The steering committee for Indivisible Central Wisconsin is working to settle the group's course for 2026. We will be resuming the overpass protests in the spring, when conditions are safer, but want to stay busy until then.

To get maximum input, we are inviting all our friends and allies to contribute their thoughts and ideas. You are invited to either attend the Zoom meeting listed below or reply to this email if that isn't convenient.

Some potential activities for the coming year:

- The Wisconsin State Supreme Court, coming in April, where a progressive candidate is running to replace an extreme conservative.
- Local elections, where who to support is less clear, but lines can be drawn. For example, opposing any "Moms for Liberty" candidates for school board.
- Attacking Representative Van Orden's record This is always worthwhile.
- Choosing a person to support in the primary to run against Van Orden. This would not involve attacking any other Democratic candidate, since we want a strong opponent in the general.
- Strengthen our ties with local allies by meeting with them and sharing strategies.
- Developing contacts with local immigrant groups to see how we can support them.
- Using social media to reach local audiences. This is difficult since the media actively work against such activities, but we can try.
- Using short videos to get our messages out. We aren't using Instagram or Tiktok at this time.
