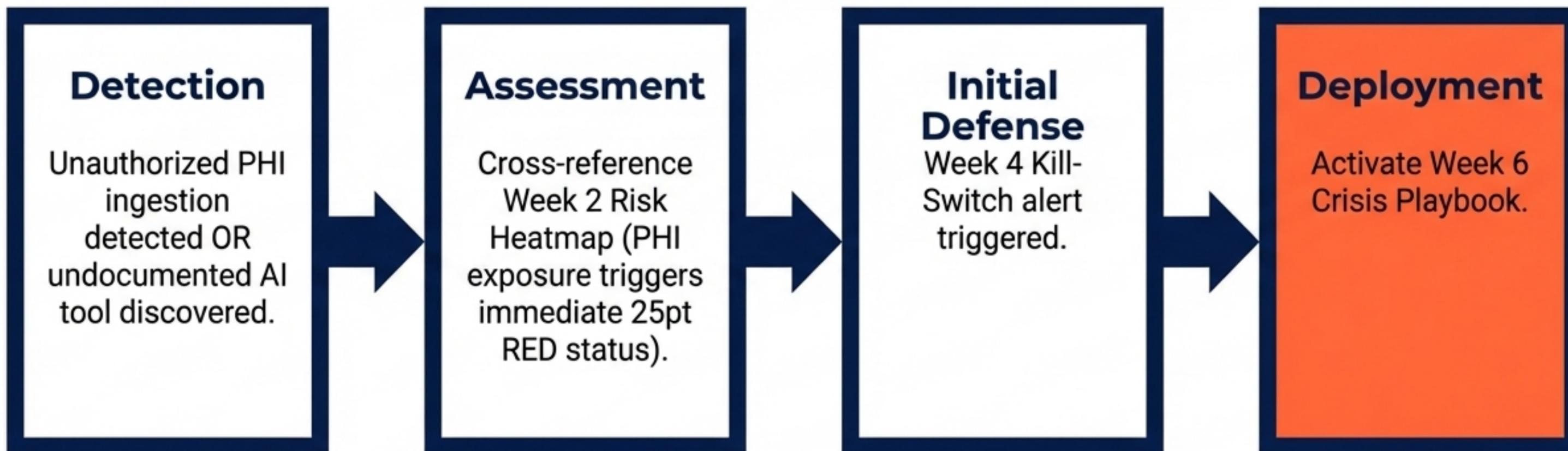

# Playbook Activation Triggers



Do not attempt to parse dense CPRA/HIPAA legal jargon during an active event. Follow the subsequent chronological triage protocol strictly to avoid \$7,500 CPRA fines per undocumented tool.

# The 7-Day Crisis Lifecycle

**Phase 1:  
CONTAIN**  
(Hour 0-24)

Immediate threat  
isolation and system  
shutdown.

**Phase 2:  
INVESTIGATE**  
(Day 1-3)

Methodical analysis of  
PHI exposure and  
vendor logs.

**Phase 3:  
REPORT**  
(Day 4-7)

Regulatory compliance,  
board documentation,  
and structural updates.

# PHASE 1: CONTAIN



**Hour 0 to 24**

Stop the bleeding. Isolate the threat, restrict all vendor access, and execute emergency shutdown protocols. Do not wait for complete information to take defensive action.

# Hour 0-24 Tactical Checklist

<input type="checkbox"/>	<b>Activate Kill-Switches</b> Deploy Week 4 Tampermonkey protocol ( <code>if(!localStorage.aiConsent){PAUSE AI}</code> ) across affected networks.
<input type="checkbox"/>	<b>Sever Vendor Access</b> Immediately revoke API keys and block IP addresses associated with the compromised AI tool.
<input type="checkbox"/>	<b>Quarantine Data</b> Lock down databases or servers where unauthorized PHI/PII ingestion is suspected.
<input type="checkbox"/>	<b>Internal Escalation</b> Notify IT Lead and newly appointed AI Compliance Officer.
<input type="checkbox"/>	<b>Halt Automated Decisions</b> Pause any AI-driven patient scheduling, triage, or diagnostic support tools tied to the breached system.

# PHASE 2: INVESTIGATE

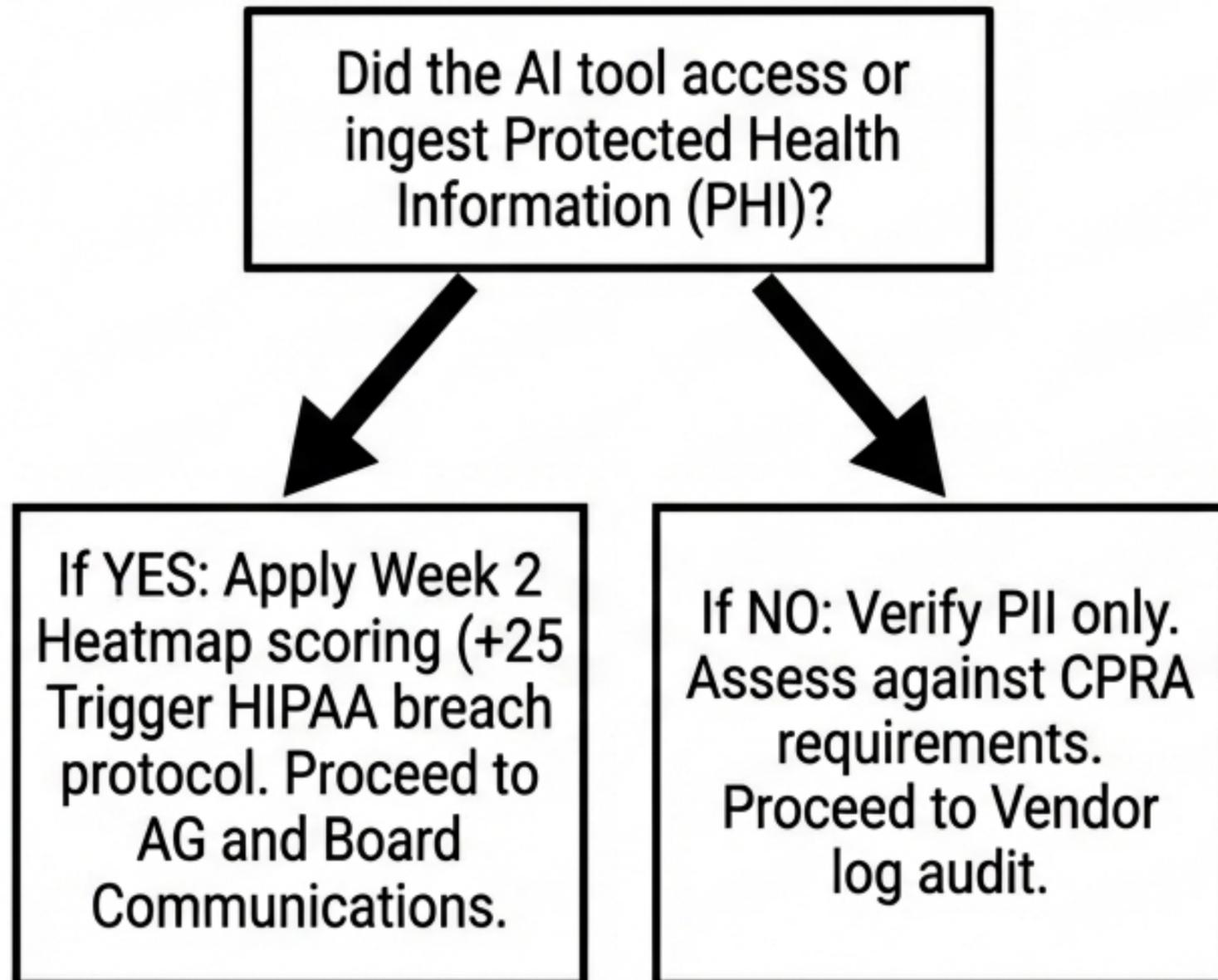


**Day 1 to 3**

Map the exposure. Determine exactly what data was ingested, trace the AI tool's decision pathways, and assess legal liability.

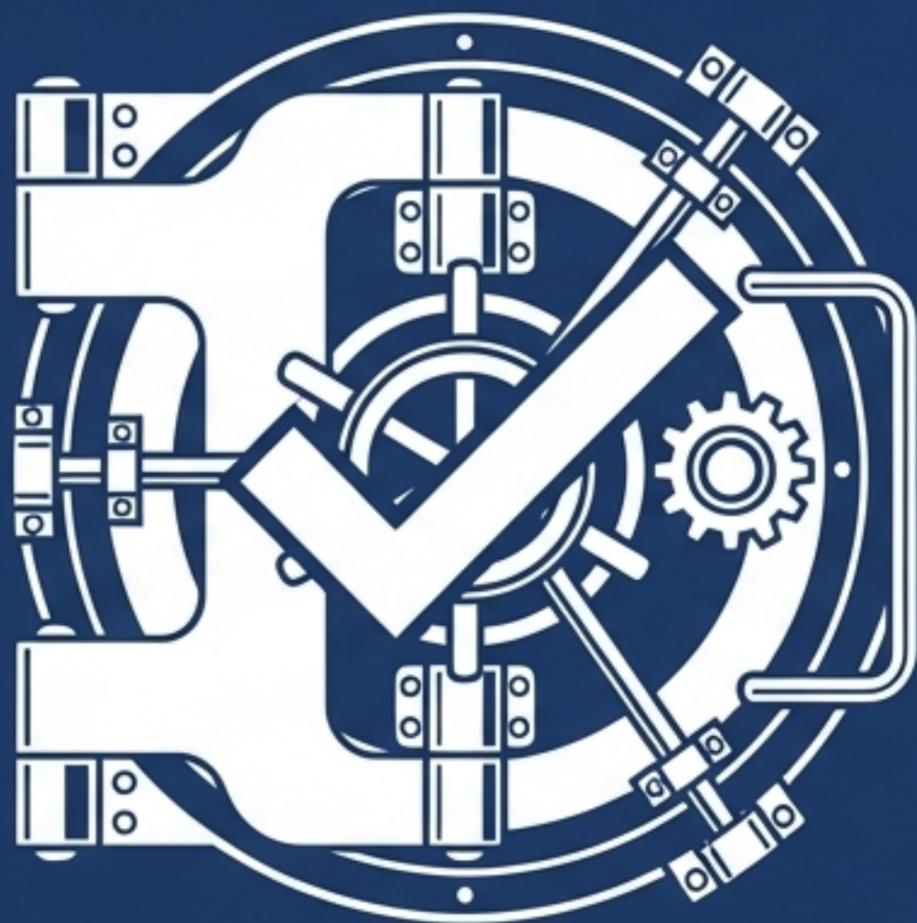
# Day 1-3 Tactical Checklist & Exposure Mapping

## PHI Exposure Flowchart



<input type="checkbox"/>	<b>Audit Vendor Logs:</b> Request and review 30-day activity logs from the AI vendor.
<input type="checkbox"/>	<b>Assess Staff Involvement:</b> Identify which personnel bypassed Week 3 Consent Banners.
<input type="checkbox"/>	<b>Quantify Scope:</b> Document the exact number of patient/client records potentially exposed.
<input type="checkbox"/>	<b>Draft Incident Summary:</b> Compile findings into a preliminary internal timeline.

# PHASE 3: REPORT



**Day 4 to 7**

Fulfill regulatory obligations. Deploy targeted communications, update risk architecture, and officially close the incident loop.

# Day 4-7 Tactical Checklist



## Deploy Required Notices

Send legally mandated communications (AG Notice, Board Brief) based on the Phase 2 investigation results.



## Update Week 2 Heatmap

Re-score the involved AI tool (Likely shifting to RED/100pt status) and document the failure point.



## Retrain Personnel

Mandate affected staff to retake Week 5 Certification Modules (specifically Module 6: Incident Escalation).



## Finalize Incident Log

Store the completed operational timeline in the Week 7 Google Sheets Incident dashboard.

## URGENT: IMMEDIATE CEASE OF DATA PROCESSING & LOG REQUEST
