

Cookie Policy

This Cookie Policy explains how Aeternis Fincon Limited uses cookies and similar technologies on its website, aeternisfincon.com. It should be read together with our Privacy Policy and Website Disclaimer.

1. About this Cookie Policy

In this Cookie Policy, “Aeternis Fincon”, “we”, “us” and “our” refer to Aeternis Fincon Limited, a company registered in England and Wales with company number 17265321.

This policy explains what cookies are, why we may use them, the types of cookies that may be placed on your device, and how you can manage your cookie preferences.

2. What are cookies?

Cookies are small text files placed on your computer, smartphone, tablet or other device when you visit a website. Cookies are widely used to make websites work, improve website performance, remember user preferences, and help website owners understand how visitors use their websites.

Similar technologies, such as pixels, tags, local storage and scripts, may also be used for similar purposes. In this policy, references to “cookies” include these similar technologies where relevant.

3. How we use cookies

We may use cookies for the following purposes:

- **Strictly necessary cookies:** to make the website function properly, maintain security, enable page navigation, remember cookie preferences and support basic website features.
- **Performance and analytics cookies:** to understand how visitors use the website, which pages are visited, and how the website can be improved.
- **Functionality cookies:** to remember user preferences and improve the browsing experience.
- **Third-party or embedded content cookies:** to support embedded maps, videos, forms, security tools or other third-party features where used.

4. Consent to cookies

Where cookies are strictly necessary to provide the website or a service requested by you, we may use them without requesting consent.

For non-essential cookies, such as analytics, marketing or certain third-party cookies, we will seek your consent where required. You can accept, reject or manage non-essential cookies through the cookie banner or cookie settings tool available on the website, where such tool is implemented.

You may withdraw or change your cookie consent at any time by using the website cookie settings tool or by adjusting your browser settings.

5. Cookies used on our website

The exact cookies used on the website may change depending on website configuration, hosting, security settings, plugins, analytics tools and embedded third-party services. The table below should be checked and updated against the website’s actual cookie scan before publication.

Strictly necessary	Website hosting, security, session and cookie preference cookies	Required for site operation, security, navigation and remembering cookie choices.	Consent not usually required where strictly necessary.	Session to 12 months
Analytics / performance	Google Analytics or similar analytics tool, if enabled	Helps us understand visitor numbers, page usage and website performance.	Consent required before use unless an exemption applies.	Up to 24 months, depending on tool settings
Functionality	Preference or form-related cookies, if enabled	Remembers user choices or supports enhanced website functionality.	Consent may be required depending on purpose.	Session to 12 months
Third-party embedded content	Google Maps, video embeds, reCAPTCHA, social media or similar tools, if enabled	Supports embedded content, spam protection, maps or external features.	Consent may be required depending on tool and purpose.	Set by third party
Marketing / advertising	Advertising pixels or remarketing tags, if enabled	Used to measure campaigns or deliver advertising.	Consent required before use.	Set by third party

6. Third-party cookies

Some cookies may be placed by third-party providers where we use external services, such as analytics tools, map providers, website security tools, contact form services, video embeds or other website plugins.

Third-party providers may process information according to their own privacy and cookie policies. We recommend that you review the relevant third-party policies where third-party services are used on the website.

7. Managing cookies through your browser

Most web browsers allow you to control cookies through browser settings. You can usually block cookies, delete existing cookies, receive warnings before cookies are placed, or restrict cookies from specific websites.

Please note that if you block or delete certain cookies, some parts of the website may not function properly.
