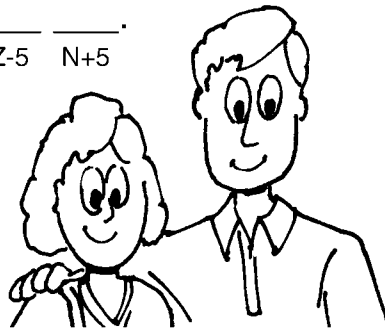

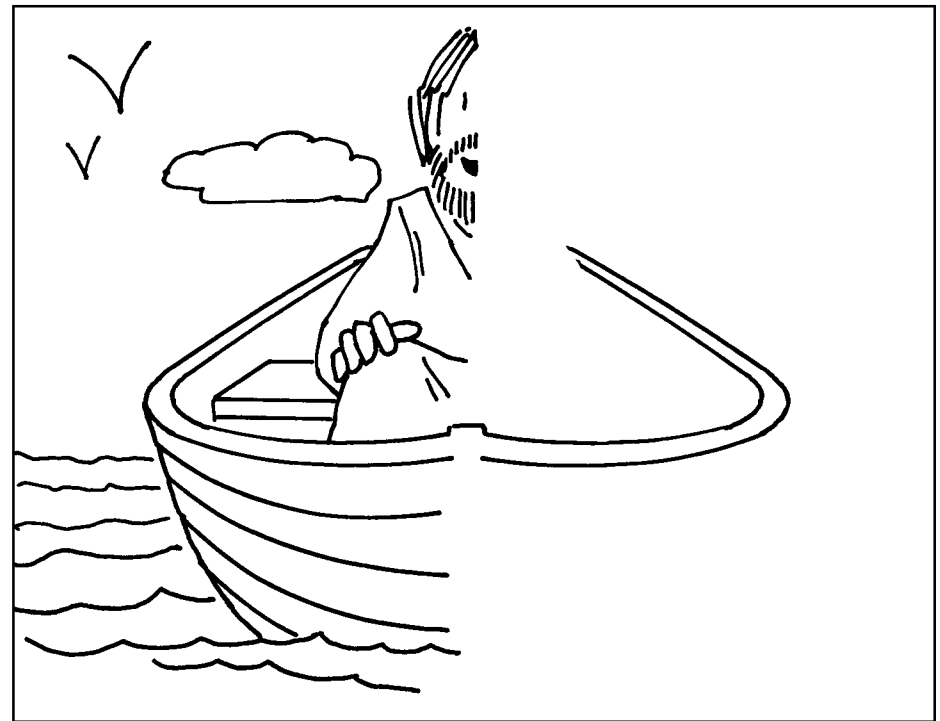

Half the picture below is finished. Finish the drawing.

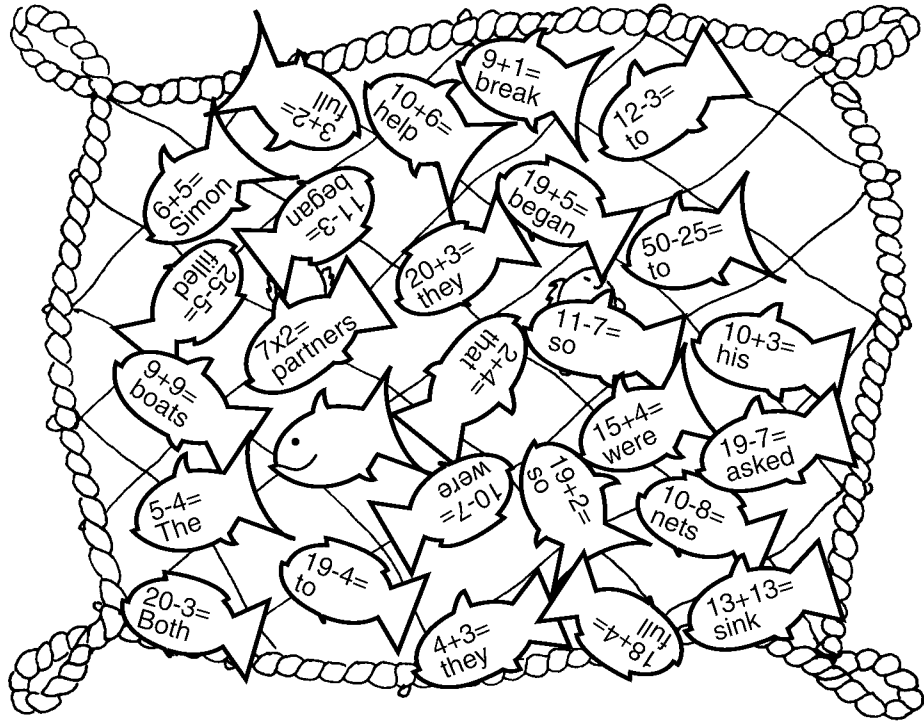


Today's scripture is found in Luke 5:1-11. Can you find it in the Adventure Bible?
