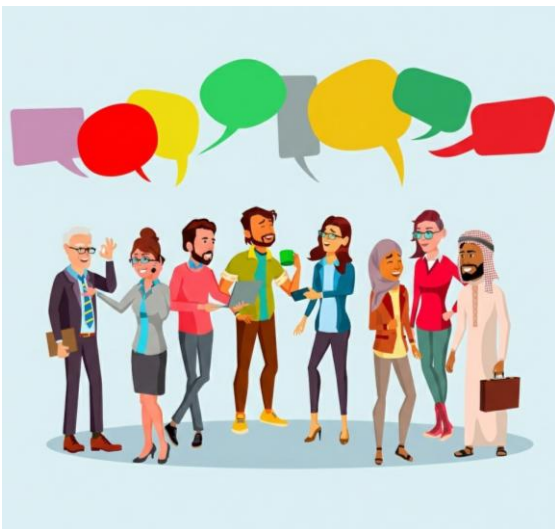

## Section 2: More on Conditionals

### 2.1 Conditionals with after, until, when

Use Present Simple after 'after', 'until', and 'when' to refer to future events.

Example 1: I will call you when I \_\_\_ (arrive). (arrive)

Example 2: Wait until he \_\_\_ (come). (comes)

1. I will go to sleep after I \_\_\_ (finish) this book.
2. We cannot leave until the rain \_\_\_ (stop).
3. When she \_\_\_ (arrive), we will start the meeting.
4. He will buy a car after he \_\_\_ (save) enough money.
5. Don't cross the street until the light \_\_\_ (turn) green.
6. I will tell you the news when I \_\_\_ (see) you tomorrow.
7. After you \_\_\_ (complete) the level, you get a reward.
8. They will wait here until you \_\_\_ (call) them.
9. When the sun \_\_\_ (set), it will get cold.
10. I will wash the dishes after we \_\_\_ (eat) dinner.
11. You can't play video games until you \_\_\_ (do) your homework.
12. When he \_\_\_ (wake) up, I will ask him.
13. She will travel to London after she \_\_\_ (get) her visa.
14. Let's not start the movie until everyone \_\_\_ (be) ready.
15. When you \_\_\_ (mix) red and blue, you get purple.
16. I will check my emails after I \_\_\_ (have) breakfast.
17. Stay in bed until you \_\_\_ (feel) better.
18. When she \_\_\_ (call), please tell her I am busy.

## 2.2 Present Unreal Conditionals (Second Conditional)

Use Past Simple in the 'if' clause and 'would' + verb in the main clause for unlikely present situations.

Example 1: If I \_\_\_ (have) a million dollars, I \_\_\_ (buy) a boat. (had / would buy)

Example 2: If I \_\_\_ (be) you, I wouldn't do that. (were)

1. If I \_\_\_ (have) more time, I would learn a new language.
2. If she \_\_\_ (know) the answer, she would tell us.
3. What \_\_\_ you \_\_\_ (do) if you won the lottery?
4. If I \_\_\_ (be) you, I wouldn't buy that expensive phone.

6. He \_\_\_ (be) happier if he had a better job.
7. If they \_\_\_ (not / be) so tired, they would come to the party.
8. I would travel the world if I \_\_\_ (be) rich.
9. If she \_\_\_ (study) harder, she would pass the exam.
10. \_\_\_ you \_\_\_ (help) him if he asked you?
11. If I \_\_\_ (find) a wallet in the street, I would take it to the police.
12. We would go to the beach if it \_\_\_ (not / rain) today.
13. If he \_\_\_ (can) speak Arabic, he would understand the song.
14. I \_\_\_ (call) her if I had her phone number.
15. If she \_\_\_ (be) taller, she could play basketball.
16. If they \_\_\_ (have) a car, they would drive to work.
17. Where \_\_\_ you \_\_\_ (go) if you could travel anywhere?
18. If I \_\_\_ (not / have) to work, I would sleep all day.
19. She \_\_\_ (buy) that dress if it wasn't so expensive.
