

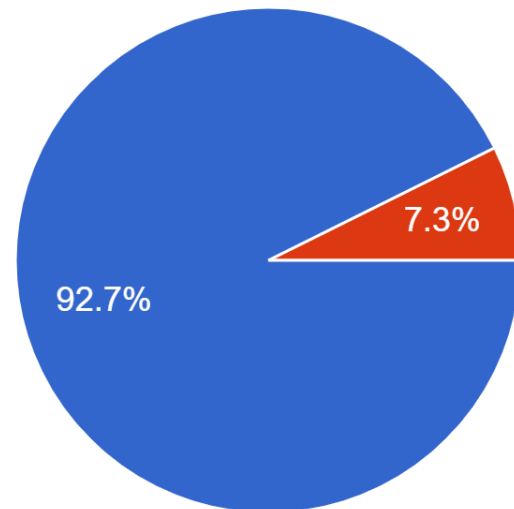

### 1.) Are you a member of the MGA?

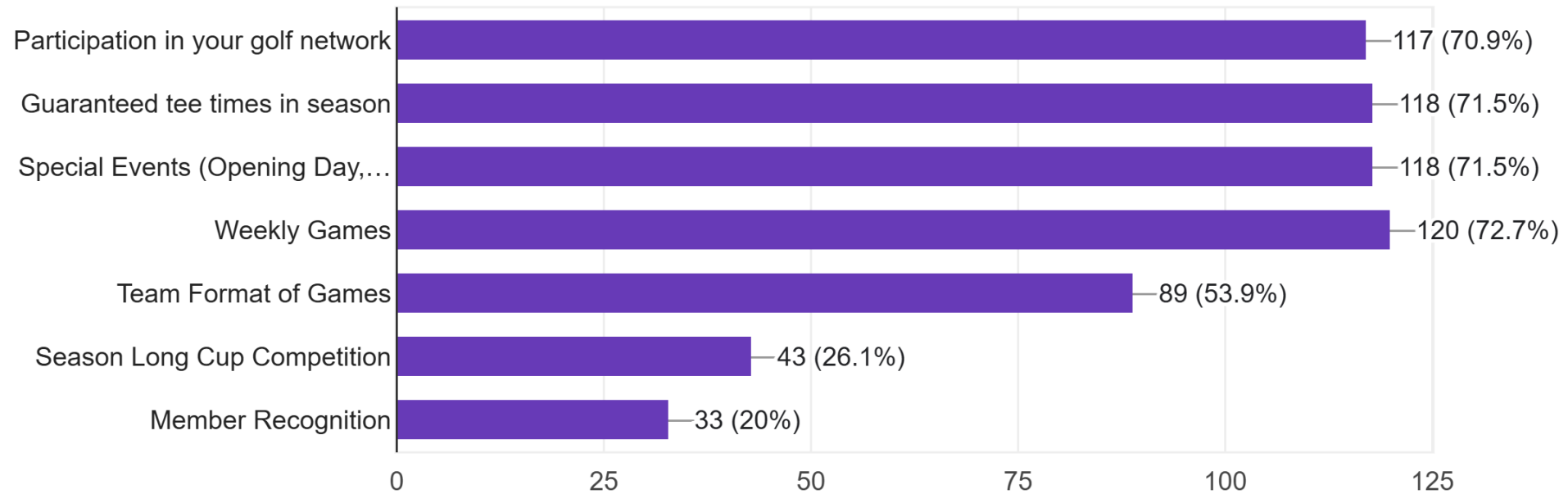

#### 4.) Thank you for being a member. Why do you belong to the MGA? (Check all that apply)

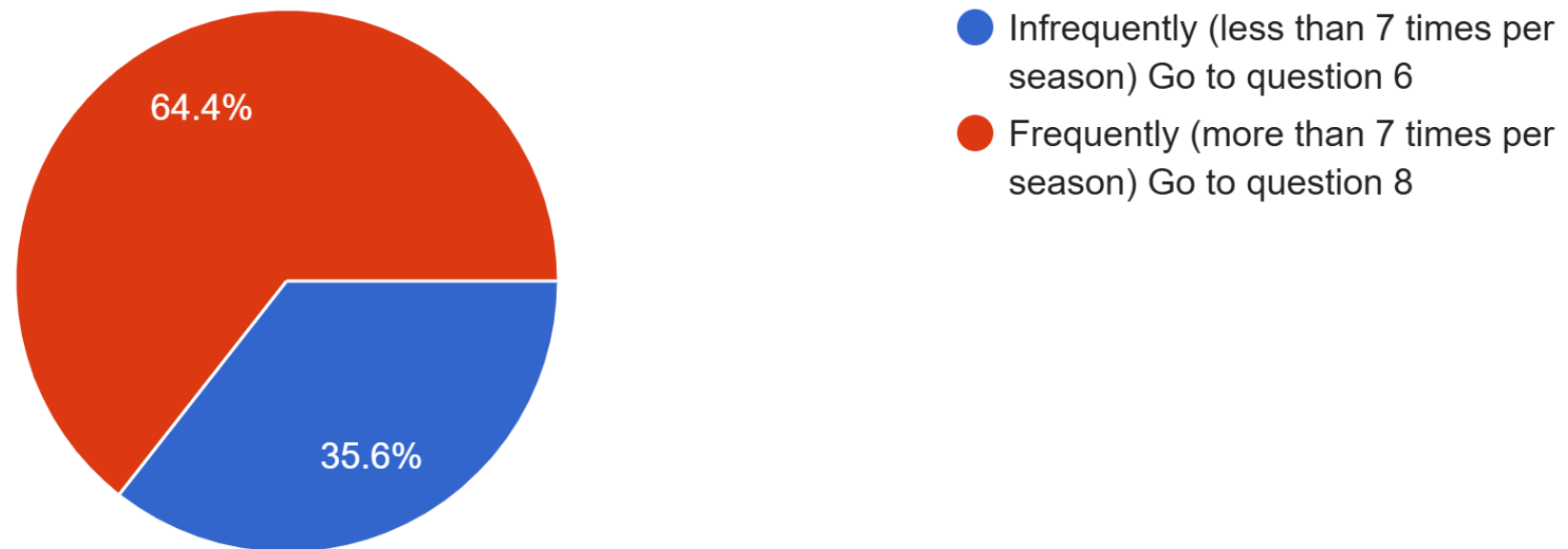
165 responses



More than a third of our members only play infrequently

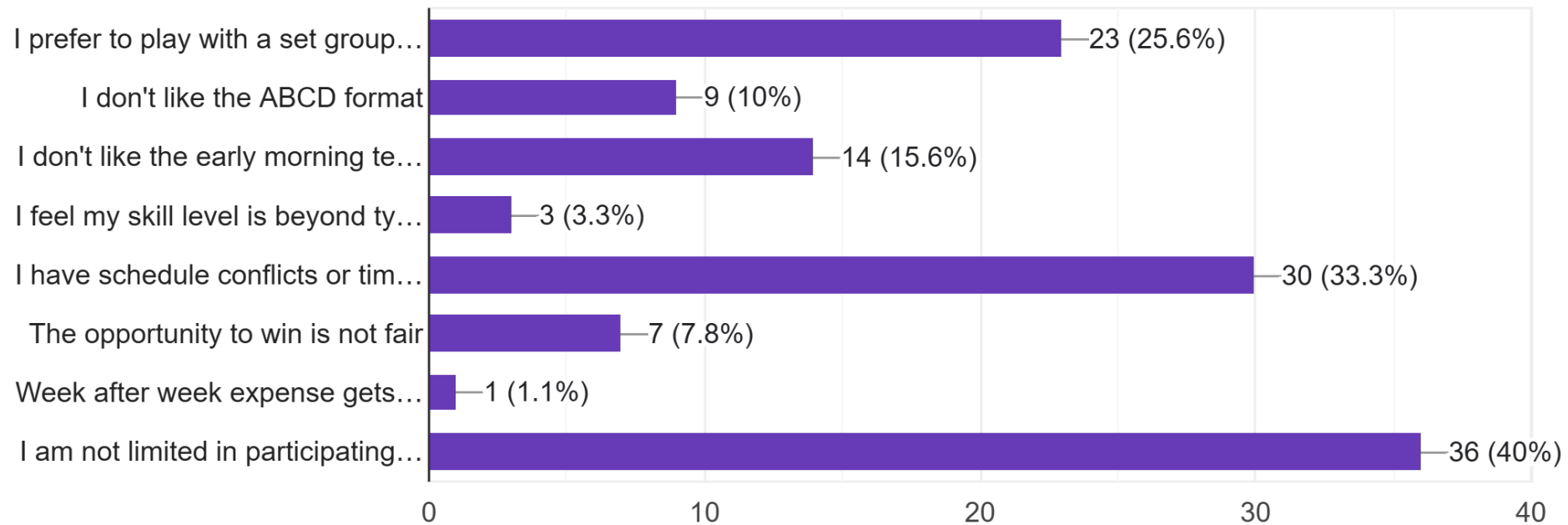
## 5.) As a member of the MGA, how frequently do you play in the sponsored MGA games?

## 6.) What factors limit your participation in the MGA games? (Check all that apply)

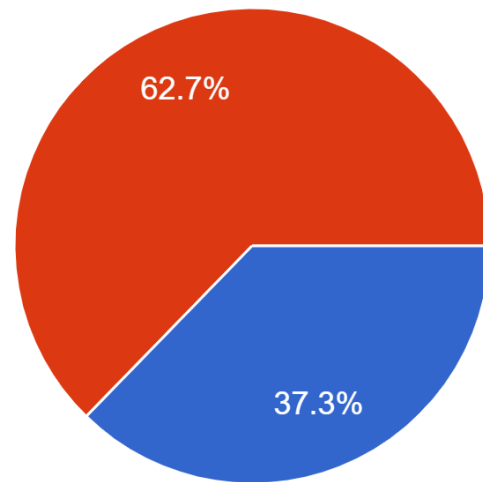
90 responses

### 8.) Should the MGA enhance the variety of games?

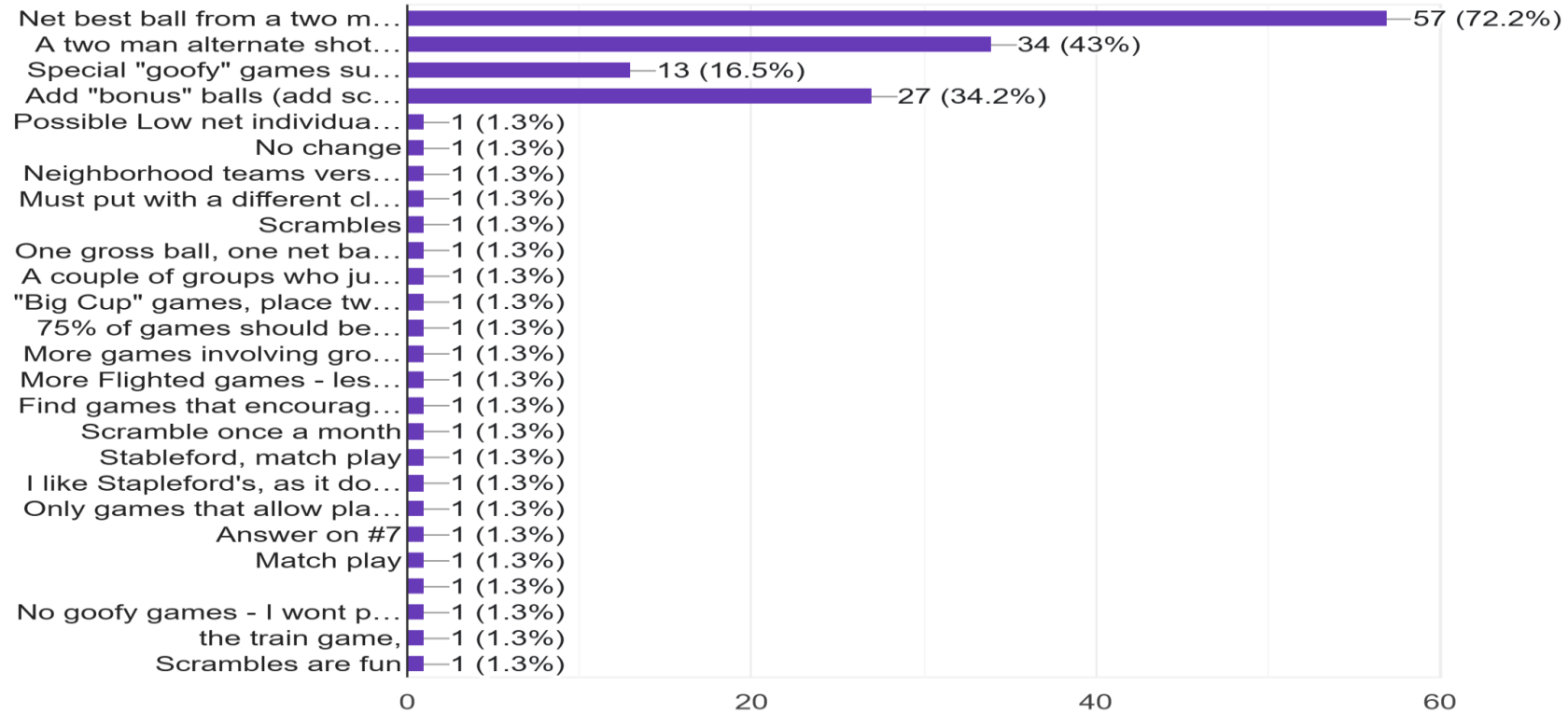

### 9.) What type of alternate game might you be interested? (Please check all that apply)

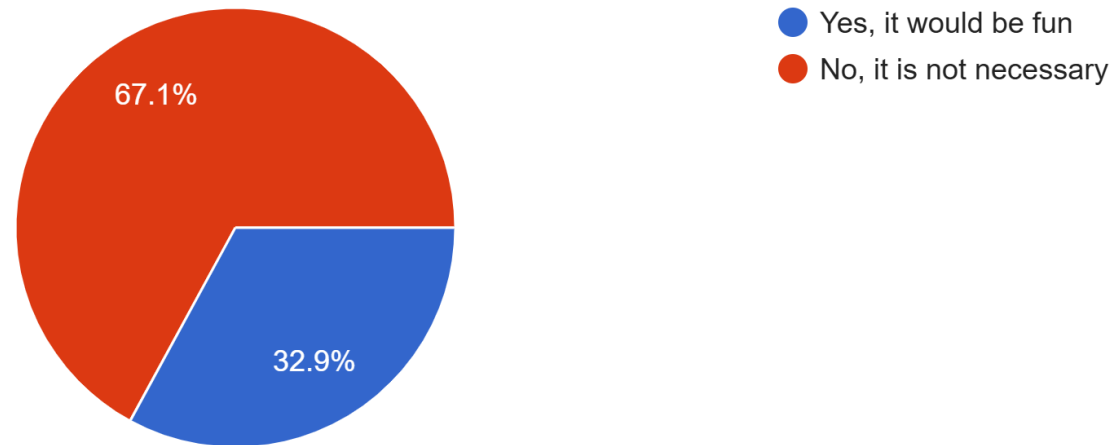

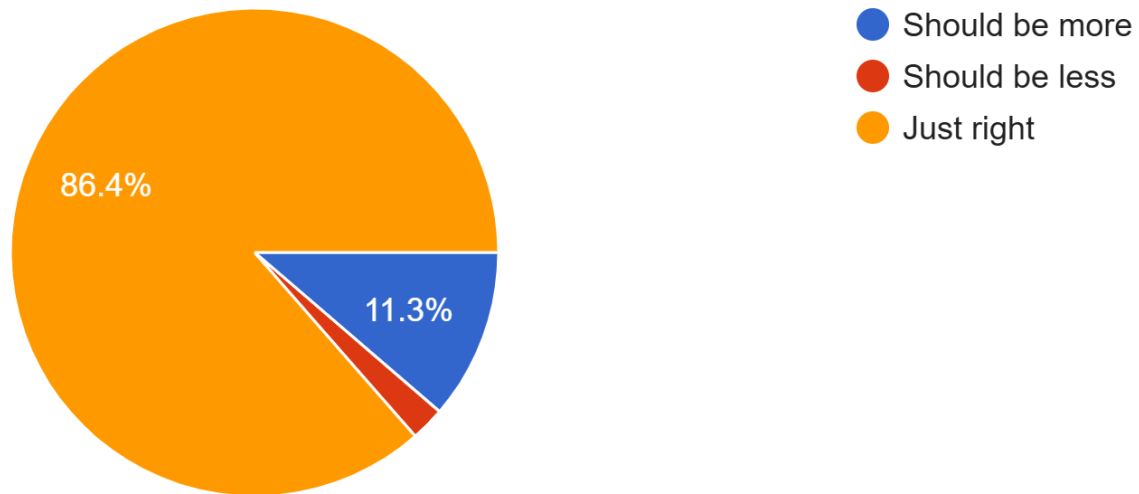




Over wheming support for keeping the fees the same

### 11.) Is the entry fee of \$11 appropriate?

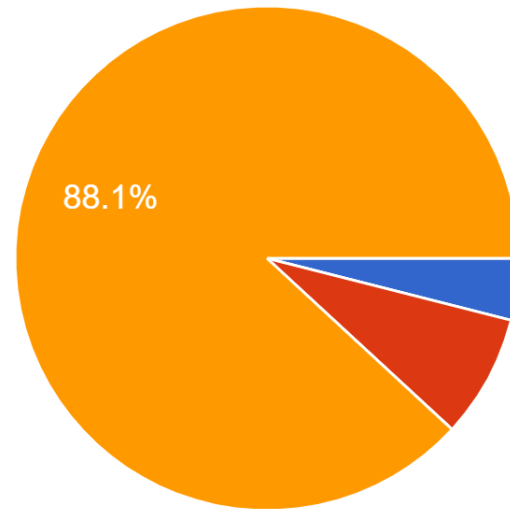

More than 50% believe paying blind draw is not necessary

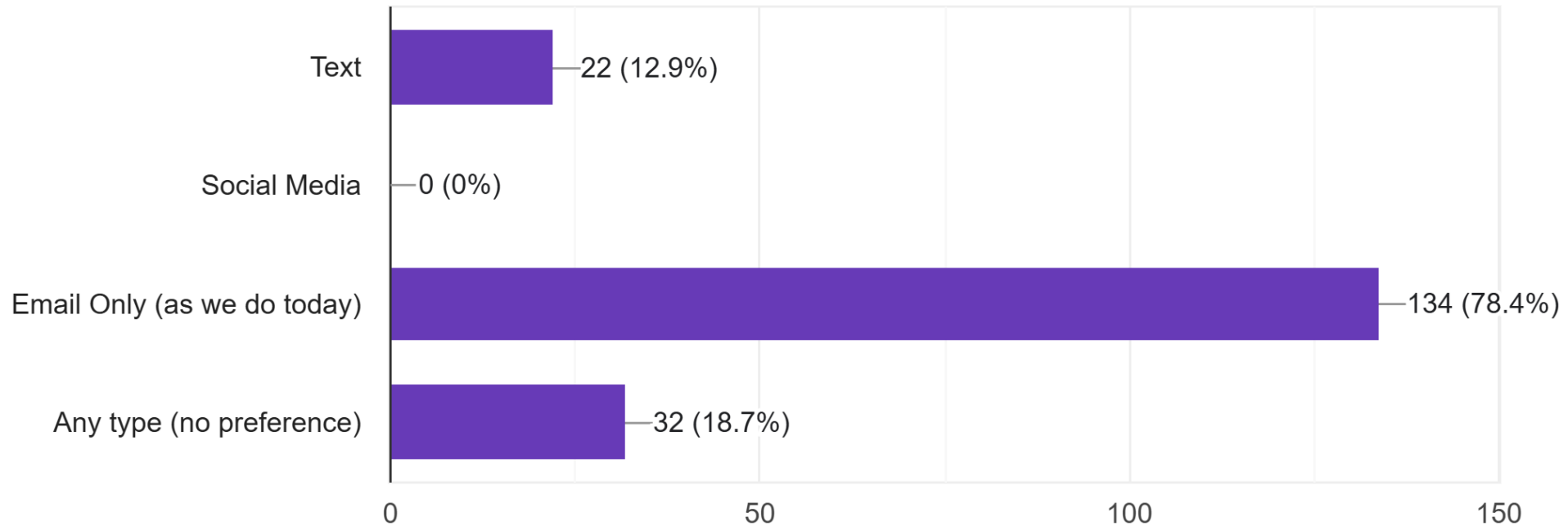
### 13.) Should blind draws be paid if not part of the field payment on his regular team?

14.) MGA generally communicates through weekly emails. Do you prefer communication by alternate means as well? (Please check all that apply)

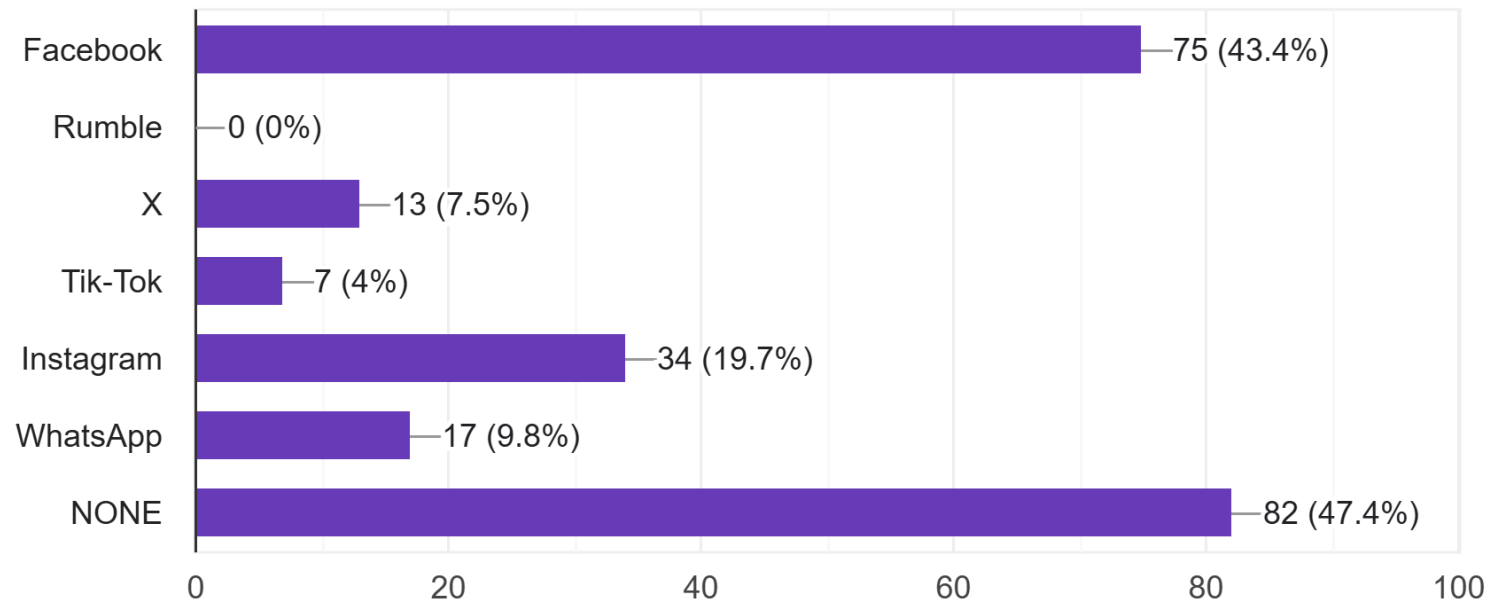

### 15.) Do you participate in social media? (Please check all that apply)

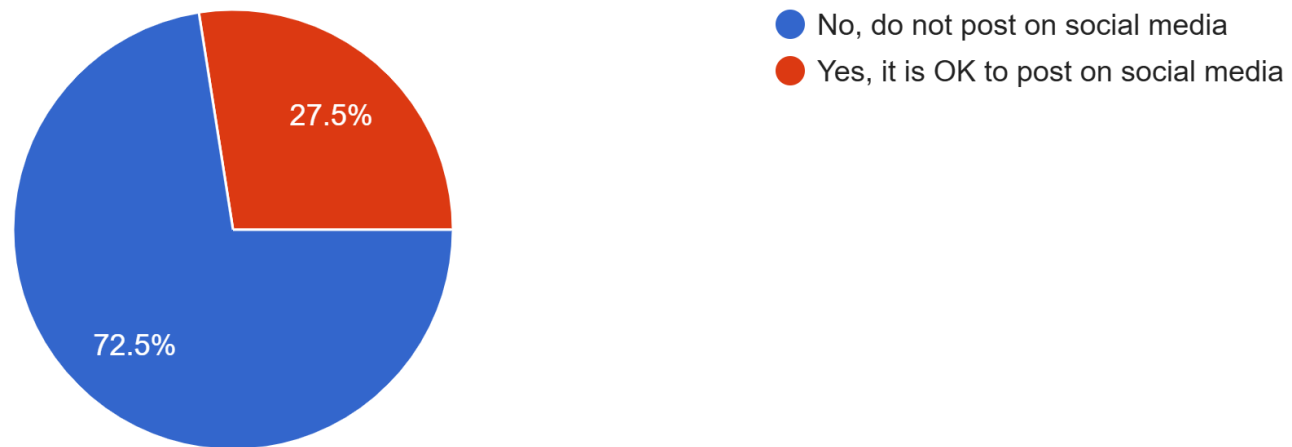

Should not post game results – email is fine

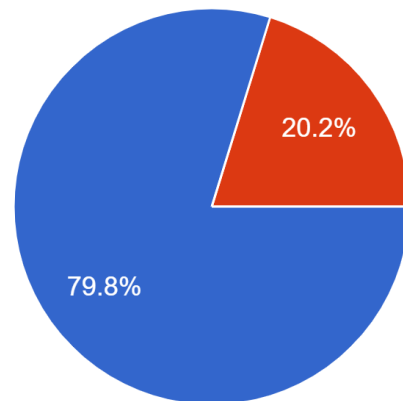
16.) Should MGA results be posted on Social Media such as daily winners and scores, current standings, members currently signed up to play in upcoming games?
