Mac McAnally Brings His "All The Way Around" Tour to Southern California

Mac McAnally is one of Nashville's most respected singer- songwriters, musicians, and producers. A 10-time CMA Musician of the Year and member of the Nashville Songwriters Hall of Fame, McAnally has built a remarkable career spanning more than four decades. He has written hit songs for artists including Alabama, Sawyer Brown, Kenny Chesney and our own, Jimmy Buffett. Mac has also recorded 14 solo albums of his own.

Born Lyman Corbitt "Mac" McAnally Jr. on July 15th 1957, in Belmont, Mississippi, McAnally was raised in a deeply musical family. His father served as the local high school principal, while his mother played piano and organ at their church. By the age of 3 Mac was already singing gospel hymns alongside his mother at First Baptist Church in Belmont. Encouraged by his mother, he began piano lessons early in life and developed a love for music that would shape his future career.

By age 15, McAnally had written his first song and was performing professionally in clubs along the Mississippi-Tennessee state line. His exposure to both gospel music and the lively club scene helped form the unique storytelling style and musicianship that later made him a Nashville legend.

McAnally also became a longtime member of Jimmy Buffett's famous Coral Reefer Band, serving as one of Buffett's closest musical collaborators for decades. Following Buffett's passing in 2023, McAnally has continued leading the Coral Reefer Band, honoring Buffett's legacy and keeping the music alive for generations of Parrot Heads.

Recently, we had a chance to see Mac McNally perform live at The Belly Up Tavern in Solana Beach, near San Diego. Mac was joined by his fellow Coral Reefer and percussionist, Eric Darken. Parrot Head Club Members from Orange County, Los Angeles and San Diego attended and joined in on the fun. The performance was unforgettable. Mac's heartfelt renditions of Jimmy Buffett classics, along with his own original songs, were delivered with warmth, humor and incredible musicianship.

The intimate venue made the night even more special. Although The Belly Up is surprisingly small for such legendary performances, the packed crowd didn't seem to mind at all. Fans sang loudly along to many Buffett favorites, creating an atmosphere that felt more like a family gathering than a concert. Mac brought out another Coral Reefer, Mick Utley to join in on the classic, Volcano. Mick's keyboard stylings sound amazingly like his dad's, Michael Utley, Jimmy's long time partner in his music career.

One of the evening's most emotional moments came during "Bubbles Up", a song that continues to touch Buffett fans deeply. It's hard to hear that song without feeling emotional. Throughout the nearly two-hour show, Mac shared personal "Jimmy Stories", talked about how songs were written, and connected with the audience in a way that only longtime friends and true storytellers can.

For Parrot Heads and music lovers alike, seeing Mac McNally live is more than just a concert. It's a celebration of great songwriting, friendship, memories and the enduring spirit of Jimmy Buffett's music.

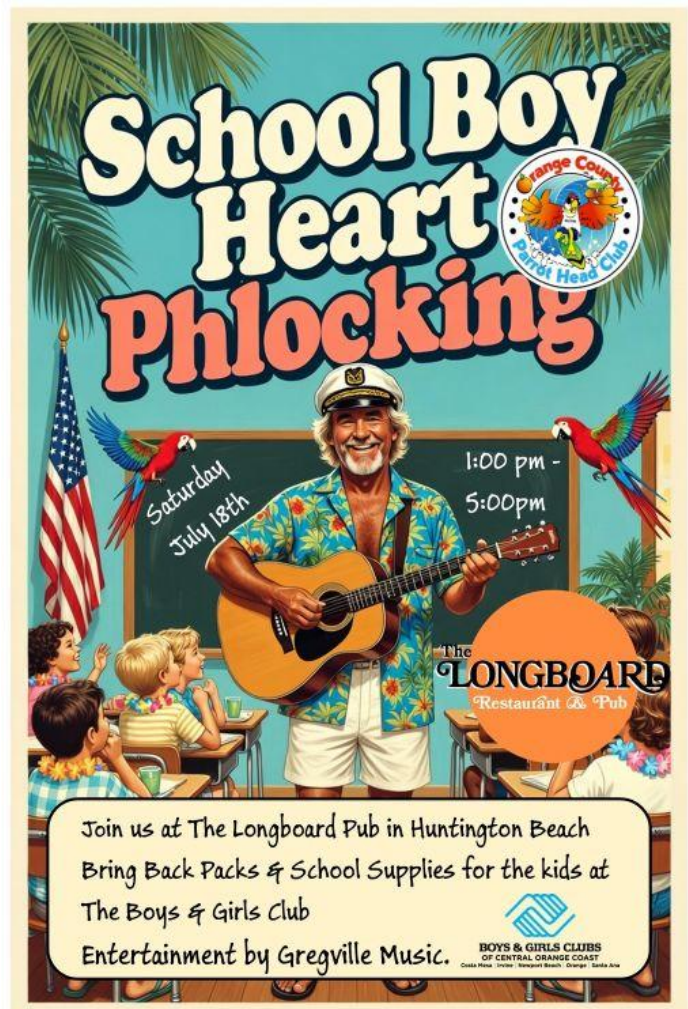

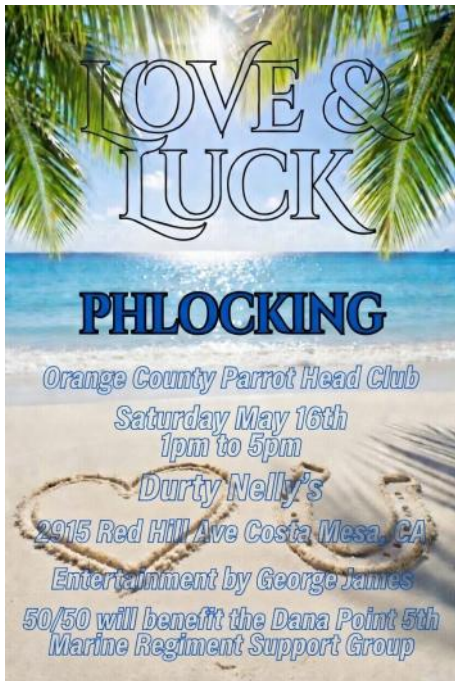

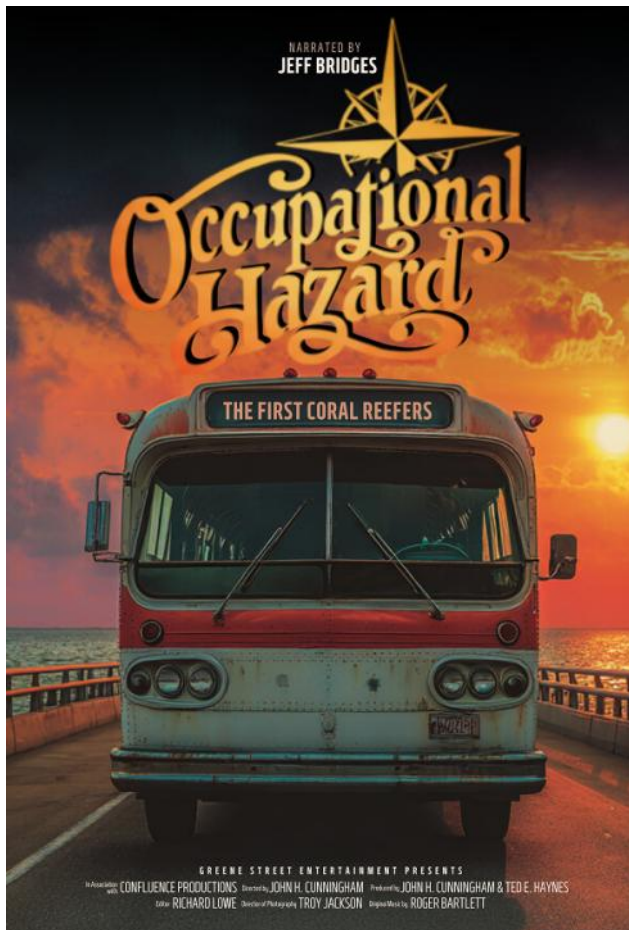

Occupational Hazard The Movie

Occupational Hazard is a feature documentary directed by John H Cunningham that traces the origins and evolution of Jimmy Buffett's original Coral Reefer Band during the 1970s and early 1980s. It chronicles the group of wildly talented, often unruly characters whose creative energy and personal chemistry helped define Buffett's most iconic early work. The movie is narrated by Jeff Bridges.

Set largely in Key West, a place the bandmates described as having its own rhythm and creative spark. The film delves into how this laid-back island community shaped not only the music but the mindset of the early Coral Reefers. Through rare, never-before-seen archival footage and deeply person interviews with founding members, tour managers, producers and music legends, Occupational Hazard captures the camaraderie, chaos, and magic of an era that thrived on freedom and lived without a rulebook.



From dusty road gigs and dive-bar rehearsals to the first big studio albums, the documentary details how this group crafted a sound and built a touring family until the hard-partying lifestyle began to take its toll. Drug use led to burnout, and tragedy crept in, but Buffett's desire to succeed resulted in a near-total transformation of the band on the road to becoming one of the most successful musicians of our generation.

This film is a tribute to Buffett and the original Coral Reefers, the places and people that shaped them, the volatile beauty of a musical moment that couldn't last but changed everything and their candid sentiment toward Buffett.

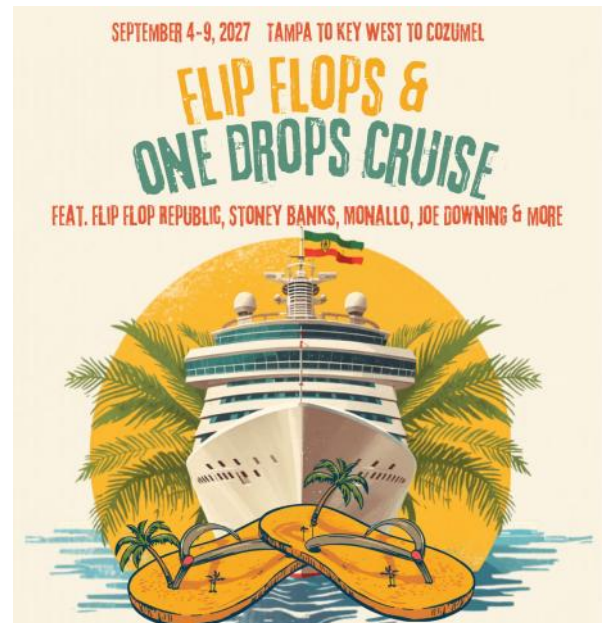
Atlanta Parrot Head Club Southern Cross 2027 Parrot Head Cruise

Elks Purple Pig Has Raised Over \$140,500,000 Since It Started in 1950

The "Purple Pig" is the fundraising arm of the California - Hawaii Elks Association Major Project, Inc. (CHEMPI). Since 1950 it has raised millions to provide free, in-home therapy services and preschool vision screenings for children with physical and developmental disabilities. The program runs primarily through grassroots philanthropy and the iconic purple piggy banks found at Elks Lodges and local businesses.

How the Program Works

Members and supporters pick up a purple piggy bank and fill it with spare change under the motto, "A Coin a Day so They Can Walk, Talk, See and Play."

100% of the funds go directly into supporting the Major Project, which operates at no cost to the families receiving help.

Services Provided

Funds raised by the Purple Pig directly employ and deploy professional teams across California and Hawaii including...

Occupational and Physical Therapists who travel to homes to aid children with motor skills, sensory integration, and daily independence.

Speech - Language Pathologists who diagnose and treat communication disorders.

Pediatric Vision Screeners who visit preschools to identify vision issues early and prevent long-term impairment.
