momentum Health Charities board members are **not eligible** to apply

Application Period & Deadlines

- **Opens:** October 1, 2025
- **Z Closes:** March 15, 2026 at 11:59pm
- **Propriets Announced By:** May 1, 2026

Incomplete or late applications will not be reviewed.

Application Package Must Include:

- **Completed Application Form** Fill out all sections.
- **Essay (500 words max)** Prompt:
 - "Describe a challenge you have faced in your community or personal life and how it has shaped your goals for the future."
- Activities Résumé Include leadership roles, service, extracurriculars, honors, and work experience from the past 12 months
- Two Letters of Recommendation One must be from a school official
- **Transcript** Official or unofficial, must show GPA
- Proof of College Acceptance/Enrollment Required before scholarship funds are awarded
- FAFSA Student Aid Index (SAI) Include a copy or screenshot of your FAFSA confirmation or SAI page

Selection Criteria

Applications will be evaluated based on:

- Quality and depth of the personal essay
- Demonstrated leadership and community involvement
- School and non-school activities, service, and honors
- Strength and relevance of recommendation letters
- FAFSA SAI (used to help assess financial need)
- GPA and overall academic performance
- Completeness and presentation of the application

Recipient Responsibilities

Scholarship recipients may be asked to provide a brief update during their first year of college. This helps Plays 2 Empower and Momentum Health Charities understand how the scholarship is supporting their educational journey.
