### Mitchell's History a little bit at a time...

The Little Pine Lodge building was built around 1889. John W. Waterman came to eastern Oregon from Missouri with cattle and interest in the mercantile business in 1864. In 1895, he turned his business interests over to his sons who moved the business to Mitchell. Mr. Waterman's son, Hanley and his wife Rena owned and operated H. A. Waterman and Co. General Merchandise in the building now known as the Little Pine Lodge.

On March 20th of 1914, Hanley sold the building to Mitchell Lodge No. 141 I.O.O.F. (Independent Order of Odd Fellows). The Odd Fellows and the Rebekahs held their meetings in the Lodge. [An Illustrated History of Central Oregon; Shaver]

Although there have been many owners since then, implementing changes and upgrades to the structure, the Little Pine Lodge

building still maintains most of her original majesty and charm.
