- **End the Tale of Two Economies:** Eliminate the shameful 17-year life expectancy, \$200,000 household income and 81x wealth gaps between Ward 3 and Wards 7 & 8.
- **\$900/month Housing Revolution:** Deliver 100,000 new homes with rents and mortgages capped at \$900 for one-bedroom and \$1,500 for three-bedroom units.
- **Family First Guarantee:** Establish 36 weeks of paid parental leave with full job protections and guaranteed no-cost, universal childcare.
- **The \$100K Teacher and Student Payday:** \$100,000 starting salaries for teachers and a \$25 daily stipend for students (Grades 6-12). We will reduce teacher turnover from 25% to 5% and slash student absenteeism from 70% to 10%.
- **The 5-Minute Bio-Nutrient and Fitness Fix:** Supercharge school meals with essential nutrients (B-12, Zinc, Iron, Omega-3s, Probiotics). We will launch non-profit grocery stores (prices cheaper than Aldi) and no-cost fitness centers within a 5-minute walk of every front door.
- **The \$5 Billion Creative Engine:** Invest \$5 billion in those who define DC's soul—artists, engineers, and designers. Move over London and Paris—the world's next creative capital is the 202.
- **The \$10 billion AI shield:** Upskill and shockproof DC's most vulnerable communities and ensure workers are the owners and architects of the new AI and automated economy, not just its displaced observers. We will also ban algorithmic wage discrimination.
- **\$50/Hour Minimum Wage:** We will raise the pay for jobs that require physical presence, emotional intelligence, and complex manual dexterity that algorithms cannot effectively replicate: Construction, Sanitation, Personal Care, Childcare, Snow Removal, Housekeeping, Security. \$30/hr for all workers.
- **No-Cost 24/7 Transit:** Unlock the city with FREE 24/7 Metro train + expanded bus service. A new fleet of quiet electric buses and vans will navigate even our narrowest residential streets.
- **Gold Standard Infrastructure:** End "snowcrete" with 24-hour snow clearing and banish poisoned water by replacing every single lead water pipe.
- **Equitable Traffic Enforcement:** Replace unnecessary speed cameras with speed tables; reduce camera and parking fines to \$20 and eliminate predatory double-fining.
- **Smart-City Mobility:** Cut pollution, commute times and pedestrian/cyclist fatalities by 50% through the use of FREE electric bikes, smart sensors and protected routes.
- **Better Mental Health For All:** Slash deaths from opioid overdoses, violent crimes, by 75% through expanded, accessible care for all. (See Page 2)

Washington DC: A Tale of Two Economies

I architected Obama's 2008 win and built platforms for global brands. But I developed *this* campaign while logging thousands of miles for a rideshare app, witnessing the real DC firsthand. That's why this is a platform built by and for the people of DC, and not by and for the wealthy donors who are bankrolling my rivals. I don't just understand our problems—I have the solutions.

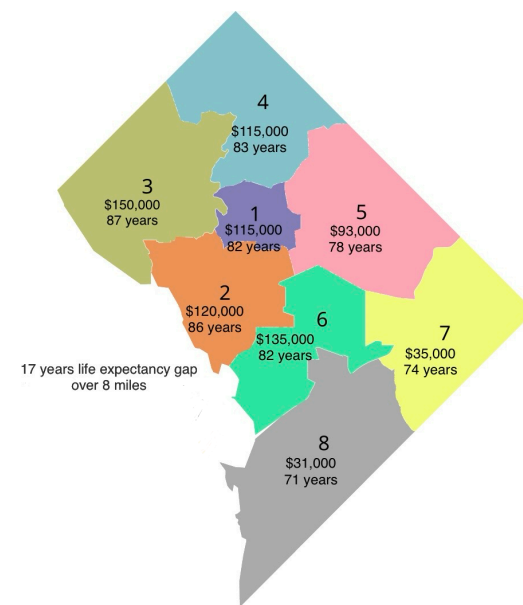
The 17-Year Life Expectancy Penalty: In Ward 3, residents live to 88; in Ward 8, that number drops to 71. I believe your birth certificate shouldn't come with an expiration date dictated by your zip code.

The 81x Wealth Gap: White households in Northwest D.C. (Wards 2 and 3) have a net worth estimated to be 81 times greater (\$240,000) than Black households (\$3500). When the median income for White households is triple that of Black households, when Black residents experience a poverty rate 374% higher than White residents, we don't have an "equity" problem—we have a structural one. I'm running to build a city where every home in every Ward is thriving.

The No-Grocery Zone: It shouldn't take three bus transfers or a \$25 Uber ride just to find a fresh head of lettuce. While Northwest DC is overflowing with Whole Foods, Trader Joe's, Safeways and Giants, 170,000 residents in Wards 7 and 8 have been left behind — they contain 80% of DC's healthy "food deserts" with just THREE full-service grocery stores serving 7 & 8 COMBINED. Ward 3 alone has 19! I'm running to ensure that "eating well" isn't a privilege reserved for the wealthy.

"Medical Apartheid": Six hospitals for Northwest and two for Southeast isn't just bad math—it's bad medicine. We're going to ensure that "quality care" is a right for every Ward, not a luxury for few.

I am running for Mayor of Washington DC, because I believe your life expectancy should NOT depend on which side of the river you call home. I'm not just running to balance the budget; I'm running to balance the scales. I'm running to deliver the long-awaited sequel to our sorry Tale of Two Economies, a new era where EVERY Ward is a winner. I'm running because I believe that the incredible talent and resilience of DC's people can transform the District into the ultimate Dream City —the gold standard by which all great cities are judged.
