Thurs 24<sup>th</sup>      **Nut free Pk lunch**

**Fruit art day** .... From crafting fruit through card, paints, pom-poms etc. to making magnets and mobiles. Afternoon snack with a selection of fruit and a chocolate dip.

**Mon 28<sup>th</sup>    Nut free Pk lunch**

**Junk modelling** ....the children can combine craft with rubbish, recyclable card, plastic tubes/cones and many other materials/objects in all shapes and sizes. This is a rewarding activity which has no limitations and can be endless to the children's imaginations. Their models will be judged and prizes awarded to children of different age groups and abilities. There will be lots of other activities indoors and out for the children to challenge themselves with throughout the day

**Tues 29<sup>th</sup>    Nut free Pk lunch**

**Den building outdoors**....construction play for the children to build dens, erecting hammocks using materials, sticks/canes etc. along with their imaginations to construct a safe concept that will give them shelter or hold their weight. Weather permitting lunches will be eaten outdoors. Other activities will be on offer for the children to choose from throughout the day

**Wed 30<sup>th</sup>    Nut free Pk lunch**

**Treasure Trail** ...the children will be challenged today design to draw-up a treasure map, they can use their imaginations but it needs to be based around the school grounds and be accessible to all ages. There will be prizes for how the map was constructed, number of clues, and what the end reward would be. There will also be a Treasure Trail planned by staff members for the children to follow, where the children will hunt for clues, if the clues are solved then they might receive treasure in return.
