

# Introduction

- India's logistics sector moves **4.6 billion tonnes of freight annually**.

# The Problem

## India's Truck Drivers: The Unsung Backbone of the Economy

- Truck drivers are the backbone who keep goods moving across the country.
- Yet, at industrial hubs and factory gates, they face long wait times (often 12–24 hours) with little to no facilities.
- Lack of clean washrooms, resting spaces, and food leads to fatigue, health issues, and dissatisfaction.
- This directly results in delayed shipments, safety risks, and negative brand experiences.

## Key Data:

- 75% of drivers report extreme fatigue during wait times (All India Truckers Survey, 2023).
- 82% agree that better facilities would improve their loyalty to freight partners.





## Key Challenges Faced by Indian Truck Drivers:

### → Lack of Basic Sanitation:

- Over **85% of industrial locations** lack clean restrooms and wash areas for drivers.
- Forced to rely on unsafe and unhygienic options, leading to health risks and loss of dignity.

### → No Safe Resting Spaces:

- Long waiting hours often extend to **18–24 hours** with drivers sleeping on sidewalks or inside cramped cabins.
- Results in fatigue, reduced concentration, and higher accident risks on return trips.

### → Poor Food Availability:

- Only **12%** of logistics hubs offer reliable food stalls or cafeterias for drivers.
- Leads to reliance on junk food or skipping meals altogether.

### → Mental & Physical Health Impact:

- Fatigue, poor hygiene, and stress significantly impact both **driver health and overall fleet efficiency**.
- Studies show **30% higher turnover rates** in fleets that do not invest in driver welfare.

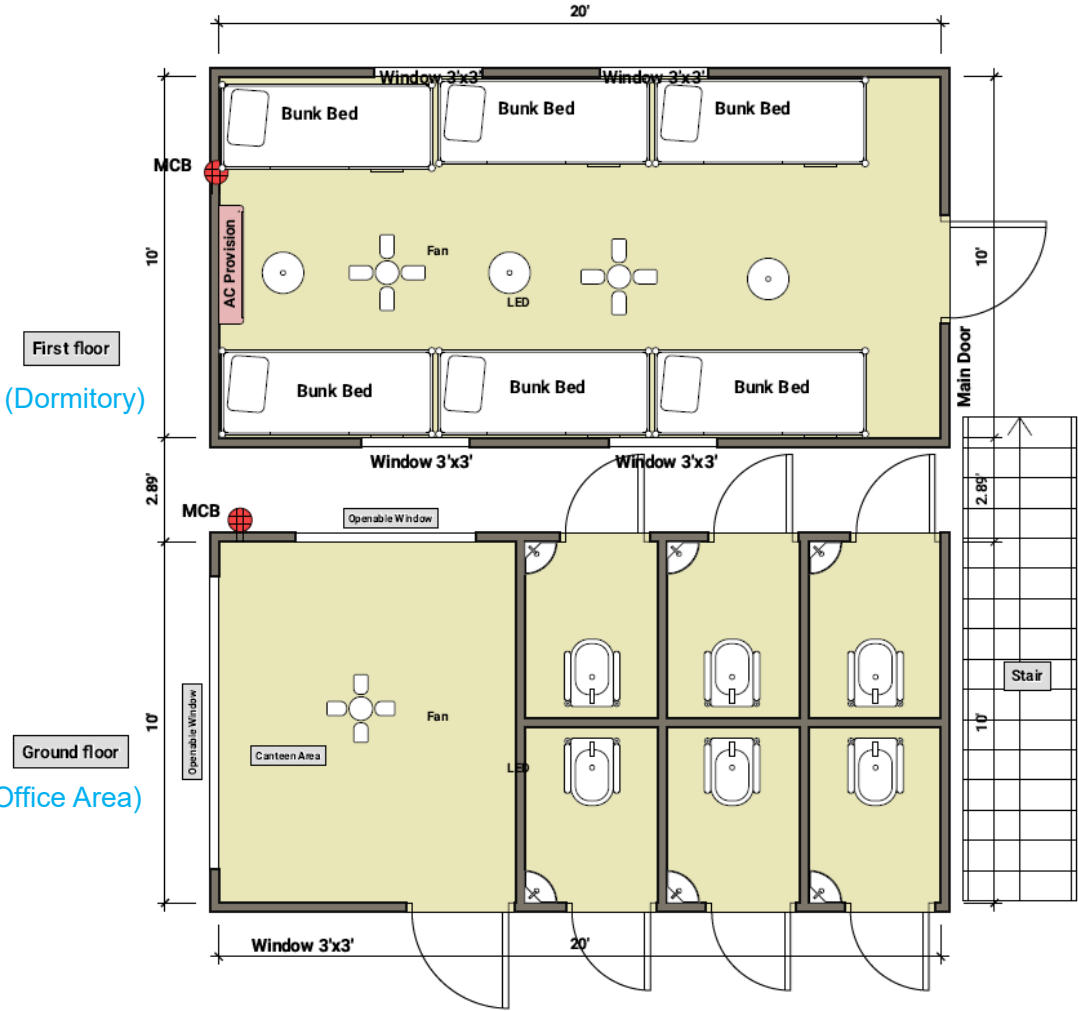
