Guide for Attendees at the International Congress of Medical and Pharmaceutical Biotechnology

Welcome to Guadalajara, Jalisco, the cultural heart of Western Mexico and host city of the **International Congress of Medical and Pharmaceutical Biotechnology 2026**. This guide provides information on access to CIATEJ Normalistas, nearby lodging options, and transportation routes to facilitate your stay in our city, as well as tourist attractions you can visit and enjoy.

► **Arrival at CIATEJ Normalistas**

CIATEJ Normalistas is located very close to downtown Guadalajara. If you arrive by air or land, these are the common routes to reach CIATEJ Normalistas:

Guadalajara International Airport – Central Nueva de Guadalajara:
45 minutes.



To travel **from the Airport to Central Nueva**, bus lines such as VivaAerobus and ETN offer transportation services with prior reservation via their websites. Please check airline counters and websites for more information.



To travel from **Central Nueva to the International Airport**, VivaAerobus offers service every 2 hours from Terminal C of Central Nueva, at the “La Línea” ticket booths.

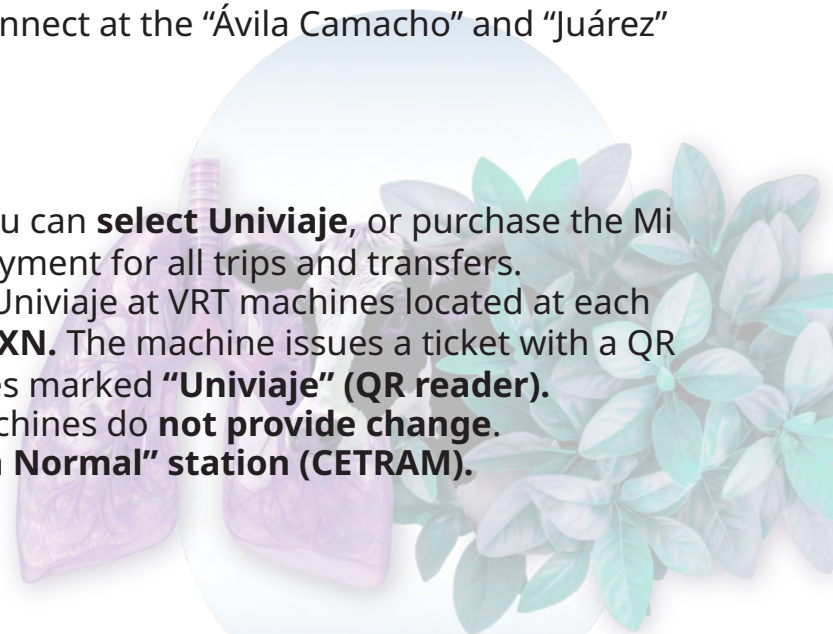
► **Public Transportation**

Guadalajara has a modern light rail network that connects several tourist spots from CIATEJ Normalistas.

There are 3 light rail lines that connect at the “Ávila Camacho” and “Juárez” stations.

Important notes for use

- You will find machines where you can **select Univiaje**, or purchase the Mi Transporte card, which allows payment for all trips and transfers.
- Occasional users can purchase Univiaje at VRT machines located at each station entrance. **Cost: \$11.00 MXN.** The machine issues a ticket with a QR code for access through turnstiles marked **“Univiaje” (QR reader)**.
- Exact change is required, as machines do **not provide change**.
- CIATEJ is located outside the **“La Normal” station (CETRAM)**.

• **Other landmarks:** Metropolitan Cathedral, Expiatorio, Instituto Cultural Cabañas, Ibero-American Library.

- **Horse-drawn carriage rides (Calandria)** in front of the Cathedral and Teatro Degollado.

- **Tlaquepaque:** A picturesque town known for handicrafts, art galleries, and restaurants.

► **Gastronomy and Entertainment**

Jalisco is rich in gastronomy. Don't miss traditional dishes such as **tortas ahogadas, birria, and tejuino in local markets and restaurants.**

Birriería Las 9 Esquinas: Famous for goat birria and barbecue cooked in maguey leaves. A Guadalajara tradition since 1986.

Conoce el restaurante tradicional "**La Chata**" que ofrece numerosos platillos jaliscienses en un entorno familiar en el Centro Histórico.

Chapultepec Avenue: Ideal for nightlife, with bars, cafés, and shops.

San Juan de Dios Market: One of the largest in Latin America, offering crafts, clothing, food, and more.
