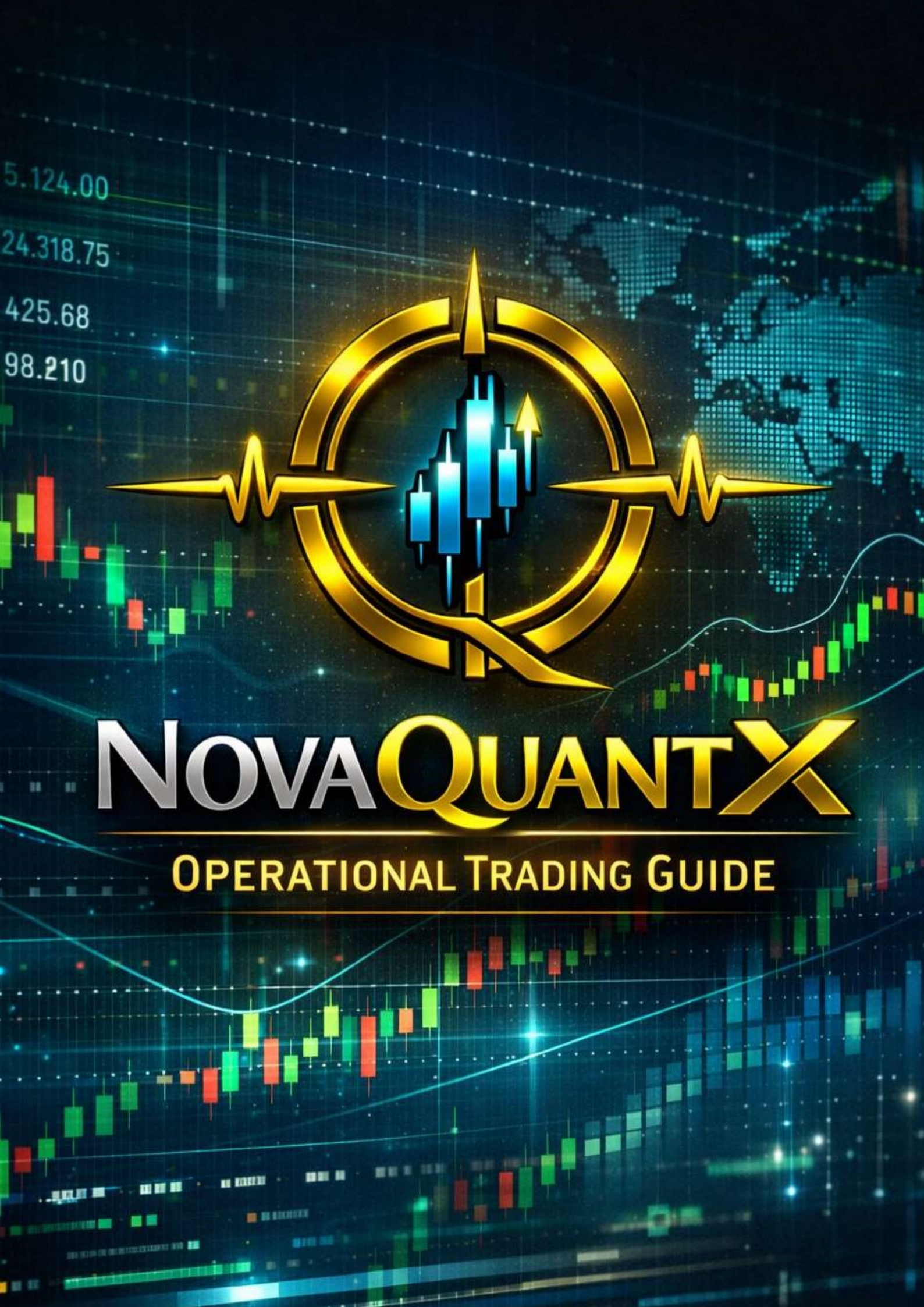

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Introduction

NovaQuantX indicators are designed to give traders a **clean, intuitive** view of market direction and behavior.

This guide focuses on **how to use** each tool in real.

Every section explains what you see on the chart, how to interpret it, and how to apply it in your trading workflow.

Trend Bias & Market Context

Nova Flow Free is the simplest and most essential tool in the NovaQuantX ecosystem.

It provides a **clear directional bias** and a **soft equilibrium zone** that helps you understand whether the market is trending, compressing, or transitioning.



What You See

- A single smooth line that changes color with the trend
- A soft shaded zone around price (equilibrium area)
- No signals, no alerts — it's intentionally minimal

How to Read It

- Green line → bullish bias
- Red line → bearish bias
- Price inside the soft zone → compression, indecision, or transition
- Price clearly above the line → strong bullish environment
- Price clearly below the line → strong bearish environment

How to Use It Operationally

- Use it as your **primary context filter** before taking any trade
- Avoid trading against the color of the line
- When price is inside the equilibrium zone, expect slower movement or choppy behavior
- When price breaks away from the zone, momentum usually increases

Best Timeframes

- Works on all timeframes
- Most effective on **M15, H1, H4, and Daily** for clean trend bias

Ideal For

- Traders who want a simple, reliable trend filter
- Beginners who need a clean visual guide

Trend Structure & Strength

Nova Flow Core expands the visual information provided by Nova Flow Free.

Instead of a single trend line, it displays a **dual-band ribbon** that reveals the *structure*, *strength*, and *quality* of the trend.

It remains simple and visual, but gives you a deeper understanding of how the market is moving.



What You See

- A two-line ribbon that changes color with the trend
- A shaded area between the lines
- A small label showing “Trend ↑” or “Trend ↓”





How to Read the Ribbon

The ribbon gives you information that a single line cannot:

1. Ribbon Angle

- Steep angle → strong directional trend
- Flat angle → weak trend or sideways market

2. Ribbon Width

- Wide ribbon → momentum expanding
- Narrow ribbon → compression or loss of strength

3. Ribbon Color

- Green → bullish structure
- Red → bearish structure

4. Price Position

- Price consistently above the ribbon → healthy uptrend
- Price consistently below the ribbon → healthy downtrend
- Price inside the ribbon → transition, hesitation, or early reversal

How to Use It Operationally

Nova Flow Core is designed to help you understand *trend quality*, not to give signals.

Here's how traders typically use it:

Identify Trend Strength

- Strong angle + wide ribbon = trend continuation likely
- Flat ribbon = avoid trend-based entries

Avoid Choppy Markets

If the ribbon becomes flat and narrow, the market is compressing. This is where most traders lose money — Core helps you avoid it.



Combine with Sniper Elite

- Use Core to confirm the environment
- Use Sniper to time entries and exits
- Core = context
- Sniper = execution

(Flow Core is already integrated in Sniper Elite — no need to purchase both.)

Best Timeframes

- Works on all timeframes
- Most effective on **M5, M15, H1, H4**
- Higher timeframes give the cleanest structure

Ideal For

- Traders who want a deeper understanding of trend behavior
- Swing traders and intraday traders



NOVA SNIPER ELITE

Nova Sniper Elite provides three operational modes

Conservative, Balanced, and Aggressive

allowing traders to adapt execution speed and signal sensitivity to any market condition.

Customization Options Across All Modes

All three modes include flexible display settings.

You can choose whether to show or hide elements such as:

- **EMA 200**
- **Signal labels** (specific to each mode)
- **Pro Panel** (Market State)

This allows you to tailor the chart to your preferred level of clarity and focus

Nova Sniper Elite: Conservative Mode

High-Quality Signals for Clean Market Conditions

Sniper Conservative is the most selective and disciplined mode of the Nova Sniper Elite system. It focuses on **clean structure**, **strong directional conditions**, and **high-quality candles**, producing fewer signals but with exceptional clarity.

This mode is designed for traders who prefer patience, precision, and stability over frequency.



What You See

- **B** (Buy) and **S** (Sell) signals only when the market structure is clean
- **E** exit markers that appear when the trend weakens or conditions shift
- No noise, no rapid signals, no cluster behavior

How to Interpret Conservative Signals

1. A Conservative Buy (B)

A Buy signal appears when the market shows:

- A clear bullish environment
- Strong, healthy candles
- Clean directional behavior
- No compression or hesitation

In other words: **The market is aligned, strong, and moving with intention.**

2. A Conservative Sell (S)

A Sell signal appears in the opposite scenario:

- Clear bearish environment
- Strong downward structure
- No conflicting signals or sideways behavior

3. Exit (E)

The **E** marker appears when the trend loses strength or the market shows early signs of reversal.

It is not a “panic exit” — it’s a **professional early warning** that the clean structure is fading.

How to Use It Operationally

- Treat Conservative signals as **high-probability opportunities**
- Avoid forcing trades — this mode rewards patience
- Use the **E** marker as a guide to reduce risk or close positions
- Combine with Nova Flow Core to confirm trend structure
- Avoid using Conservative in very fast or chaotic markets



Best Timeframes

Sniper Conservative performs best where structure is clean and noise is low:

- **H1**
- **H4**
- **Daily**

It remains effective on lower timeframes, but its full potential emerges on higher structures.

Ideal For

- Swing traders
- Intraday traders who prefer fewer but cleaner setups
- Traders who dislike noise and over-trading
- Anyone who wants a calm, structured approach



BALANCED MODE



Nova Sniper Elite: Balanced Mode

The Perfect Middle Ground for Most Traders

Sniper Balanced is the most versatile and adaptive mode of the Nova Sniper Elite system.

It sits exactly between the precision of Conservative and the speed of Reactive, offering a **balanced mix of signal frequency, clarity, and responsiveness**.

This mode is designed to work in most market conditions and is ideal for everyday intraday trading.

What You See

- **B** (Buy) and **S** (Sell) signals that appear when momentum and structure align
- **!** exit markers that warn when the trend weakens or the market enters compression
- Smooth, consistent behavior without excessive noise



How to Interpret Balanced Signals

1. A Balanced Buy (B)

A Buy signal appears when:

- The trend is aligned
- Momentum is healthy
- Candles show clear direction
- The market is not in heavy sideways movement

2. A Balanced Sell (S)

A Sell signal appears when:

- Bearish momentum is present
- Structure supports continuation
- The market is not compressing

Balanced is designed to catch both trend continuations and early shifts, without being overly aggressive.

3. Exit (!)

The ! marker appears when:

- Momentum weakens
- Candles show hesitation
- The market begins to compress

It's a practical early warning that the move is losing strength.

How to Use It Operationally

- Treat Balanced signals as **your main intraday engine**
- Use the ! marker to reduce risk, scale out, or close positions
- Avoid trading Balanced signals during extremely choppy or news-driven markets
- Combine with Nova Flow Core to confirm trend structure and avoid sideways phases
- Balanced is excellent for catching the “middle” of the move



Best Timeframes

Sniper Balanced performs best where momentum is visible but noise is manageable:

- **M5**
- **M15**
- **M30**
- **H1**

These timeframes give the cleanest and most consistent Balanced signals.

Ideal For

- Intraday traders
- Traders who want a good balance between frequency and quality
- Those who prefer a calm but active trading style
- Anyone who wants one mode that works well across most markets



REACTIVE MODE



Nova Sniper Elite: Reactive Mode

Fast Signals for Dynamic Markets

Sniper Reactive is the fastest and most responsive mode of the Nova Sniper Elite system. It is designed to capture **early trend shifts**, **momentum bursts**, and **rapid directional changes** — the kind of movements that appear before the trend becomes obvious.

Reactive is ideal for traders who operate in fast markets and want to anticipate moves rather than wait for full confirmation.



What You See

- **B** (Buy) and **S** (Sell) signals that appear quickly when momentum turns
- Small **pre-alert dots** that show early pressure before a potential shift
- No exit markers — Reactive is designed for short, fast trades

How to Interpret Reactive Signals

1. Reactive Buy (B)

A Buy signal appears when:

- Momentum turns upward
- Price shows a clean directional push
- The market is not in heavy compression

Reactive Buy signals often appear **before** the trend becomes obvious — that's the purpose of this mode.

2. Reactive Sell (S)

A Sell signal appears when:

- Momentum turns downward
- Price shows a clear push lower
- The market is not stuck in a tight range

Reactive Sell signals are designed to catch the start of fast bearish moves.

3. Pre-Alert Dots

The small dots are **early warnings** that the market is preparing to shift.

They do NOT mean “enter now”. They mean:

“Momentum is building — be ready.”

When a dot appears and the next candles confirm direction, Reactive becomes extremely powerful.



How to Use It Operationally

- Treat Reactive as a **fast execution mode**
- Use pre-alerts to prepare, not to enter
- Keep trades short and focused — Reactive is not meant for long holds
- Avoid using Reactive during slow or low-volume sessions
- Combine with Nova Flow Core to avoid trading inside compression zones

Reactive works best when the market is moving with speed and intention.

Best Timeframes

Sniper Reactive performs best in fast environments:

- **M1**
- **M3**
- **M5**
- **M15**
- **M30**

These timeframes allow Reactive to shine with early entries and momentum-based setups.

Ideal For

- Scalpers
- High-frequency intraday traders
- Traders who prefer early entries
- Markets with strong volatility (indices, crypto, gold)
- Anyone who wants a fast, responsive mode that reacts before the trend becomes obvious
