- (a) Prior to submitting the notice of work required by Condition 2 the following documents shall be prepared by the licence holder:
  - a suitable and sufficient written statement of the plan of work to be used.
  - a suitable and sufficient written specification for the equipment for the protection and decontamination of those engaged in asbestos work and also for the protection of other persons, as appropriate to the work.
  - The licensee shall, on request by HSE and/or the local authority provide copies of the documents referred to in 3(a) and/or allow inspection of those documents as required.
  - Work carried out under the notice of work required by Condition 2 shall be carried out in accordance with the suitable and sufficient plan of work and the equipment, as specified in (a) (i) and (ii).


