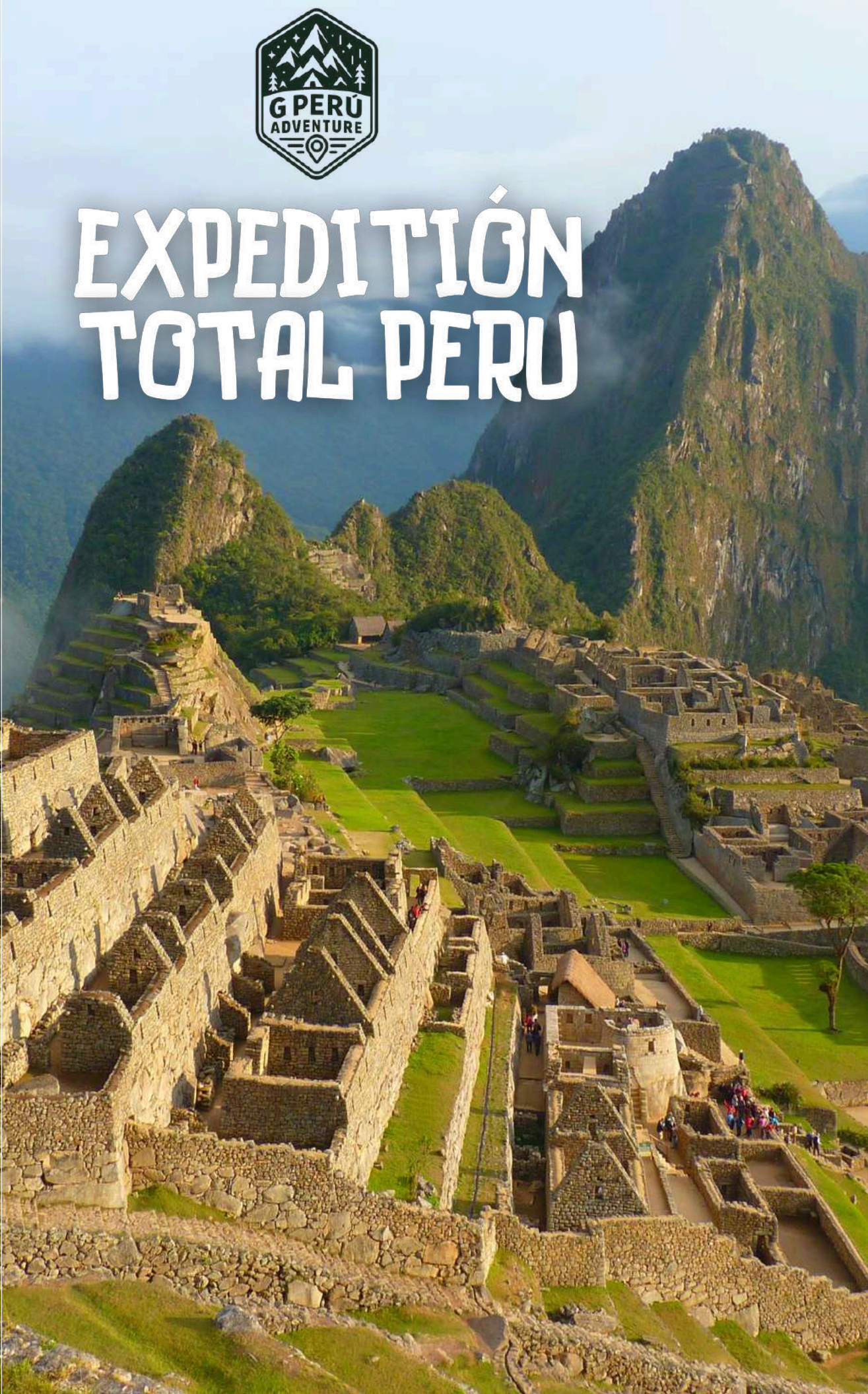

# ICA & PARACAS





## ● Sunday, November 2: Arrival in Lima

Upon arrival at Lima Airport, a Vladitours representative will assist you and accompany you to your hotel. After the check-in process, you may enjoy the rest of the day at your leisure, either taking part in optional activities or simply relaxing and enjoying your stay.

## ● Monday, November 3: Full-Day Paracas and Ica

A representative will pick you up in the morning from your hotel in Lima and take you directly to Paracas by private transport, without the need for bus terminal stops. Sit back, relax, and enjoy a comfortable ride.

Upon arrival in Paracas, your exciting tour to the Paracas Peninsula will begin, home to the most important wildlife sanctuary on the Peruvian coast. You will board a motorboat to the stunning Ballestas Islands, where you can spot sea lions, pelicans, penguins, and a great variety of seabirds. On the way back, you won't miss the view of the famous "Candelabro," a mysterious geoglyph etched in the sand, reminiscent of the Nazca Lines. You'll also have free time to capture photos of the breathtaking scenery.

Next, you'll continue your journey to Ica with a transfer from Paracas, where you'll enjoy a tourist lunch menu and a tasting of local wines at a regional vineyard. The adventure continues at the spectacular Huacachina Lagoon, an oasis surrounded by palm trees and massive sand dunes. Here, the thrill begins with a dune buggy ride across the desert, offering spectacular views. Along the way, stops will be made for photos of the stunning landscape where the dunes meet the Peruvian Andes. An expert guide will also teach you how to sandboard on the dunes — a truly unique experience.

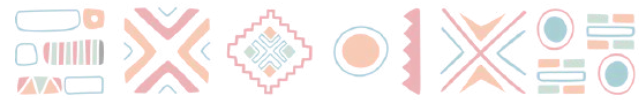

## ● Tuesday, November 4: Gastronomic Tour & City Tour Lima

In the morning, after breakfast, we will pick you up to begin an unforgettable gastronomic and cultural experience in Lima.

We will start by exploring a traditional market, highly valued by renowned Peruvian chefs. Here, you will discover a wide variety of natural products typical of the country and learn more about the ingredients that bring Peruvian cuisine to life.

Next, we will head to a carefully selected restaurant where, guided by expert chefs, you will take part in preparing a delicious tourist lunch. To complement this culinary experience, you will enjoy a complimentary Pisco Sour or Chilcano.

After lunch, we will begin our city tour with a panoramic view of Huaca Pucllana, an impressive pre-Inca ceremonial center located in the heart of Miraflores.

The tour continues through the historic center of Lima, declared a UNESCO World Heritage Site, where we will admire architectural gems such as the Plaza Mayor, the Cathedral, and the Government Palace. We will also visit the Convent of San Francisco, famous for its mysterious catacombs.

We will end the day with a stroll through the charming districts of Miraflores and Barranco, known for their architecture, street art, and breathtaking views of the Pacific Ocean — the perfect close to a day filled with flavors, history, and culture.

## ● Wednesday, November 5: Lima – Cusco | Arrival in Cusco

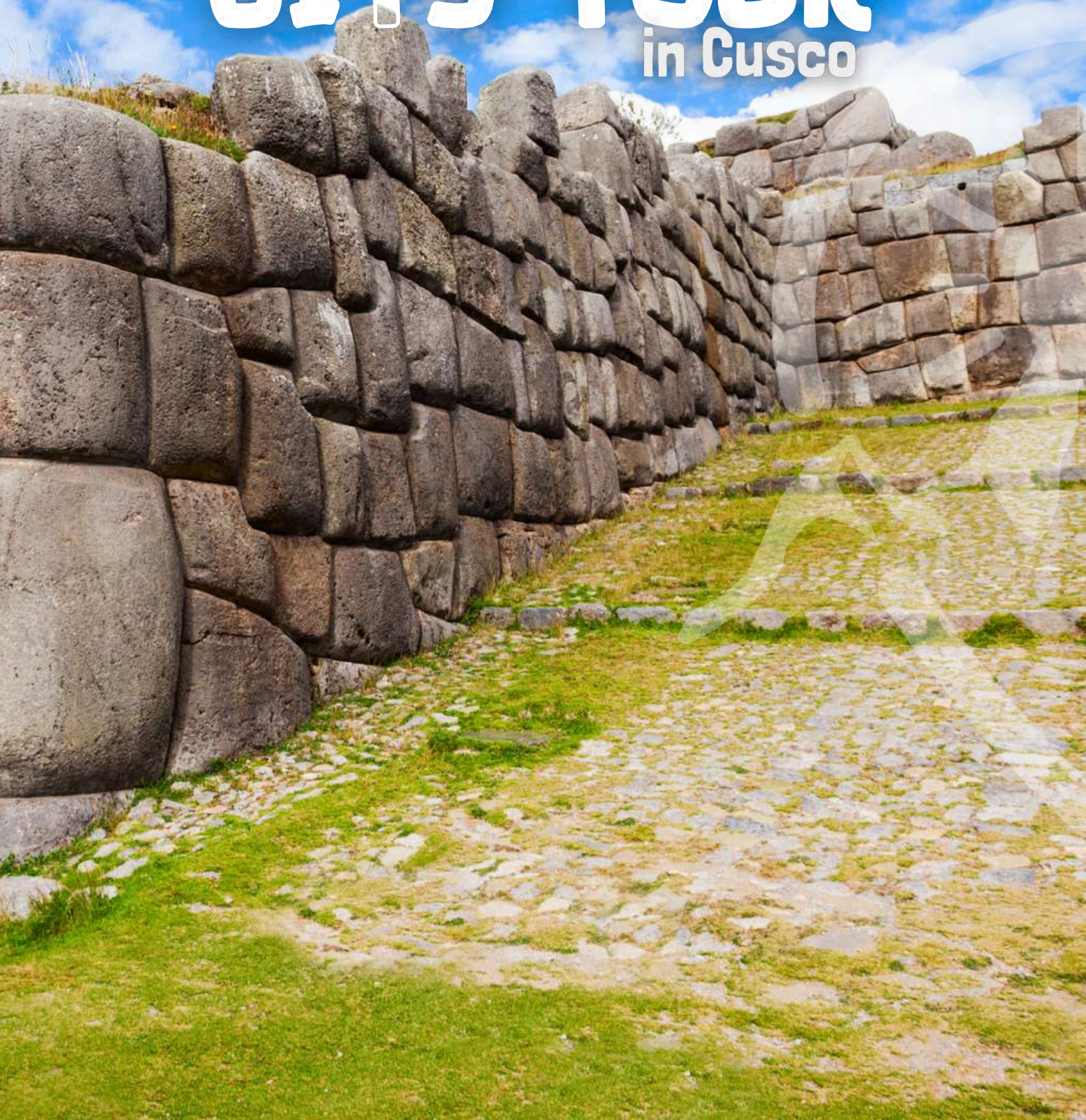

# CITY TOUR

● **Wednesday, November 5: Cusco City Tour & Inca Ruins**

In the afternoon, we will pick you up from your hotel to begin our tour of the city of Cusco. We will start with a visit to the Qoricancha Temple, also known as the Temple of the Sun, upon which the Church of Santo Domingo was built. Next, we will head to the Archaeological Park of Sacsayhuamán, an impressive site that conveys a deep sense of peace and serenity, where you can see massive stones up to 4 meters high used in the construction of this fortress.

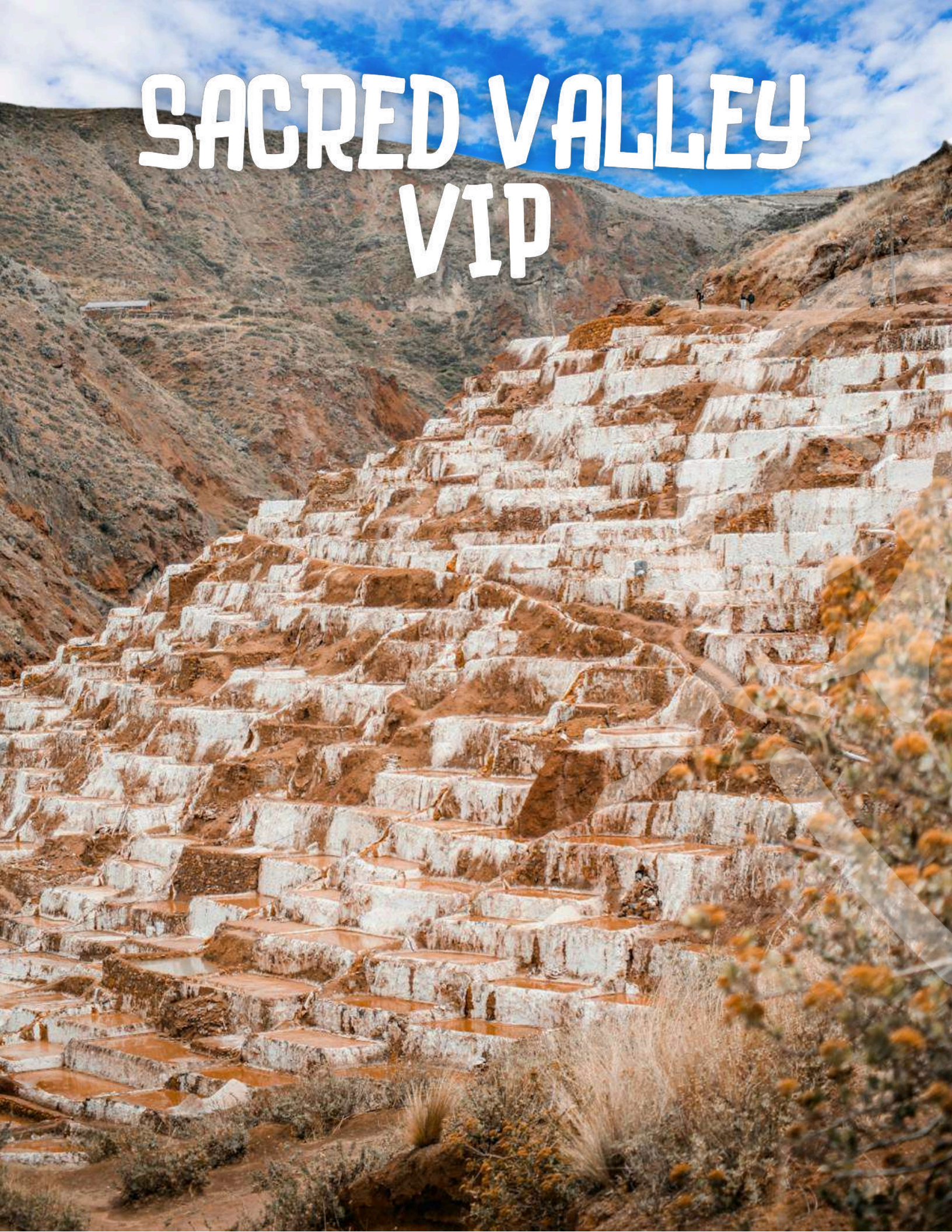
We will then visit the ceremonial center of Q'enqo, followed by a panoramic view of Puca Pucara, an important defensive checkpoint for the city. Our last stop will be the ceremonial center of Tambomachay, known for its sacred fountains that symbolize life and health.

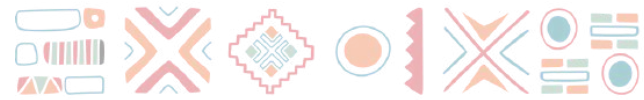
At the end of the tour, we will return to Cusco, concluding the service with your transfer back to the hotel.

# SACRED VALLEY VIP





## ● Thursday, November 6: VIP Sacred Valley of the Incas Tour

In the morning, at 7:00 a.m., we will pick you up from your hotel to begin the VIP tour of the Sacred Valley. Our first stop will be the picturesque town of Chinchero, where we will visit a local workshop to learn about the region’s traditional textiles. We will then continue to Moray, a fascinating archaeological site used by the Incas as an agricultural laboratory, featuring circular terraces that simulate different microclimates.

Next, we will head to the Maras Salt Mines, a complex of around 3,000 salt pools that have been in use since Inca times. Afterward, we will travel by our private transport to Urubamba, where you will enjoy a delicious buffet lunch with typical dishes of Cusco’s cuisine.

In the afternoon, we will visit the imposing Ollantaytambo Fortress, an important Inca site that served for defense and to control access to the Antisuyo region. At the end of the visit, we will transfer you to your hotel in the Sacred Valley at around 3:00 p.m.

# MACHU PICCHU





## ● Friday, November 7: Machu Picchu Visit – Full Day

In the morning, at 7:30 a.m., our tourist transport will pick you up from your hotel in the Sacred Valley to take you to the Ollantaytambo train station, where your journey to Machu Picchu — one of the Seven Wonders of the World — will begin. Upon arrival in Aguas Calientes, a Vladitours representative will assist you in boarding the eco-bus that will take you up a winding road, offering spectacular views of the Urubamba River and the valley.

After passing the security checkpoint, you will enter the Inca citadel of Machu Picchu accompanied by your exclusive private professional guide for a guided tour of approximately two and a half hours, providing you with detailed information about this world wonder. You will have enough time to explore all its important areas and take photos.

Following the visit, we will return to Aguas Calientes, where you will enjoy a delicious buffet lunch. At the previously scheduled time, 5:00 p.m., you must be at the Aguas Calientes train station to take the return train. Upon arrival, we will transfer you to your selected hotel in the Sacred Valley of the Incas.

# RAINBOW MOUNTAIN





## ● Saturday, November 8: Rainbow Mountain Visit

In the morning, at 6:00 a.m., we will begin our journey to Rainbow Mountain, also known as the Mountain of Seven Colors or Vinicunca — a magical place that was once part of the ancient Quechua culture. We will depart early from Cusco, heading south to the town of Cusipata, where we will enjoy a delicious breakfast. After a brief orientation, we will continue by transport to the starting point of the hike, located at the foot of the Ausangate snow-capped mountain.

The ascent will take approximately 40 minutes to 1 hour until we reach the highest point, from where you can admire the breathtaking Rainbow Mountain. Along the way, we will have the opportunity to observe various species of Andean camelids and the typical flora of the region. Upon arrival, you will have free time to take photos and soak in the stunning scenery.

We will then begin our descent, which will take about 40 minutes, to the point where our transport will be waiting to take us to a restaurant in Cusipata, where we will enjoy a delicious lunch. Afterward, we will return to your hotel in Cusco, arriving at around 5:00 p.m.
