

## **Jesus is The Son of Man Who Comes at the End of the Age**

Jesus is The Son God yet He also referred to Himself as The Son of Man, especially when speaking of end times. The prophet Daniel had seen “one like a son of man” in the dream he saw and wrote down about four great beasts who he was told are four great kings who would arise from the earth

“I kept looking in the night visions,  
And behold, with the clouds of heaven  
One like a son of man was coming,  
And He came up to the Ancient of Days  
And was presented before Him.  
“And to Him was given dominion,  
Honor, and a kingdom,  
So that all the peoples, nations, and languages  
Might serve Him.  
His dominion is an everlasting dominion  
Which will not pass away;  
And His kingdom is one  
which will not be destroyed.” (Daniel 7:13-14)

So when Jesus calls Himself The Son of Man, those who have read Daniel can know of whom He was speaking, serve and obey Him now and then since He as the great stone that was cut out without hands only falls on and crushes the unrepentant kings of the earth and their followers. “Then the sovereignty, the dominion, and the greatness of all the kingdoms under the whole heaven will be given to the people of the holy ones of the Highest One; His kingdom will be an everlasting kingdom, and all the empires will serve and obey Him.” (Daniel 7:27)

The book of Revelation gives us much more detail concerning these end times matters and it is amazing how the prophetic utterances in the Old Testament find their fulfillment in Jesus Christ.

When Jesus returns “ he brings His rewards with him” (Revelation 22: 2) which the apostles Paul, James, and John said includes “the crown of life” and ruling and reigning together with Him in His Kingdom (2 Timothy 4:8, James 1:12, Revelation 2:10) because they persevered in times of trial.
