- 06/17 **Trail Ride** – Glacier Park hosted by K Moon, M Povich, D Rieter, D Robertson – Rain or hopefully shine!! IF trails in conservancy are closed, we can still ride the rail line and the service road. Arrive at 10:00 AM. Ride out at 10:30 and Lunch after ride. Use Hart Road parking lot – **NOT KEYSTONE LOT**. Lunch is sandwiches and side salads. Bring a dish to share and your own travel cup. Iced tea and lemonade will be available.
