

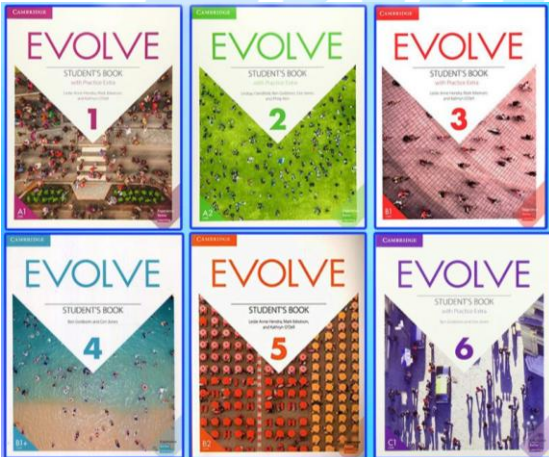

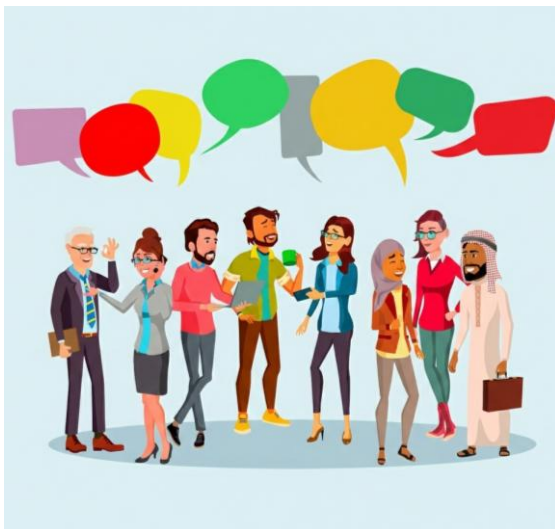

Section 3: Conditionals

1.3 Real Conditionals (Zero and First)

Use Zero (Present/Present) for facts, First (Present/Will) for future possibilities.

Example 1: If you heat ice, it ___ (melt). (melts)

Example 2: If it rains, I ___ (stay) home. (will stay)

Use Past Simple + would/wouldn't + verb for unlikely present/future situations.

Example 1: If I had a million dollars, I ___ (buy) a boat. (would buy)

Example 2: If she ___ (know), she would tell you. (knew)

Use present simple after when, as soon as, until, before, after for future meaning.

Example 1: I will call you when I ___ (arrive). (arrive)

Example 2: Let's wait until it ___ (stop) raining. (stops)
